


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. **Sunday** - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to / from central London.

- Sunday All day, services to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for all or part of their journey. Some trains may depart EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, but will be part replaced by additional trains running between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Most trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway only.
- Sunday until approximately 1430 Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. Most trains FROM London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. For other journeys, alternative rail connections will be available via Bristol Temple Meads.
- From approximately 2130 Saturday until 1430 Sunday Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central will either not run, or will be diverted to terminate at / start from Bristol Parkway, not serving stations in south Wales. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central (on Saturday only), or between Bristol Parkway and Newport, with alternative rail connections between Newport and Cardiff Central (on Sunday only). Passengers should check their journeys before travelling.
 - **Monday to Thursday** The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will terminate at Port Talbot Parkway. Replacement buses will run from Port Talbot Parkway to Neath and Swansea.
 - **Tuesday to Friday** The 0341 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Passengers travelling from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway or Bridgend should travel on a later service.
 - Sunday The 0806 Reading to Newbury will be replaced by a bus, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0834 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury. The 0751 London Paddington to Penzance will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Westbury and will not call at Newbury and Pewsey. The 0851 London Paddington to Penzance will depart EARLIER and will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey.
- **Wednesday** The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.
- Sunday The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive at Exeter St Davids slightly later than usual. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart from Exeter St Davids slightly EARLIER than usual.
- Tuesday to Friday The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart a few minutes EARLIER than usual.
- **Tuesday to Friday** The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary. Passengers travelling from Yeovil Pen Mill should travel on a later service.

- Sunday The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke will be replaced by a single bus at 0737 from Reading. The 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will be replaced by a bus at 0747 from Basingstoke. These buses will not serve Reading West. In addition, most local trains between Reading and Basingstoke will run 1 minute later than usual, to maintain connections with retimed trains running through Reading.
- **Tuesday to Thursday** The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
- Saturday All day, buses will replace trains between Cheltenham Spa and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street.

 Sunday Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cheltenham Spa and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street will be replaced by buses between Gloucester and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street. A revised rail service will run between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa.
 - **Monday to Thursday** The 2340 (**Monday to Wednesday**) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and 0019 (**Tuesday to Thursday**) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will be replaced by buses.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

- B Tuesday to Thursday 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington; Friday 0045 London Paddington to Reading;
 - In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
 - **The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday** 0649 Ealing Broadway to Reading, 0636 Reading to London Paddington and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
- The following trains will not call at Pangbourne: Sunday 0738, 2233 & 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway, 0818 Didcot Parkway to Reading and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; Friday 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway. In both cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
