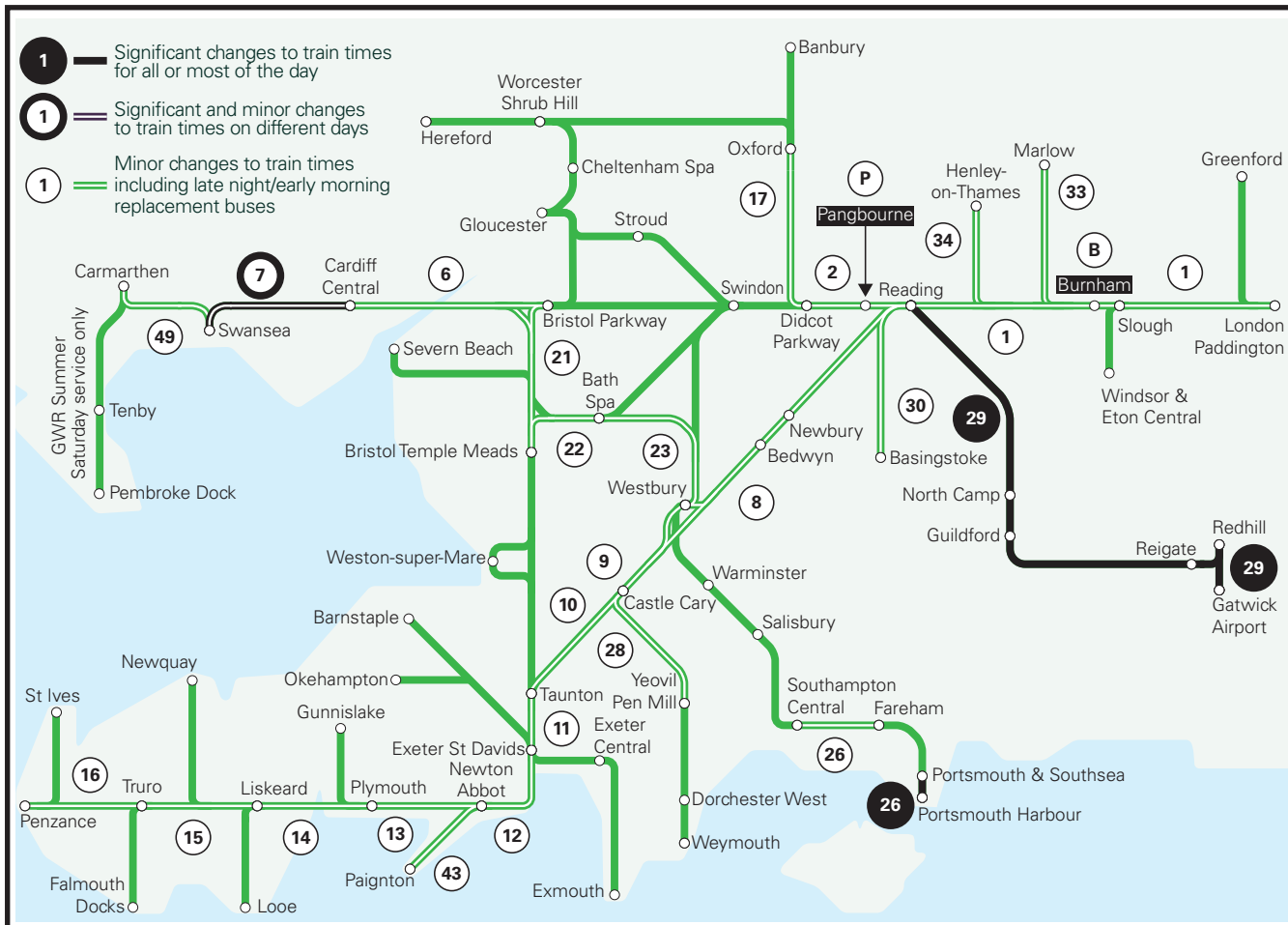


# Summary of timetable changes

- Sunday** - All day, most High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will only run between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Trains calling at Radley will be retimed. Some local stopping trains between Didcot Parkway, Reading and London Paddington will be retimed by a few minutes.

①⑦ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2330 until 0400 next morning each night** - Trains from London Paddington to Oxford will arrive slightly later at Oxford. Local services between Didcot Parkway and Oxford will be replaced by buses. The 0003 Banbury to Reading will be replaced by a bus from Oxford to Reading. The 0355 Oxford to Reading will run EARLIER from Oxford to Didcot Parkway.

⑯ **Monday to Thursday** - The **Night Riviera Sleeper** service (2345 London Paddington to Penzance and 2145 Penzance to London Paddington) will NOT run, and no alternative transport will be provided. Passengers will need to use alternative daytime services.

- ⑥ ⑳ **Sunday until approximately 1145** - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central will either not run at all, or will be diverted to terminate at / start from Bristol Parkway, not serving stations in Wales. Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will not run between Bristol Parkway and Cardiff Central. Buses will run between Bristol Temple Meads / Bristol Parkway and Newport / Cardiff Central.

- ⑦ **Saturday** - The 1818 London Paddington to Swansea will terminate at Cardiff Central. Passengers travelling beyond Cardiff Central should use the next available service.

- ⑦ ④⑨ **Sunday** - All day, trains will be diverted between Cardiff Central and Bridgend, extending journey times. Most GWR trains to / from Carmarthen will run as separate trains between Swansea and Carmarthen.

㉒ ㉓ **Saturday** - Due to SWR diverting their Salisbury to Yeovil Junction services via Westbury and Castle Cary, there will be consequent retimings to some GWR services running through the Westbury area. In some cases, trains will run up to 20 minutes later for all or part of their journey. The 0733, 0930 & 1130 Weymouth to Gloucester will not call at Oldfield Park.
- ㉔ ㉕ **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary and run later as far as Westbury. Passengers travelling from Yeovil Pen Mill should use the next available service.
- 
- ⑧ **Sunday** - The 0751 London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. The 0851 London Paddington to Penzance will depart EARLIER and call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey. The 0806 Reading to Newbury will be replaced by a bus and the 0834 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury. The 0847 Newbury to Reading will run later than usual.

- ⑨ **Saturday** - The 2312 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury.
- ⑨ **Monday and Tuesday** - The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. In all cases, replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.

---

**Sunday until approximately 0930** - Trains will be subject to minor retimings. The 0825 & 0912 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Totnes at 0852 & 0939 respectively. A replacement bus will run from Plymouth at 0755 to connect into the 0853 from Totnes; otherwise passengers should travel on a later service.

**Monday to Thursday from approximately 2100 until end of service** - Some late evening trains will only run for part of their journey.

⑫ ⑬ Replacement buses will run instead.

**Tuesday to Friday** - The 0454 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Newton Abbot at 0530. Passengers travelling from Plymouth should use an alternative later service. The 0533 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Totnes at 0601 and the 0555 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Exeter St Davids at 0652. Replacement buses will run from Plymouth to connect into these trains, departing EARLIER than usual.

**Sunday until approximately 1600** - Buses will replace trains between Portsmouth & Southsea and Portsmouth Harbour.

⑳ ㉔ **Sunday** - The 1737 Worcester Foregate Street to Portsmouth Harbour will not call at Southampton Airport Parkway, Eastleigh, Hedge End and Botley, and will run EARLIER from Fareham to Portsmouth Harbour.

㉑ **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Guildford. A reduced, hourly, train service will run between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport.

⑳ **Sunday** - The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and the 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. A replacement bus will run in each direction, departing EARLIER than usual, calling at all stations except Reading West. Passengers travelling to / from Reading West should use alternative later services.

⑳ **Sunday** - The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will terminate at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.

⑳ **Tuesday to Thursday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

⑳ **Sunday** - The 1036 Paignton to London Paddington will start from Newton Abbot. Passengers from Paignton, Torquay and Torre should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.

**The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:**

**Saturday** - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

**Sunday** - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

Ⓑ **Tuesday to Thursday** - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington;

**Friday** - 0045 London Paddington to Reading;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

**Sunday - The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:** 0620 Reading to London Paddington, 0638 London Paddington to Reading and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

**The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:**

Ⓟ **Sunday** - 0738, 2233 & 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 0818 & 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

**Friday** - 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway. In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
