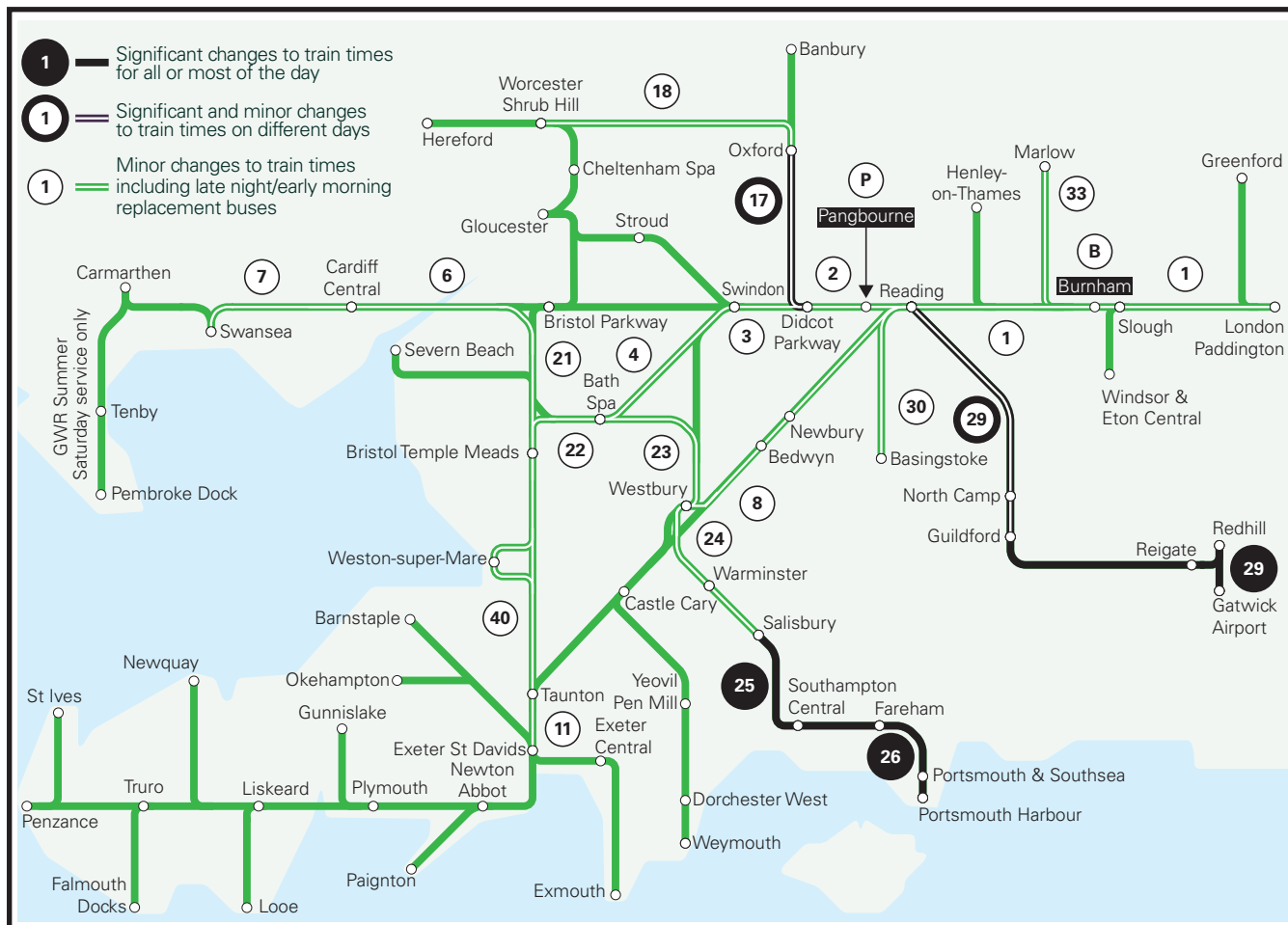


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 13 to Friday 19 April 2024

Saturday - The 2208 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2250 London Paddington to Oxford will depart slightly EARLIER from London Paddington. The 2200 Oxford to London Paddington will not call at Twyford or Maidenhead. The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Slough. A replacement bus will run from Slough to London Paddington.

Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Slough at 0700. A replacement bus will run non-stop from London Paddington at 0556 to Slough. Passengers travelling to/from other stations should use the next available train service.

Sunday - All day, services to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for all or part of their journey. Some trains may depart EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, but will be part replaced by additional trains running between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Most trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway only and the 0738 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will run later from Reading to Didcot Parkway.

Sunday - The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Passengers for Didcot Parkway should use an alternative local service from Reading. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham.

Monday and Tuesday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run a few minutes later from Severn Tunnel Junction onwards.

Monday to Thursday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will not call at Stapleton Road or Lawrence Hill. A replacement bus will serve these stations.

Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea to Cardiff Central, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0832 Swansea to London Paddington will run slightly later from Swansea to Cardiff Central.

Sunday until approximately 1000 - Trains between Reading, Newbury and Westbury will be subject to alteration or diversion, with some trains replaced by buses for all or part of their journey.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury will run a few minutes later than usual.

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from approximately 2200 until end of service - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton / Exeter St Davids will either be diverted to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, or will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey.

Saturday 13 to Friday 19 April 2024

Monday to Thursday - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, and will then be diverted to run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. An alternative rail connection will be available from Didcot Parkway to Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will terminate at Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill and restart from Oxford. A non-stop replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford to connect into the train. A separate replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill, calling at intermediate stations to Oxford. There will be no onward connection at Oxford to London Paddington out of this bus.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, and will not call at Southampton Central. Most trains will call additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. On **Saturday**, alternative rail services operated by SWR will run between Romsey and Southampton Central. On **Sunday**, replacement buses will run between Southampton Central and Eastleigh, to connect into/out of diverted trains at Eastleigh.

Saturday - The 0705 Westbury to Southampton Central will terminate at Salisbury and the 0830 Southampton Central to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Salisbury. **Sunday** - The 1740 Cardiff Central and 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will both terminate at Westbury. In all cases, passengers should travel on alternative earlier or later services.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Reading and Redhill / Gatwick Airport will be reduced to hourly, and will be replaced by buses between Guildford and Shalford.

Monday until approximately 1000 - A few trains will not run for all or part of their journey or a change of train en-route at Guildford will be required.

Monday to Thursday - The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.

Tuesday to Friday until approximately 0600 - The first two trains from Reading to Redhill / Gatwick Airport will be replaced by buses from Reading to Guildford.

Sunday - The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and the 0747 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, calling at all stations except Reading West.

Sunday - The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will terminate at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 2345 Didcot Parkway to Slough;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading.

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0700 Slough to Reading, 0636 Reading to London Paddington and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

Sunday - The 0818 & 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington and 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
