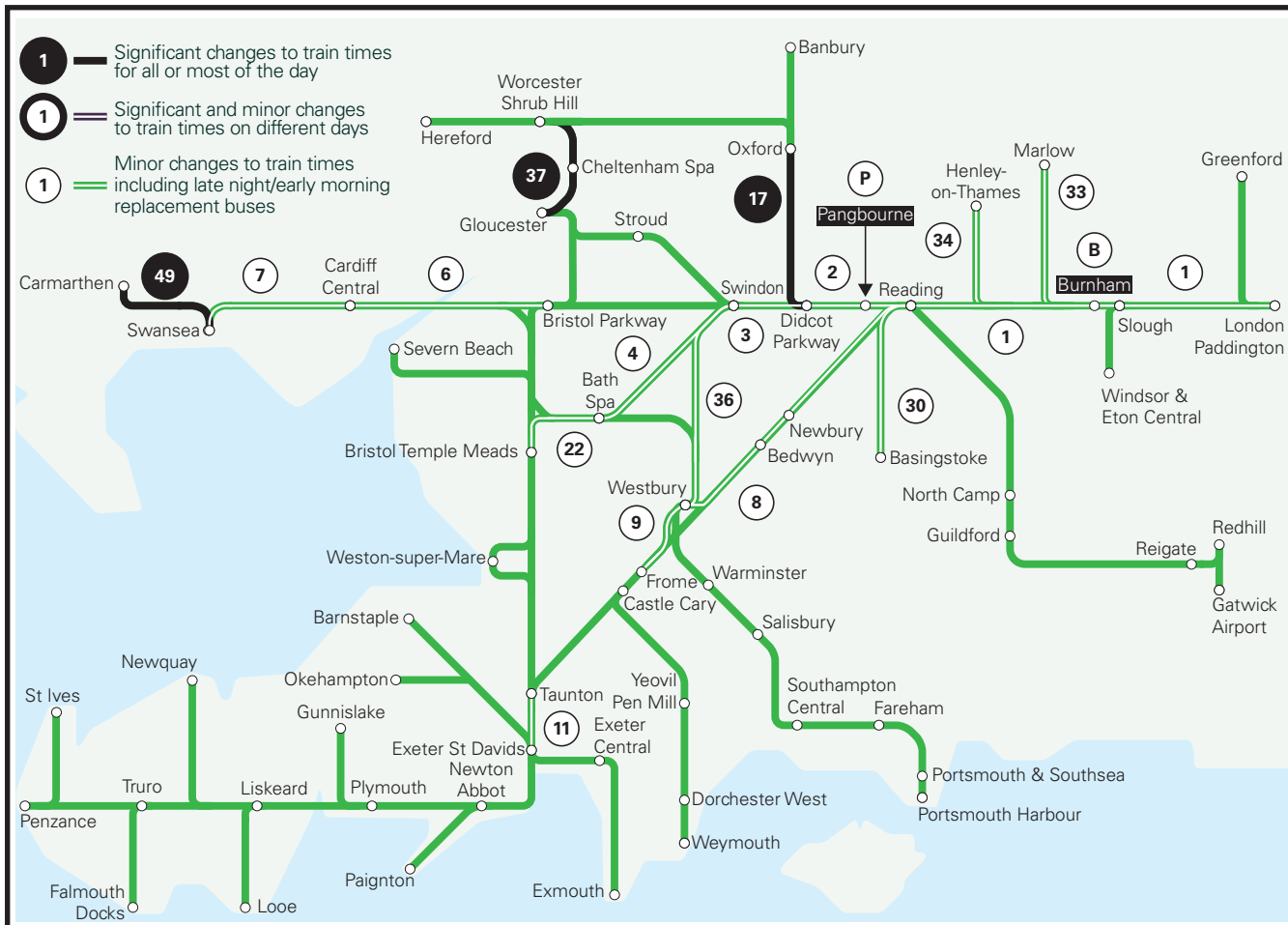


Summary of timetable changes

- Saturday** - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway.
- Sunday until approximately 0800** - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading will depart EARLIER at 0013 and a later train will run at 0120 from Ealing Broadway to Reading. The 0638 London Paddington to Reading and 0738 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will start from Ealing Broadway. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use TfL Central line services to complete their journeys to / from central London, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.
-
- Sunday** - The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will divert after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Passengers for Didcot Parkway should travel on an alternative local service from Reading. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham.
-
- Sunday** - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea and intermediate stations to Cardiff Central.
- Thursday** - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will divert after Cardiff Central and run approximately 25-30 minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea. The 2030 Carmarthen to Bristol Parkway will divert after Bridgend and run approximately 25-30 minutes later from Cardiff Central to Bristol Parkway.
-
- Sunday** - The 0751 London Paddington to Penzance will be diverted and will not call at Newbury or Pewsey, but will call additionally at Swindon. Passengers travelling to/from Newbury should use later services and travel via Reading. Passengers travelling to/from Pewsey should use replacement buses to/from Swindon, connecting with the train there. The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0834 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Newbury. The 0847 Newbury to Reading will depart at 0855 and run slightly later throughout.
-
- Monday to Thursday** - The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.
-
- Tuesday and Wednesday** - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Taunton and will arrive earlier at Exeter St Davids. The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will depart later from Exeter St Davids and will not call at Taunton. No alternative transport will be provided to or from Taunton.
-
- All week and until further notice** - The line between Didcot Parkway and Oxford will remain closed until 9 June 2023 due to urgent repairs being made to Nuneham Viaduct. - Sunday** - The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and the 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. Replacement buses will run at 0738 from Reading and 0745 from Basingstoke.

- Sunday** - The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will terminate at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.
-
- Tuesday to Thursday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

③⑥ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2230 Swindon to Westbury will not call at Melksham. A replacement bus will run from Chippenham to Melksham, Trowbridge and Westbury.

③⑦ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Gloucester, Cheltenham Spa and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street.

④⑨ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Sunday - 0034 (departing 0018) London Paddington to Reading and 0120 Ealing Broadway to Reading;

Tuesday to Friday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington.

Ⓑ In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Sunday - *The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:*

0638 London Paddington (starting Ealing Broadway) to Reading, 0620 Reading to London Paddington (terminating Ealing Broadway) and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington.

Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:

Ⓟ **Sunday** - 0738 London Paddington (starting Ealing Broadway) to Didcot Parkway, 0818 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington, 2233 & 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Friday - 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway.

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
