


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 17 to Friday 23 June 2023

- 1 2 All week There will be some retimings to some trains between London Paddington, Reading and Swindon, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere.
- (2) (17) Monday to Thursday from approximately 2345 until 0430 next day Late evening trains from London Paddington to Oxford will arrive slightly later at Oxford. Buses will replace local trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford.
 - Saturday and Sunday All weekend, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be reduced to an hourly frequency, and will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. A few trains will call additionally at Gloucester (to pick up only on trains towards South Wales and to set down only on trains towards London Paddington). A limited direct service will continue to run between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway, otherwise passengers should travel via Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
 - **Saturday** All day, local trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Lawrence Hill and Stapleton Road will generally only be served by trains running between Bristol Temple Meads and Avonmouth / Severn Beach.
- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central will either be diverted to run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway only, or will not run. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport, with rail connections between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway, and between Newport and Cardiff Central. Some early morning and late evening services will be replaced by buses throughout. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
- **Saturday and Sunday** Due to trains being diverted between Swindon and Newport, most GWR trains to Swansea / Carmarthen will be subject to minor retimings.
 - Sunday The 0751 London Paddington to Penzance will be diverted and will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. The 0851 London Paddington to Penzance will depart EARLIER at 0844 and will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey. The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0834 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Newbury. The 0847 Newbury to Reading will depart at 0855 and run slightly later throughout.
 - **Saturday** The 2215 Bristol Temple Meads (starting 2200 from Bristol Parkway) to Frome will terminate at Westbury. The 2316 Frome to Westbury will not run. Replacement buses will run between Westbury and Frome.
- **Tuesday to Friday** The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Frome. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Yeovil Pen Mill to Frome.
 - **Wednesday and Thursday** The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.
- Sunday The 0755 Westbury to Warminster will not run (no replacement transport provided). The 0811 Warminster to Swindon will be replaced by a bus from Warminster to Chippenham departing EARLIER than usual. The 0914 Swindon to Westbury will start from Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available to/from Swindon. The 0840 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads will depart at 0855 and run later throughout.

Saturday 17 to Friday 23 June 2023

- Sunday The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. A replacement bus will run in each direction, departing Reading at 0738 and Basingstoke at 0745. These buses will not serve Reading West. Passengers to/from Reading West should travel on a later service.
- Sunday The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will terminate at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.

 Tuesday to Thursday The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will run from Twyford to Reading.
- The 2340 (**Monday to Wednesday**) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (**Tuesday to Thursday**) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will be replaced by buses.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading

- (B) Tuesday to Friday 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
 - **The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday** 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 Reading to London Paddington and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:

P Sunday - 0738, 2233 & 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway, 0818 & 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington Friday - 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway
In both cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
