


## Summary of timetable changes

## Saturday 24 to Friday 30 June 2023

- Sunday There will be some retimings to some trains between London Paddington, Reading and Swindon, due to engineering work taking place elsewhere. Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will run to a revised timetable and will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway. A limited direct service will continue to run between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway, otherwise passengers should travel via Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Saturday - The 2023 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads. A replacement bus will run from Bristol Temple Meads to Cardiff Central. Stops at Severn Tunnel Junction and Newport will be to set down passengers only. **(6) (21)** Passengers travelling from these stations should use alternative Transport for Wales services. Monday and Tuesday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run a few minutes later from Patchway onwards. Sunday - All day, trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central will either be diverted to run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway only, or will not run. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport, with rail connections between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway, and between Newport and Cardiff Central. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Tuesday to Thursday - The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will terminate at Neath. Replacement buses will run from Neath to Swansea. Wednesday to Friday - The 0341 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Neath. A replacement bus will run from Swansea to Neath. Saturday - The 0508 Reading to Bedwyn will terminate at Newbury. Passengers travelling beyond Newbury will need to use a later train. The 0608 Bedwyn to Reading will start from Newbury. A replacement bus will run from Bedwyn to Newbury, departing EARLIER than usual at 0523. (8) Sunday - The 2323 Newbury to Reading will not run. A replacement bus will run instead. Journey times will be extended. Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening - Buses will replace trains between Reading. Newbury and Bedwyn. Journey times will be extended. 9 22 23
  - Monday to Wednesday The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will depart at 2351 and run a few minutes later throughout.

Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive later at Exeter St Davids at 0344 (Monday morning). The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart EARLIER from Exeter St Davids at 0058 (Monday morning).

Monday to Wednesday - The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will run non-stop from Bristol Temple Meads to Taunton and will run later from Taunton onwards. A replacement bus will run from Bristol Temple Meads from Bridgwater, calling at all stations via Weston-super-Mare.

## Saturday 24 to Friday 30 June 2023

- Monday to Thursday The 2121 Bristol Parkway to Portsmouth & Southsea will be diverted after Southampton Central to call additionally at Southampton Airport Parkway 2341 and Eastleigh 2345, and will arrive approximately 10-15 minutes later at Fareham 0011, Fratton 0025 and Portsmouth & Southsea 0028.
  - **Saturday** The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Thameslink, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport.
- Sunday The 0603 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement bus will run EARLIER than usual at 0520 from Reading to Guildford. The 0611 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. An alternative EARLIER rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Gatwick Airport at 0603 to Redhill.
- B Saturday *The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:* 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
- (P) Saturday The 0003 Banbury to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
