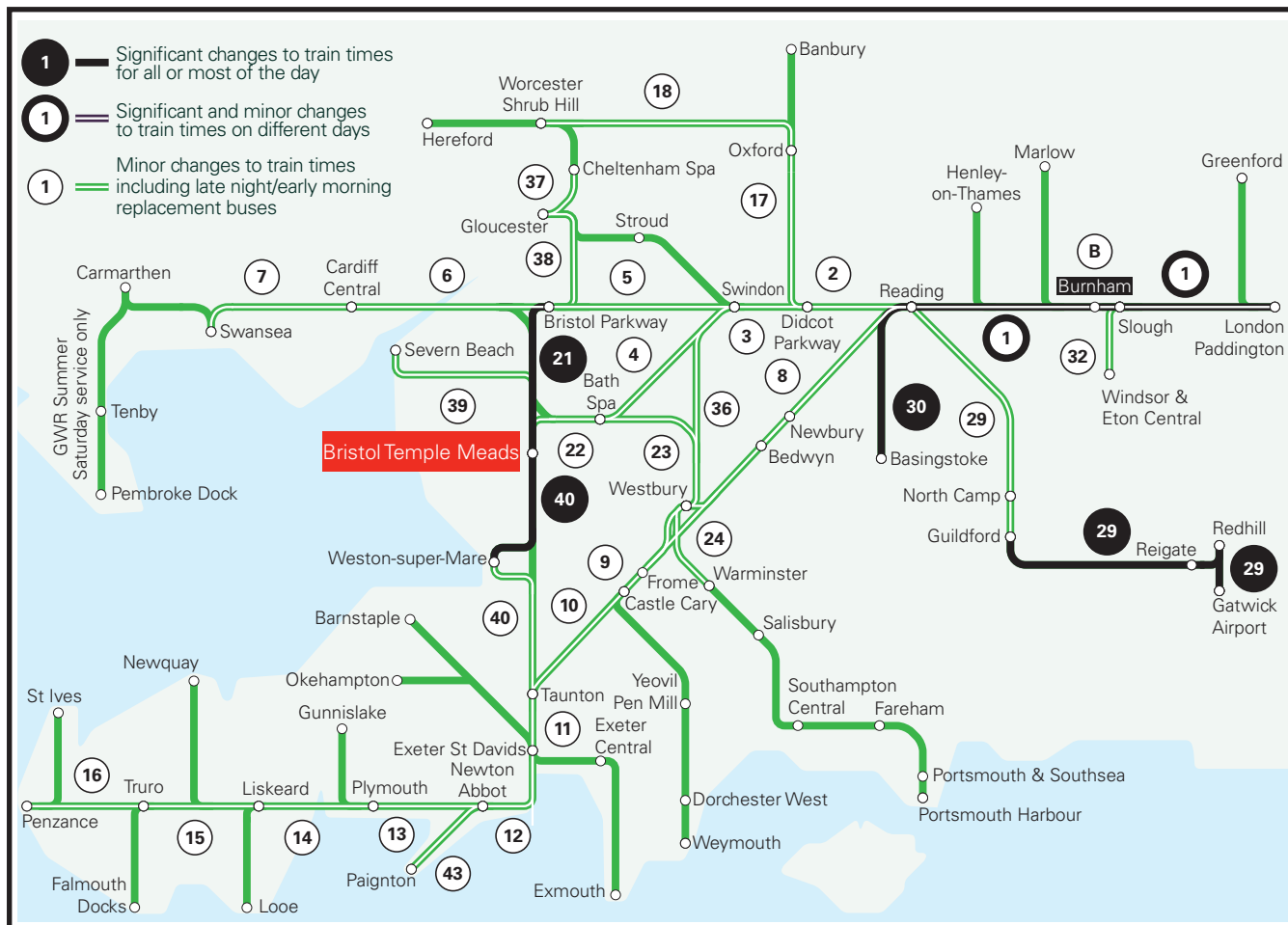


Summary of timetable changes

1 2	Sunday - All day, services to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for all or part of their journey. Some trains may depart EARLIER than usual. Most trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway only.
1 11 12 13 14 15 16	Monday to Thursday - The Night Riviera Sleeper service (2345 London Paddington to Penzance and 2145 Penzance to London Paddington) will NOT run. No alternative transport will be provided. Passengers will need to use alternative daytime services.
2 3 4 5 17	From approximately 2215 Saturday until approximately 1030 Sunday - Services between Reading, Didcot Parkway and Swindon / Oxford will be revised. Some longer-distance services will be diverted and will not call at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Most local services will be replaced by buses between Reading, Didcot Parkway and Oxford.
6 21	Saturday and Monday to Friday - Local trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Other trains will call additionally at Lawrence Hill and Stapleton Road.
8 9 10 11	Saturday - The 1235 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will terminate at Taunton. The 1343 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington will start from Taunton at 1502 and run later throughout. Sunday - The 1333 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington will not run. The 1314 Plymouth to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary, Westbury and Pewsey.
8	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn.
9 22 23 24 36	Saturday to Friday - Some trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury / Frome will be subject to minor retimings. Sunday - Early morning trains through Westbury will be retimed or replaced by buses for all or part of their journey. The 2230 Cardiff Central to Warminster will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Warminster.
11	Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER from Exeter St Davids.
12 13	Sunday until approximately 1000 - Some trains will be subject to minor retimings. The 0825 & 0912 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Totnes at 0852 & 0939 respectively. A replacement bus will run from Plymouth at 0755 to connect into the 0853 from Totnes; otherwise passengers should travel on a later service. Monday to Thursday - The 2104 London Paddington to Plymouth will terminate at Exeter St Davids. A replacement bus will run from Exeter St Davids to Plymouth.
17 18	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2230 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Oxford and Worcester Shrub Hill.

	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. On Sunday, trains between Reading and Guildford will be retimed.
29 29	Monday to Thursday - The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.
	Tuesday to Friday until approximately 0600 - Trains from Reading to Redhill / Gatwick Airport will be replaced by buses from Reading to Guildford, or will be retimed.
30	Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Buses will not call at Reading West. Reading West passengers should use alternative rail services.
32	Sunday - The 1918 Windsor & Eton Central to Slough will depart EARLIER at 1914. The 1928 Slough to Windsor & Eton Central will depart at 1932.
37 38	Sunday - The 1037 Bristol Temple Meads to Gloucester will run approximately 25 minutes EARLIER throughout. The 1054 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington will start from Gloucester. The 1141 Gloucester to Bristol Temple Meads will start back from Cheltenham Spa at 1054 (to provide a connection for London Paddington).
39	Saturday and Monday to Friday - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Avonmouth and Severn Beach will be subject to minor retimings and will not run to/from Weston-super-Mare.
40 40	Saturday to Friday - All week, buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare. Bedminster and Parson Street will not be served, and passengers should use alternative local buses. Some early morning and late evening trains between Weston-super-Mare and Taunton will also not run or will be replaced by buses. A very limited direct service of trains will continue to run between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, running non-stop between the two.
43	Sunday - The 1036 Paignton to London Paddington will start from Newton Abbot. Passengers from Paignton, Torquay and Torre should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.
B	Saturday - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

On Monday 22 and Tuesday 23 January, due to restricted platform capacity at Bristol Temple Meads, some trains between Gloucester and Westbury / Weymouth will not run between Bristol Parkway and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers will need to change trains en-route to complete their journey if travelling through Bristol Temple Meads.
