


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 4 to Friday 10 November 2023

- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, due to engineering work taking place in the Bristol Parkway area, some trains to/from London Paddington will be retimed (in some cases EARLIER than usual). Some trains will not run or will only run for part of their journey.
- **Sunday** All day, some trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads / Weston-super-Mare / Taunton will not run, or will only run for part of their journey. Some trains from Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington will run slightly later than usual.

All day Saturday and from approximately 1700 Sunday - Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Bristol Parkway. Most trains from London towards South Wales will depart EARLIER than usual from London Paddington, Reading (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon. Some trains will not run or will only run for part of their journey.

- Until approximately 1700 Sunday Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted between Swindon and Newport, not calling at Bristol Parkway, but calling additionally at Patchway. Replacement buses will run between Patchway and Bristol Parkway. Some trains will not run or will only run for part of their journey.
- **Saturday and Sunday** All weekend, due to engineering work taking place in the Bristol Parkway area, some trains to/from Swansea and Carmarthen will be subject to minor retimings.
 - Sunday The 0751 (departing 0752) London Paddington to Penzance (terminating at Plymouth) will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and will be replaced by a bus, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0834 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury, connecting out of the earlier bus from Reading. The 0851 London Paddington to Penzance (terminating at Plymouth) will depart slightly EARLIER from London Paddington and Reading and will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey. The 0847 Newbury to Reading will run a few minutes later than usual.
 - Monday to Thursday The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between St Austell and St Erth / Penzance. A revised, reduced, train service will run between Plymouth and St Austell. In most cases, a change of train at Plymouth will be necessary for passengers travelling to / from stations east of Plymouth. A special rail shuttle service will run between St Erth and Penzance.

Monday to Friday - All week, buses will replace trains between Plymouth and Penzance, between Liskeard and St Austell and between St Austell and Penzance. A reduced train service will run between Plymouth and Liskeard. A special rail shuttle service will run between St Erth and Penzance.

Journey times will be considerably extended. Passengers should check before travelling, especially when travelling later in the day, that their whole journey is still possible.

- (17) 35 Saturday and Tuesday to Friday The 0003 Banbury to Reading will run as two separate trains: 0003 Banbury to Oxford and 0045 Oxford to Reading. Passengers will need to change trains at Oxford.
- **Saturday and Sunday** All weekend, buses will replace trains between Kemble and Gloucester. A revised rail service will run between Swindon and Kemble. Alternative rail services will be available between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa.

- **Saturday** All day, buses will replace trains, at a reduced hourly frequency, between Gloucester and Bristol Parkway. **Sunday** All day, buses will replace trains between Gloucester, Bristol Parkway and Bristol Temple Meads.
- **Sunday** The 1737 Worcester Foregate Street to Portsmouth Harbour will terminate at Gloucester and the 1740 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will terminate at Westbury. Passengers should use alternative services.
- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, GWR trains via Southampton Central will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, not calling at Southampton Central, but calling additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Replacement buses will run between Eastleigh and Southampton Central, connecting with diverted trains at Eastleigh.
- Sunday All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford and Redhill at a reduced, hourly frequency. Passengers should use alternative rail services, operated by Southern and Thameslink, to complete their journey to/from Gatwick Airport, on which GWR tickets will be accepted. A few late evening buses will also be extended to/from Gatwick Airport.
- Monday to Friday The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Gatwick Airport. Monday to Thursday The 2320 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Redhill. A replacement bus will run from Redhill to Guildford, with a connecting rail service from Guildford to Reading.
- Sunday The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke will be replaced by a single bus at 0728 from Reading to Basingstoke. The 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will be replaced by a bus at 0745 from Basingstoke to Reading. Buses will not call at Reading West. Passengers travelling to / from Reading West should use alternative later services.
- **Sunday** -The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will terminate at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.
- **Tuesday to Thursday** The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
- Monday to Friday The 1631 Barnstaple to Axminster will terminate at Exeter Central. A replacement bus, provided by SWR, will run from Exeter Central to Axminster.
- Sunday To maintain connections with retimed mainline services at Plymouth, the 1110 & 1520 Plymouth to Gunnislake and 1210 & 1611 Gunnislake to Plymouth will run later than usual.
- Saturday from approximately 1345 To maintain connections with retimed mainline services at Liskeard, some trains between Liskeard and Looe will run later than usual.
- **Saturday from approximately 1200** To maintain connections with retimed mainline services at Par, some trains between Par and Newquay will run later than usual.
- Sunday To maintain connections with retimed mainline services at Par, all trains between Par and Newquay will run later than usual.

 Monday to Friday All week, replacement buses will run between St Austell (rather than Par) and Newquay. Passengers travelling to/from Par should change buses at St Austell.
- Sunday to Friday All week, buses will replace trains between Truro and Falmouth Docks.

Saturday - The 0045 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Sunday -The 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

(P) Saturday - The 0003 Banbury to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
