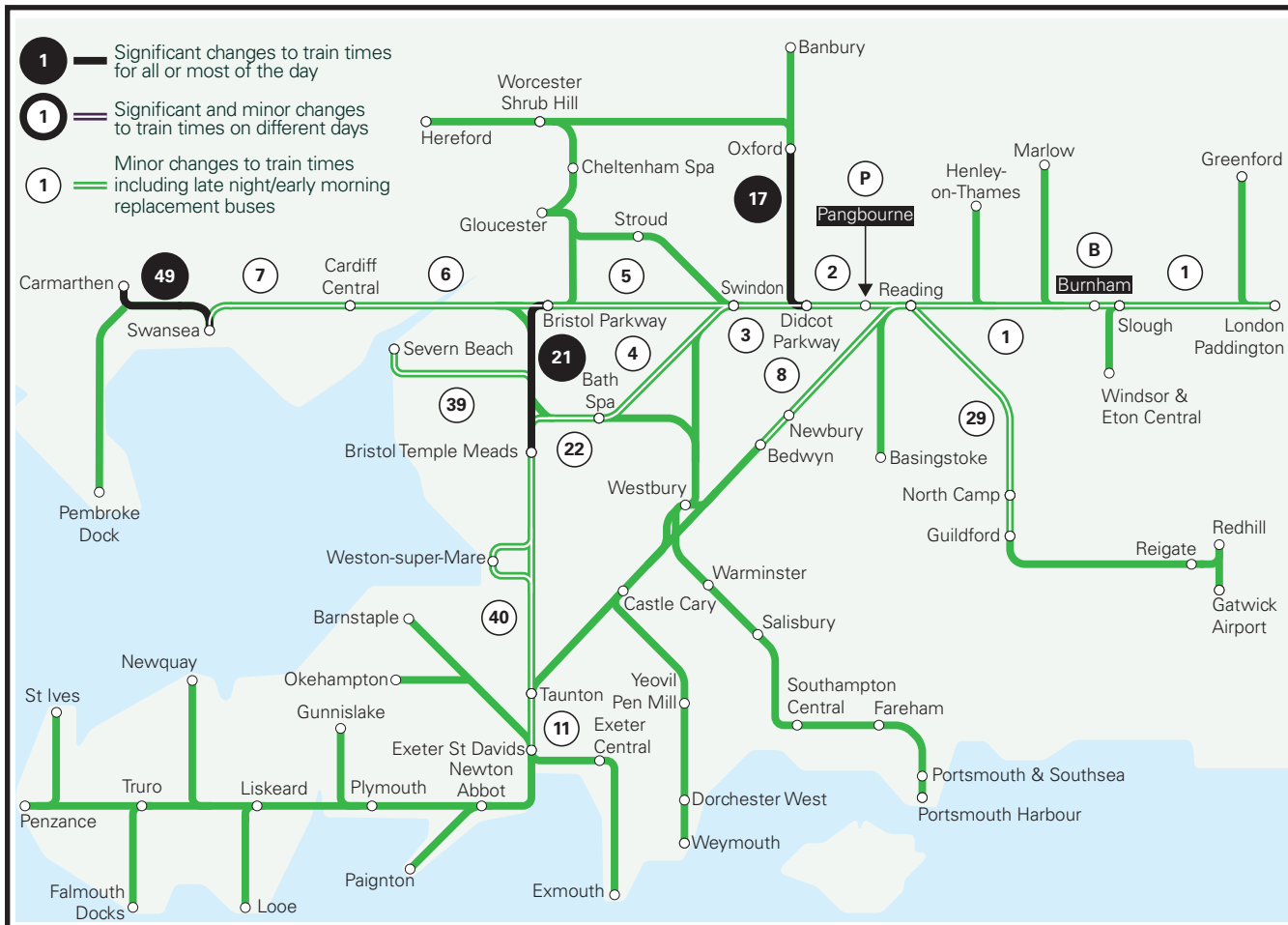


Summary of timetable changes

- ① ② **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2100 until end of service each evening** - Some High Speed and local stopping trains will incur a few minutes extra running time between Reading and Didcot Parkway.
-
- ② ③ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2314 London Paddington to Oxford will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will divert after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham, from Didcot Parkway to Swindon and from Swindon and Chippenham to Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads.

- ⑤ ⑥ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run approximately 20 minutes later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.

- ⑦ **Sunday** - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea and intermediate stations to Cardiff Central. The 0832 Swansea to London Paddington will depart at 0840 and run slightly later as far as Cardiff Central.
- Monday to Thursday** - The 2048 London Paddington to Swansea will run a few minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.

- ⑧ **Saturday** - The 2341 Newbury to Bedwyn will be replaced by a bus. **Sunday** - The 0018 Reading to Newbury will be replaced by a bus.

- ⑪ ④① **Monday to Thursday** - The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will run slightly later throughout.
- Tuesday to Thursday** - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive slightly later at Taunton and Exeter St Davids.
- ⑪ **All week and until further notice** - The line between Didcot Parkway and Oxford will remain closed until 9 June 2023 due to urgent repairs being made to Nuneham Viaduct. Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford.

- ⑫ ③⑨ **Saturday** - All day, local stopping trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood (calling at Lawrence Hill and Stapleton Road) will not run. A few other trains will also not call at Lawrence Hill or Stapleton Road. A few other trains will be subject to minor retimings, in most cases departing a few minutes EARLIER than usual.

- ⑲ **Sunday** - The 0603 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Guildford, departing EARLIER than usual.

- ④⑨ **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.
-
- ① **Saturday** - **The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:** 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

- ① **Saturday** - The 0003 Banbury to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
