


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 1 to Friday 7 July 2023

- Sunday The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Passengers for Didcot Parkway should use alternative local services from Reading. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham.
- Monday to Friday The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run approximately 25-30 minutes
 later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.
 - Sunday The 2046 & 2146 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run a few minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.
 - **Monday to Thursday** The 2048 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run a few minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.
- Monday to Thursday The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury at 0033. A replacement bus will run from Westbury at 0043 arriving Frome at 0103.
 - **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2045 until end of service each evening** Buses will replace trains for all or part of their journeys between Oxford and Moreton-in-Marsh. Journey times will be extended. Passengers travelling on late evening services should check that their journey can still be completed.
 - **Tuesday to Friday** The 0510 Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill will not run. Passengers will need to travel on the next available service, at 0652 from Oxford.
- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, buses will replace trains between Stroud, Stonehouse (Town Hall) and Gloucester. Alternative rail connections will run between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa. A few early morning or late evening services between Swindon and Gloucester / Cheltenham Spa will either not run at all, or will be replaced by buses throughout.
- Monday to Thursday The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER at 2317 and be diverted to run non-stop to and terminate at Gloucester at 0050. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa at 2342, calling at all stations via Stroud.
- **Friday** The 2236 Worcester Shrub Hill to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Gloucester and will arrive later at Bristol Parkway 0030, Fillton Abbey Wood 0039 and Bristol Temple Meads 0048.
- Sunday All day, a reduced hourly service will run between Blackwater, Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Replacement buses will run between Reading and North Camp.
- Tuesday to Thursday The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford at 0030. An alternative rail connection will run from Twyford at 0040 to Reading arriving at 0048.
- **Saturday and Sunday** All weekend, buses will replace trains, at a reduced hourly frequency, between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester.
- **Sunday** All day, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading

Tuesday to Friday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

On Sunday, the following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:

Monday to Wednesday - 2236 & 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway

Tuesday to Thursday - 0003 Banbury to Reading and 0355 Oxford to Reading **Friday** - 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
