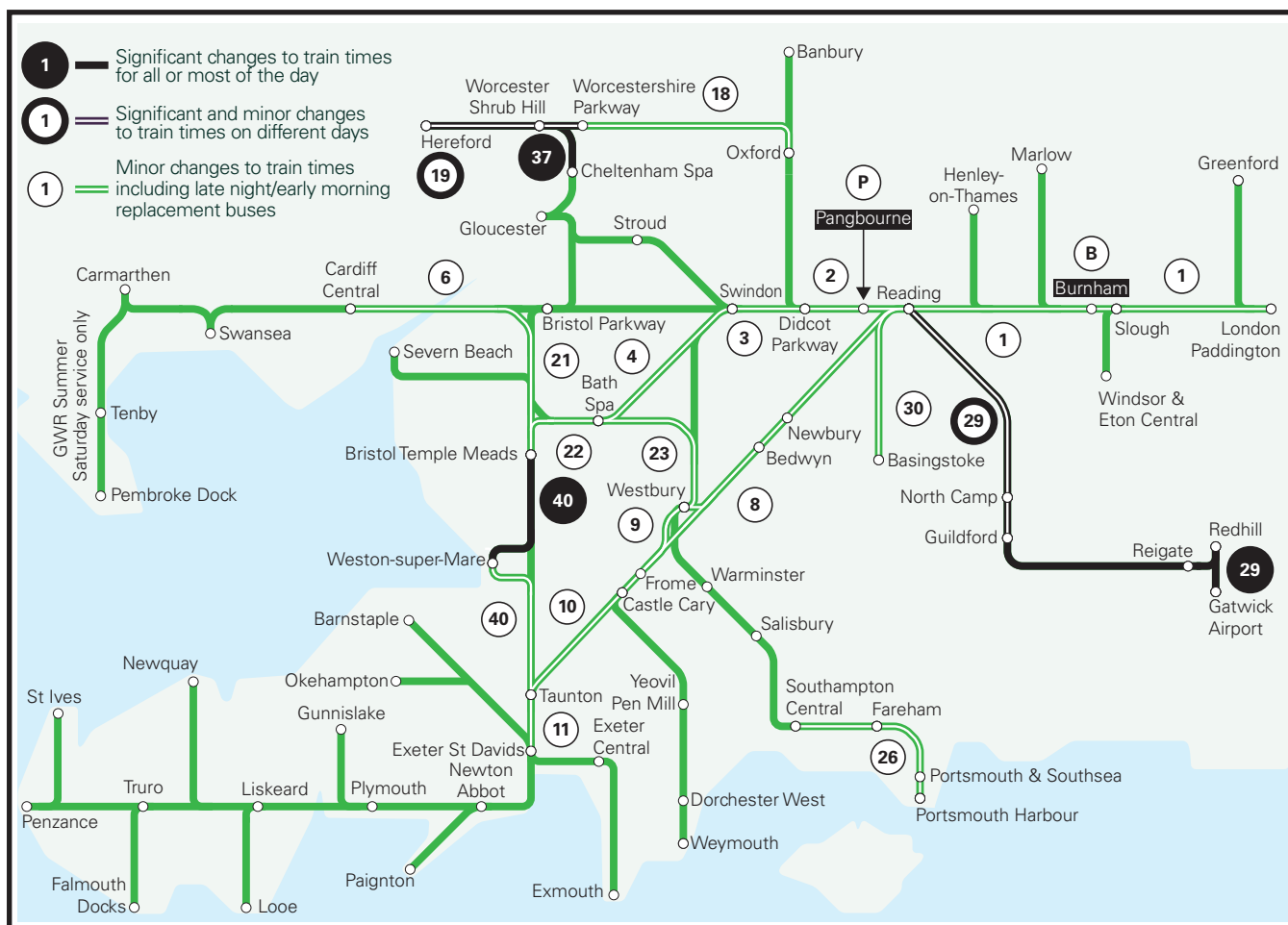


Summary of timetable changes

- Sunday** - The 0851 London Paddington to Penzance will call additionally at Tiverton Parkway. The 1413 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should use alternative services. The 2018 Plymouth to London Paddington will be diverted after Taunton and will not call at Weston-super-Mare, Bristol Temple Meads or Bath Spa, but will call additionally at Westbury. A connecting rail service will run from Bristol Temple Meads and Bath Spa to Chippenham and Swindon.

- Monday to Friday** - The 0600 London Paddington to Penzance will terminate at Bristol Temple Meads. A separate train will run at 0704 from Bristol Temple Meads, calling at Bath Spa, Taunton and then all stations to Penzance. The 1750 Penzance to London Paddington will be diverted after Taunton and will not call at Bristol Temple Meads or Bath Spa, but will call additionally at Westbury (to set down only). A connecting rail service will run from Bristol Temple Meads and Bath Spa to Chippenham and Swindon.

- ⑥ ⑲ **Monday and Tuesday** - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run a few minutes later from Patchway onwards.
-
- Saturday until approximately 0730** - Some trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn will be retimed and some will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey.
- ⑧ **Sunday** - The 2323 Newbury to Reading will be replaced by a bus.
- Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening** - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

㉑ **Sunday** - The 1648 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will depart at 1644 and run a few minutes EARLIER throughout.
- ㉒ **Monday to Friday** - Some trains from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury (and beyond) will run a few minutes EARLIER from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury.

- Sunday to Friday** - Buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare. A **very** limited direct service of trains will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, diverted via an alternative route. Some trains will not run at all and others will only run for part of their journey.
- ⑪ ⑳ **Passengers are strongly advised to check that their whole journey is still possible before travelling, particularly if travelling later in the day.**

- Sunday** - Buses will replace trains between Worcestershire Parkway, Worcester Shrub Hill and Worcester Foregate Street, with some buses extended to / from Great Malvern.
- ⑱ ㉒ The 0815 Worcester Foregate Street (starting 0825 from Worcestershire Parkway) will terminate at Oxford at 0935. An alternative rail connection will be available at 0942 from Oxford to London Paddington.

- ⑱ ㉒ **Monday** - The 0523 Hereford to London Paddington will start from Great Malvern and the 0643 Worcester Shrub Hill to London Paddington will start from Oxford. Passengers should use alternative services.
-
- Sunday** - All day, GWR trains departing from Portsmouth Harbour will be slightly retimed between Portsmouth Harbour and Fratton, in a few cases, departing EARLIER than usual.
- ㉓ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2121 Bristol Parkway to Portsmouth & Southsea will call additionally at Southampton Airport Parkway and Eastleigh, and run later from Fareham onwards.

- ②⑨ **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Guildford. A reduced, hourly service will run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport.
-
- Monday to Thursday** - The 2320 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.
- ②⑨ **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport & 0458 Reading to Redhill will start from Guildford. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Reading to Guildford. The 0531 Reading to Gatwick Airport will depart slightly EARLIER (at 0528) and will call additionally at Crowthorne, Sandhurst, Farnborough North and Ash.
-
- ③⑦ **Sunday** - The 0737 Reading to Basingstoke will be replaced by a bus, departing EARLIER than usual. The bus will not call at Reading West. Passengers travelling to / from Reading West should use an alternative later service.

- ③⑦ **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Cheltenham Spa and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street.

- ④⑦ **Saturday** - The 2100 Cardiff Central to Exeter St Davids will run as two separate trains: 2100 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads and 2152 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids with no connection between the two. Passengers travelling from stations north of Bristol Temple Meads should change into the 2209 departure to Exeter St Davids.
-
- Ⓑ **Saturday** - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

- Ⓟ **Saturday** - The 0003 Banbury to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
