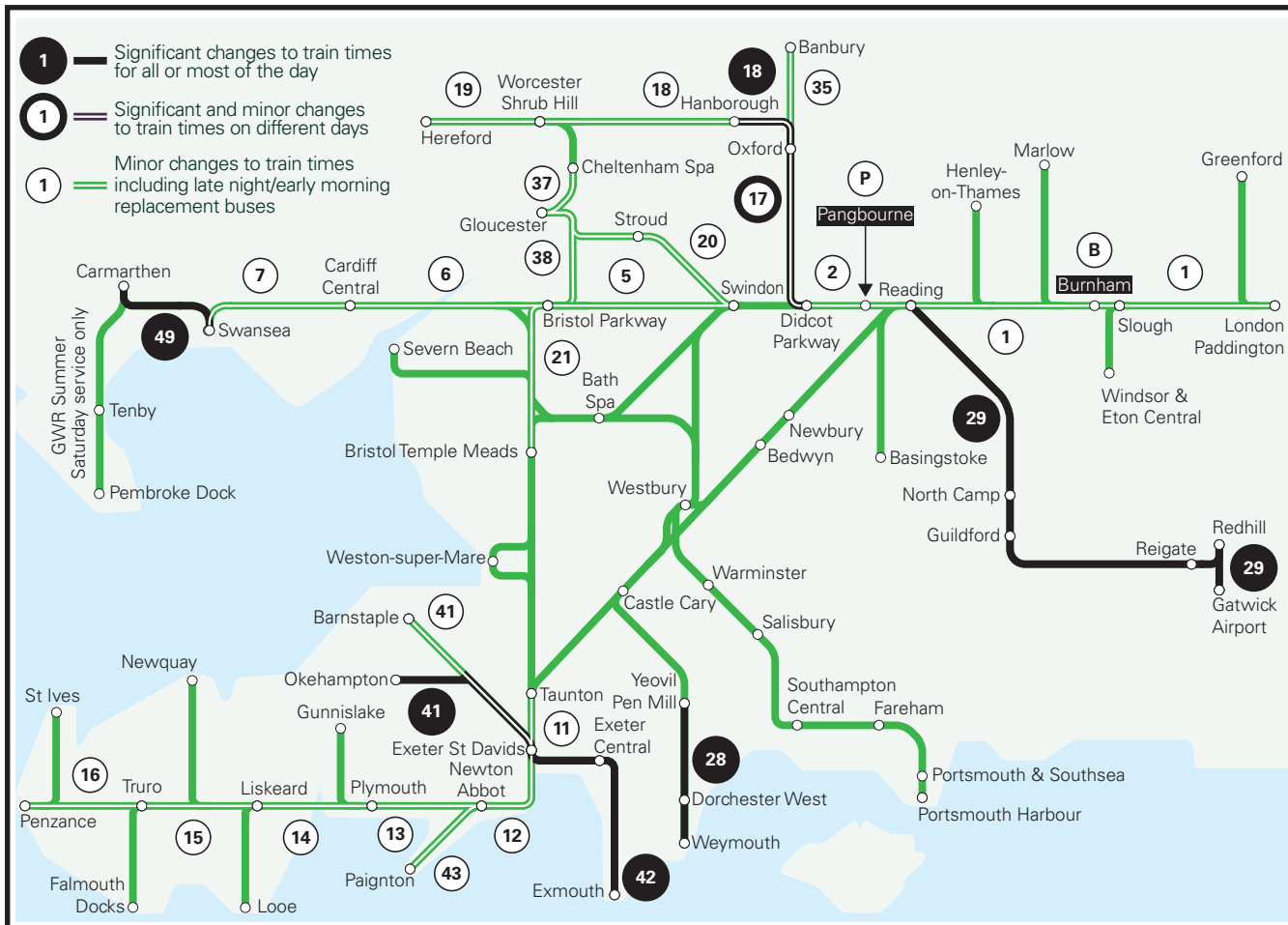


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 14 to Friday 20 October 2023

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use TfL Central line services to complete their journey into central London.

- ① **Sunday** - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway at 0649. Passengers should use TfL Central line services, travelling EARLIER from central London, to connect into the train at Ealing Broadway. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will depart at 0635 and run later throughout.

Saturday - The 2333 London Paddington to Oxford will terminate at Didcot Parkway. A replacement bus will run from Didcot Parkway to Oxford.

⑰ **Sunday** - All day, trains between London Paddington and Oxford will run between London Paddington and Didcot Parkway only and will be retimed. Trains between London Paddington and the North Cotswolds will run between Hanborough and Worcester / Great Malvern / Hereford only. Replacement buses will run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford, between Didcot Parkway and Hanborough and between Oxford and Hanborough. A direct train will run from London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill at 2013 (via Reading and Swindon).

Sunday - Most High Speed services will incur a few minutes extra journey time between London Paddington and Reading. Some trains will depart London Paddington EARLIER than usual. Most local stopping services from London Paddington to Reading and Didcot Parkway will depart a few minutes EARLIER from London Paddington.

⑯ **Monday to Thursday** - The **Night Riviera Sleeper** service (2345 London Paddington to Penzance and 2145 Penzance to London Paddington) will NOT run, and no alternative transport will be provided. Passengers will need to use alternative daytime services.

Monday to Thursday - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway and will then be diverted to run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. A rail connection will run from Didcot Parkway to Oxford, with a replacement bus from Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will terminate at Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill. A replacement bus will run non-stop from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford, connecting into an additional train to London Paddington. A separate replacement bus will also run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford, calling at all stations. There will be no onward connection to London Paddington out of this bus.

⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will run approximately 20-25 minutes later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.

Sunday - All day, a reduced service will run between Exeter St Davids, Newton Abbot and Paignton / Totnes / Plymouth. In addition, the 0813 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids and the 1036 & 1236 London Paddington to Paignton will terminate at Taunton. The 1036 & 1453 Paignton to London Paddington and the 1333 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington will start from Taunton. Passengers should use other services between Taunton and Exeter St Davids / Paignton.

⑪ ⑫ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2100 until end of service** - Some late evening trains will only run for part of their journey.
⑬ ④③ Replacement buses will run instead.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0454 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Exeter St Davids at 0552. Passengers travelling from Plymouth and Newton Abbot should use an alternative later service. The 0533 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Totnes at 0601 and the 0555 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Exeter St Davids at 0652. Replacement buses will run from Plymouth to connect into these trains, departing EARLIER than usual.

⑰ ③⑤ **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0003 Banbury to Reading will run as two separate trains: 0003 Banbury to Oxford and 0045 Oxford to Reading. Passengers will need to change trains at Oxford.

⑱ **Sunday** - The 1138 & 1538 Bristol Temple Meads to Worcester Foregate Street will be extended to Great Malvern. The 1347 Worcester Foregate Street to Bristol Temple Meads and the 1737 Worcester Foregate Street to Portsmouth Harbour will start back from Great Malvern.

⑳ ③⑧ **Monday and Tuesday** - The 2236 Worcester Foregate Street to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Gloucester and run approximately 40 minutes from Bristol Parkway onwards.

㉘ **Monday to Friday** - All week, buses will replace trains between Yeovil Pen Mill, Dorchester West and Weymouth. Passengers travelling northbound from Weymouth and intermediate stations will generally need to travel EARLIER than usual to maintain connections into trains starting from Yeovil Pen Mill.

㉙ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Reading and Guildford. A reduced, hourly service will run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport.

㉛ ㉜ **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids, Exeter Central and Exmouth. Trains between Exeter Central / Exeter St Davids and Okehampton will be retimed, and will generally not serve Exeter Central, but will instead run to / from Paignton. Trains between Exeter Central and Barnstaple will only run between Exeter St Davids and Barnstaple.

㉞ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.

Ⓑ **Saturday** - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Ⓟ **Saturday** - The 0003 Banbury to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
