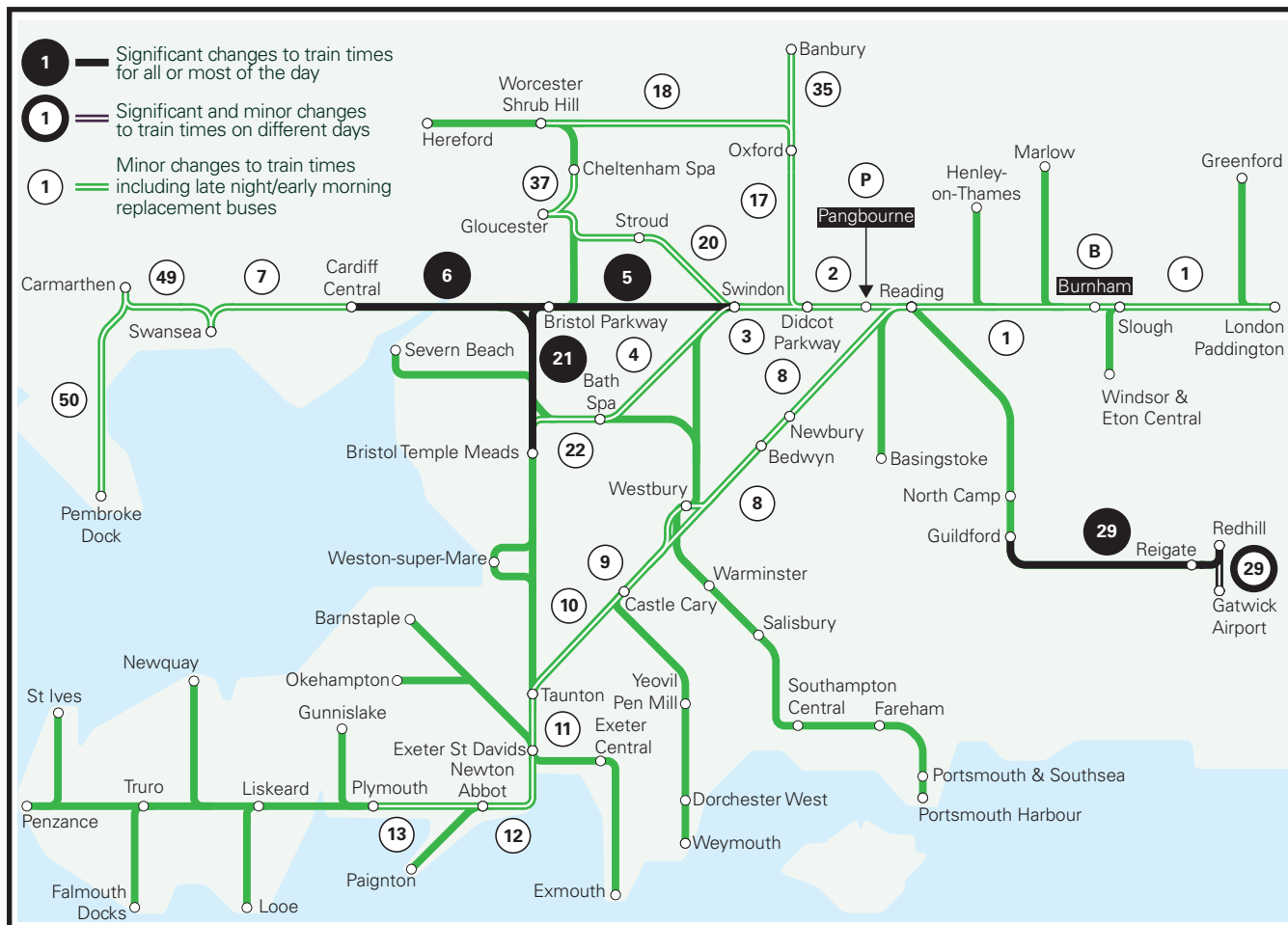


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 10 to Friday 16 June 2023

① **Sunday until approximately 2300** - Many High Speed and local stopping trains from London Paddington will depart up to 3 minutes EARLIER than usual from London Paddington.

① ② **All week** - There will be some retimings to trains between London Paddington, Reading and Swindon, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere.

② ①⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway (for a rail connection to Oxford) and will then run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will terminate at Oxford. Replacement buses will run from Oxford to Worcester. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill and restart from Oxford. A non-stop replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford to connect into the train. A separate bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill calling at all stations to Oxford, but there will be no onward connection to London Paddington out of this bus.

④ ⑤ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will not run. Trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads via Chippenham and Bath Spa will be reduced to hourly. A special hourly service will run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads via Bristol Parkway. Some additional trains will also run between London Paddington, Reading, Swindon and Bristol Parkway and a few other trains will either be retimed or will not run. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway, Newport and Cardiff Central. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

⑤ ⑥ **Monday to Friday** - All week, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be reduced to an hourly frequency, and will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway, but calling additionally at Gloucester (to pick up only on trains towards South Wales and to set down only on trains towards London Paddington). A limited direct service will continue to run between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway, otherwise passengers should travel via Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

⑥ ②① **Saturday and Monday to Friday** - Local trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Lawrence Hill and Stapleton Road will generally only be served by trains running between Bristol Temple Meads and Avonmouth / Severn Beach. Some early morning and late evening journeys on Monday to Friday only will be replaced by buses.

⑥ ②① **All week** - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central will either be diverted to run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway only, or will not run. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport (and Cardiff Central on Saturday and Sunday), with rail connections between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway (and between Newport and Cardiff Central on Monday to Friday). Some early morning and late evening services will be replaced by buses throughout. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

- 7 49** **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, a special hourly GWR service will run between Cardiff Central and Swansea, with some trains extended to/from Carmarthen. GWR trains to/from Pembroke Dock will run between Swansea and Pembroke Dock only.
- 50** **Monday to Friday** - Due to trains being diverted between Swindon and Newport, most GWR trains running to Swansea / Carmarthen will be subject to minor retimings.

- 8** **Saturday** - The 2341 Newbury to Bedwyn will be replaced by a bus.
Sunday - The 0018 Reading to Newbury will be replaced by a bus.

- 8 9** **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2000 until end of service each evening** - Long-distance services between London Paddington and the West of England will be diverted between Reading and Westbury, not calling at Newbury, Hungerford or Pewsey. Most trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn will not run. Replacement buses will run instead for all affected services. In some cases, it will be necessary to travel EARLIER than usual to maintain connections.

- 20 37** **Saturday** - The 0732 London Paddington to Cheltenham Spa will start from Swindon.
Sunday - Some trains from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will run slightly later than usual, to maintain connections out of retimed trains from London Paddington.

- 29 29** **Saturday** - The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will run from Redhill to Gatwick Airport.
Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Chilworth will be served by a separate shuttle bus between Guildford, Shalford and Gomshall. Passengers travelling between Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use alternative rail services, operated by Southern and Thameslink.

- 35** **Sunday** - The 0945 Oxford to Banbury will be replaced by a bus departing EARLIER at 0905. The 1025 Banbury to Oxford will be replaced by a bus.
Tuesday to Friday - The 0003 Banbury to Reading will run as two separate trains: 0003 Banbury to Oxford and 0045 Oxford to Reading.

- B** **Saturday** - **The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:** 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
Sunday - **The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:** 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 Reading to London Paddington and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

- P** **Saturday** - The 0003 Banbury to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
