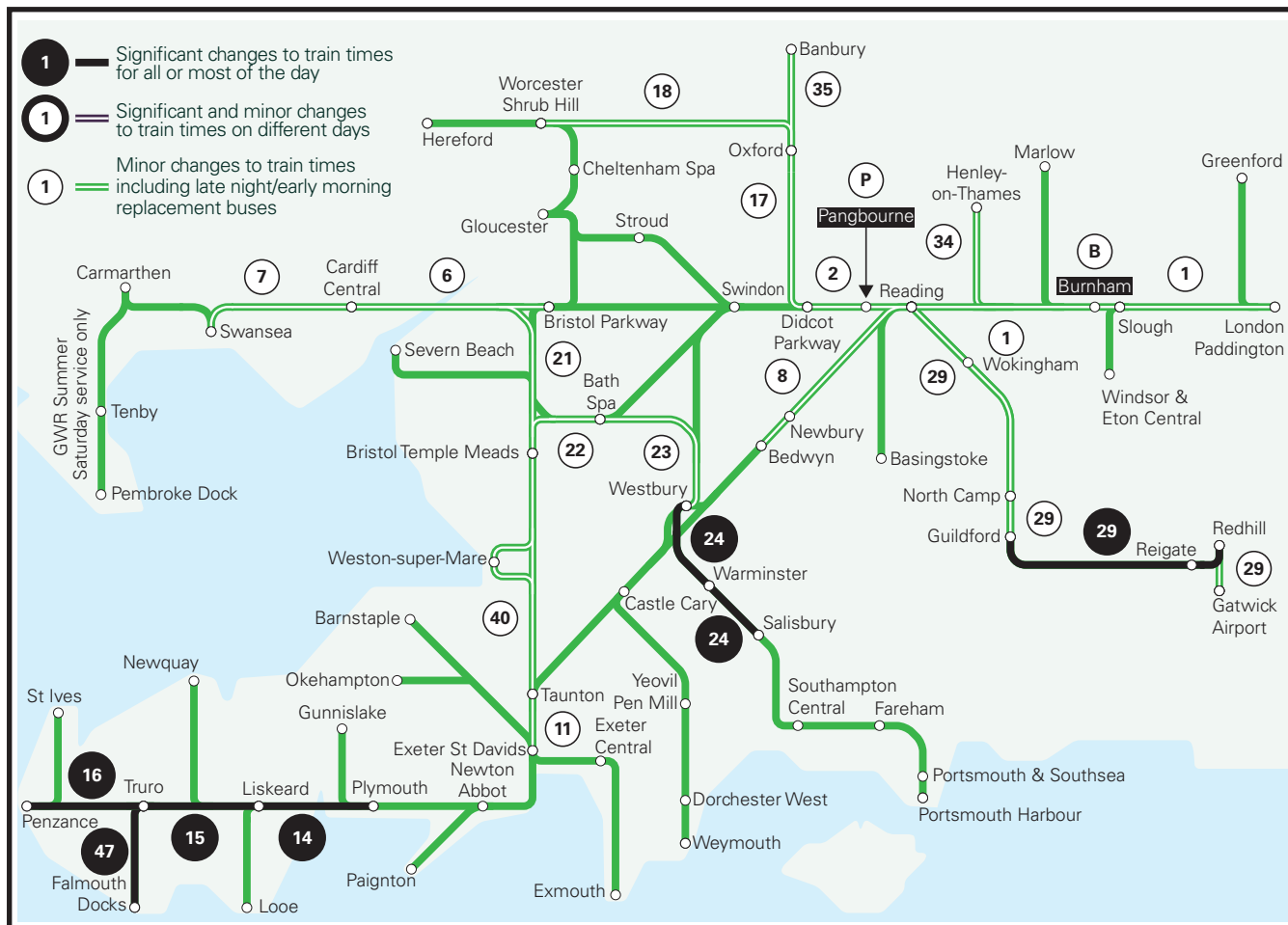


# Summary of timetable changes

# Saturday 28 October to Friday 3 November 2023

- ① ② **Sunday** - Some High Speed services will be retimed between London Paddington and Reading. The 0844 London Paddington to Great Malvern and 2149 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will run later throughout. Some local stopping trains from London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will run slightly later from Slough to Reading.
- 
- ⑥ ⑦ **Sunday** - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central and run slightly later as far as Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will run from Swansea and intermediate stations to Cardiff Central, departing EARLIER than usual.
- 
- ⑥ ②① **Monday and Tuesday** - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run slightly later from Patchway onwards.  
**Monday to Thursday** - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will not call at Stapleton Road or Lawrence Hill. A replacement bus will serve these stations.
- 
- Saturday until approximately 0730** - Some trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn will be retimed and some will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey.
- ⑧ **Sunday** - The 2323 Newbury to Reading will not run and will be replaced by a bus.  
**Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening** - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.

- ①① ④① **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 each evening until end of service** - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare, Taunton and Exeter St Davids will either not run, or will be diverted to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton. Buses will serve intermediate stations via Weston-super-Mare.

- Monday** - The 1400 Cardiff Central to Penzance, and the 1703 & 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will all terminate at Plymouth. Alternative rail / bus connections will be available.
- ①④ ①⑤  
①⑥ **Tuesday to Friday** - Buses will replace trains between St Austell and St Erth / Penzance. A revised, reduced, train service will run between Plymouth and St Austell. In most cases, a change of train at Plymouth will be necessary for passengers travelling to / from stations east of Plymouth. A special rail shuttle service will run between St Erth and Penzance.
- 
- ①⑦ ③⑤ **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0003 Banbury to Reading will run as two separate trains: 0003 Banbury to Oxford and 0045 Oxford to Reading. Passengers will need to change trains at Oxford.

- ②② ②③ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2304 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury will depart at 2308 and run slightly later throughout.
- 
- ②④ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Westbury, Warminster and Salisbury. A separate minibus shuttle will run between Westbury and Dilton Marsh, with the exception of the first bus from Warminster to Westbury and the last bus from Westbury to Warminster on Sunday, both of which will call at Dilton Marsh. A few trains will not run at all.

## Saturday 28 October to Friday 3 November 2023

---

**Saturday** - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Wokingham. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Wokingham, departing EARLIER than usual. The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which GWR tickets will be accepted.

②9 **Monday to Thursday** - The 2320 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.

**Tuesday to Friday** - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport and the 0458 Reading to Redhill will start from Guildford. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Guildford, departing EARLIER than normal. The 0531 Reading to Gatwick Airport will depart at 0528 and run slightly earlier as far as Guildford.

②9 **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford and Redhill at a reduced, hourly frequency. Passengers should use alternative rail services, operated by Southern and Thameslink, to complete their journey to/from Gatwick Airport, on which GWR tickets will be accepted. A few late evening buses will also be extended to/from Gatwick Airport.

③4 **Sunday** - Most trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames will be retimed slightly later to maintain connections with trains between London Paddington, Twyford and Reading. The 2200 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

④7 **Tuesday to Friday** - Buses will replace trains between Truro and Falmouth Docks.

⑤ **Saturday** - The 0045 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

**Sunday** - The 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

⑥ **Saturday** - The 0003 Banbury to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
