


## Summary of timetable changes

## Saturday 3 to Friday 9 June 2023

- 12 Friday All day, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be retimed, in some cases EARLIER than usual, between London Paddington, Reading and Swindon.
- Monday to Wednesday The 2228 & 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Swindon to run non-stop to Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run from Swindon to Chippenham and Bath Spa, and from Chippenham to Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads.
- Friday All day, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be reduced to an hourly frequency, and will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway, but calling additionally at Gloucester (to pick up only on trains towards South Wales and to set down only on trains towards London Paddington). A limited direct service will continue to run between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway, otherwise passengers should travel via Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

**Saturday and Monday to Friday** - Local trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Lawrence Hill and Stapleton Road will generally only be served by trains running between Bristol Temple Meads and Avonmouth / Severn Beach. Some early morning and late evening journeys on Monday to Friday only will be replaced by buses. Most other trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central will be retimed by a few minutes (except on Friday, when they will be more significantly amended - see item below).

- **Monday and Tuesday** The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run a few minutes later from Patchway to Bristol Temple Meads.
  - **Friday** All day, trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central will either be diverted to run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway only, or will not run. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport, with rail connections between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway, and between Newport and Cardiff Central. Some early morning and late evening services will be replaced by buses throughout. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**
- Sunday The 2046 & 2146 London Paddington to Swansea will run a few minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.

  Monday to Thursday The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will run up to 25 minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.
- 7 49 Friday Due to trains being diverted between Swindon and Newport, most GWR trains to Swansea / Carmarthen will be subject to minor retimings.
- Saturday The 2341 Newbury to Bedwyn will be replaced by a bus.
  Sunday The 0018 Reading to Newbury and 2323 Newbury to Reading will be replaced by buses.
- Monday to Wednesday The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will terminate at Westbury. Replacement buses will run instead.
- Monday to Thursday from approximately 2215 until end of service each evening Trains running via Tiverton Parkway will be subject to extended journey times of up to 20 minutes.

## Saturday 3 to Friday 9 June 2023

- All week The line between Didcot Parkway and Oxford will remain closed due to urgent repairs being made to Nuneham Viaduct.

  Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford.

- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, buses will replace trains between Great Malvern and Hereford. There will also be some minor changes to other GWR services between Worcester and Great Malvern.
- 20 37 Monday to Wednesday The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will run non-stop from Swindon to Gloucester. A replacement bus will serve intermediate stations via Stroud.
- Sunday All day, buses will replace trains between Southampton Central, Fareham and Portsmouth Harbour. Passengers making local journeys between Fratton, Portsmouth & Southsea and Portsmouth Harbour should use other operators' rail services. The 1737 Worcester Foregate Street to Portsmouth Harbour will terminate at Westbury and the 1740 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will only run from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury.
- Sunday All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and North Camp. A reduced, hourly train service will run between Blackwater / North Camp, Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport.
- Tuesday to Friday The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will run from Twyford to Reading.

## The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading

- **Tuesday to Friday** 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
  - **Sunday** *The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:* 0638 London Paddington to Reading and 0620 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
  - **Monday to Thursday** The last trains each evening to call at Pangbourne will be the 1935 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and the 2038 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. After this time, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
- (P) Tuesday to Friday The 0003 Banbury to Reading and 0355 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Friday The 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne.

In both cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
