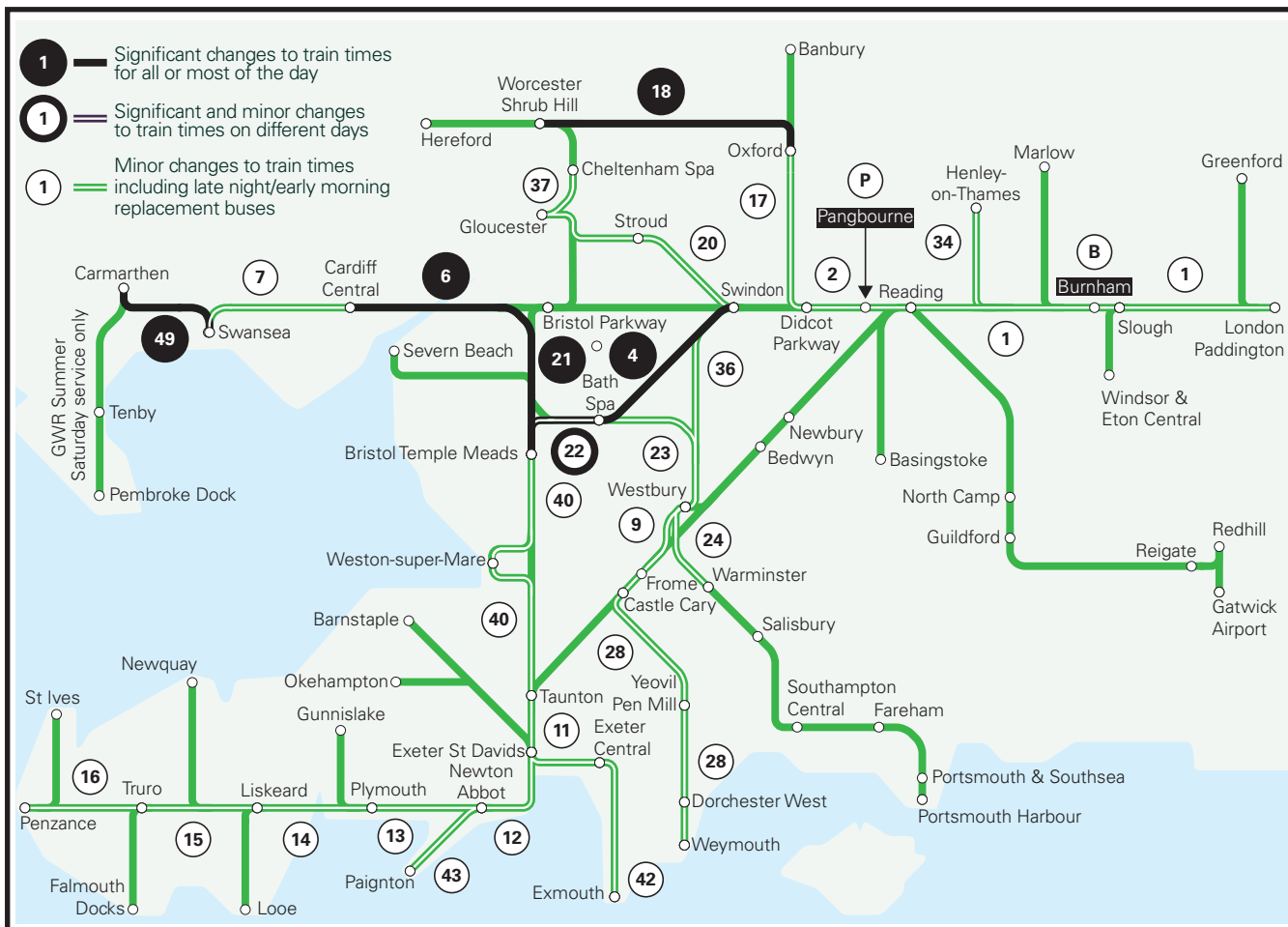


# Summary of timetable changes

# Saturday 21 to Friday 27 October 2023

① **Sunday** - Most High Speed services will incur a few minutes extra journey time between London Paddington and Reading. A few trains will depart London Paddington EARLIER than usual. Most local stopping services between London Paddington and Reading / Didcot Parkway will be retimed by a few minutes between London Paddington and Slough.

**Monday to Thursday** - The **Night Riviera Sleeper** service (2345 London Paddington to Penzance and 2145 Penzance to London Paddington) will NOT run, and no alternative transport will be provided. Passengers will need to use alternative daytime services.

**Monday to Thursday from approximately 2345 until 0430 next day** - Late evening trains from London Paddington to Oxford will arrive slightly later at Oxford. Buses will replace local trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford (including the 0003 Banbury to Reading from Oxford onwards). The 0355 (**Tuesday to Friday**) Oxford to Reading will depart EARLIER from Oxford at 0346. Normal times from Didcot Parkway onwards.

**Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads. A reduced, hourly service will run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads, running non-stop between Swindon and Bristol Temple Meads. A reduced service will run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to/from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. A rail shuttle service will run between Swindon, Chippenham and Bath Spa. A few early morning and late evening services between Swindon / Chippenham and Bath Spa will be operated by buses. Trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Southampton Central / Portsmouth Harbour will generally run between Bath Spa and Portsmouth Harbour only. Other trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury / Frome / Salisbury / Weymouth will either not run at all, or will only run between Bath Spa / Westbury and Frome / Salisbury / Weymouth.

**Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

⑦ **Sunday** - The 2143 & 2243 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run approximately 20-25 minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.

**Monday to Thursday** - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run up to 20-25 minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.

⑨ **Saturday** - The 2312 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.

**Monday to Thursday** - The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.

**Sunday** - The 0836 Exeter St Davids to Penzance will run approximately 10-15 minutes later from Newton Abbot and will terminate at Plymouth. An alternative rail connection will be available from Plymouth to Penzance. The 0825 & 0912 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Totnes at 0852 & 0939 respectively. A single replacement bus will depart from Plymouth at 0755 to connect into the 0852 from Totnes, otherwise, passengers should travel on a later service.

**12 13 Monday to Thursday from approximately 2100 until end of service** - Some late evening trains will only run for part of their journey. Replacement buses will run instead.

**Tuesday to Friday** - The 0454 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Exeter St Davids at 0552. Passengers travelling from Plymouth and Newton Abbot should use an alternative later service. The 0533 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Totnes at 0601 and the 0555 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Exeter St Davids at 0652. Replacement buses will run from Plymouth to connect into these trains, departing EARLIER than usual.

**18 Monday to Thursday** - Buses will replace trains between Charlbury, Kingham and Moreton-in-Marsh. A VERY limited direct service of trains will run between London Paddington, Great Malvern and Hereford, diverted via an alternative route between Reading and Worcester Shrub Hill.

**20 37 Sunday** - The 1500 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington will terminate at Swindon. An alternative rail connection will be available from Swindon to London Paddington.

**22 23 Tuesday to Friday** - The 0701 Salisbury to Bristol Temple Meads will run approximately 7-8 minutes later from Westbury onwards.

**24 36 Sunday** - The 0755 Westbury to Warminster will not run (no replacement transport provided). The 0811 Warminster to Swindon will not run. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Warminster to Chippenham. An alternative rail connection will be available from Chippenham to Swindon. The 0914 Swindon to Westbury will depart at 0918 and run slightly later.

**28 Saturday** - The 0638 Weymouth to Gloucester will start from Yeovil Pen Mill at 0730 and will terminate at Westbury. Passengers travelling from Weymouth and stations to Thornford should travel on the next available service at 0733. (See above for details of alterations to services taking place north of Westbury).

**Tuesday to Friday** - The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Frome. Passengers from Yeovil Pen Mill, Castle Cary and Bruton should travel on the next available service.

**34 Sunday** - Most trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames will be retimed slightly later to maintain connections with trains between London Paddington, Twyford and Reading.

**Tuesday to Friday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

**42 Monday to Thursday** - The 2340 (**Monday to Wednesday**) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (**Tuesday to Thursday**) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will be replaced by buses.

**43 Sunday** - The 1036 Paignton to London Paddington will start from Newton Abbot at 1055. Passengers travelling from Paignton, Torquay and Torre should use an alternative service.

**49** **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.

***The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:***

**Saturday** - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

**Sunday** - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

**B** **Tuesday to Friday** - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington.

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

**Sunday** - ***The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:*** 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington.

Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

***The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:***

**Monday to Thursday** - 2236 & 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 23:24 Didcot Parkway to Reading;

**P** **Tuesday to Friday** - 0355 (departing 0346) Oxford to Reading;

**Friday** - 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
