


## Summary of timetable changes

## Saturday 3 to Friday 9 February 2024

- Saturday The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. Sunday The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to/from central London. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will run later than usual.
- Sunday All day, services to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for all or part of their journey. Some trains may depart EARLIER than usual. Most trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway only.

- 12 (13) Monday to Thursday - The Night Riviera Sleeper service (2345 London Paddington to Penzance and 2145 Penzance to
- (14) (15) London Paddington) will NOT run. No alternative transport will be provided. Passengers will need to use alternative daytime services.

- 23 Monday to Thursday - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will run approximately 20-25 minutes later from Bristol Parkway onwards. The 2314 London Paddington to Oxford will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. The 2332 London Paddington to
- 4 5 6 7 22 Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. A replacement bus will run from Didcot Parkway to Swindon and Chippenham: for other journeys, passengers will need to travel on alternative EARLIER services.
- Wednesday and Thursday The 2048 & 2148 London Paddington to Swansea will be subject to minor retimings beyond Bridgend.
- Saturday Local trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Other trains will call additionally at 6 21 Lawrence Hill and Stapleton Road.
- Sunday The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea to **(7**) Cardiff Central, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0832 Swansea to London Paddington will be retimed throughout.
- Saturday until approximately 0700 Early morning trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn will be revised, with buses (8) replacing trains for some journeys.
  - Sunday The 2323 Newbury to Reading will not run and will be replaced by a bus.
- Saturday The 1235 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will terminate at Taunton. The 1343 Exeter St Davids to (8)(9)London Paddington will start from Taunton at 1502 and run later throughout.
- Sunday The 1333 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington will not run. The 1314 Plymouth to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary, Westbury and Pewsey.
- 9 22 **Saturday** - Some trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury / Frome will be subject to minor retimings. **23**

## Saturday 3 to Friday 9 February 2024

**Sunday until approximately 1000** - Some trains will be subject to minor retimings. The 0825 & 0912 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Totnes at 0852 & 0939 respectively. A replacement bus will run from Plymouth at 0755 to connect into the 0853 from Totnes; otherwise passengers should travel on a later service.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2100 until end of service - Some late evening trains will only run for part of their journey.

Replacement buses will run instead.

**Tuesday to Friday** - The 0454 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Newton Abbot at 0530. Passengers travelling from Plymouth should use an alternative later service. The 0533 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Totnes at 0601 and the 0555 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Exeter St Davids at 0652. Replacement buses will run from Plymouth to connect into these trains, departing EARLIER than usual.

- Sunday All day, buses will replace trains between Kemble and Gloucester. A rail shuttle service will run between Swindon and Kemble. Passengers should use other scheduled rail services to travel between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa.
- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, buses will replace trains between Reading and North Camp. A reduced, hourly service will run between Blackwater and Redhill / Gatwick Airport.

**Monday to Thursday** - The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.

- Tuesday to Friday until approximately 0600 Early morning trains from Reading to Redhill / Gatwick Airport will be replaced by buses from Reading to Guildford, departing EARLIER than usual.
  - **Friday** The 2020 Reading to Shalford and 2130 Shalford to Reading will not run. Passengers should use alternative earlier or later services. The 2054 Reading to Gatwick Airport will call additionally at Crowthorne, Sandhurst, Farnborough North, Ash and Shalford.
- **Sunday** The 1918 Windsor & Eton Central to Slough will depart EARLIER at 1914. The 1928 Slough to Windsor & Eton Central will depart at 1932.
- **Saturday** Some trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Avonmouth and Severn Beach will be subject to minor retimings.
- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare. Bedminster and Parson Street will not be served, and passengers should use alternative local buses. Some early morning and late evening trains between Weston-super-Mare and Taunton will also not run or will be replaced by buses. A very limited direct service of trains will continue to run between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, running non-stop between the two.
- Monday and Tuesday The 2054 Exmouth to Barnstaple will terminate at Crediton. The 2241 Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids will not run at all. Replacement buses will run instead. Yeoford will be served by a separate minibus shuttle to / from Crediton only.
- Sunday The 1036 Paignton to London Paddington will start from Newton Abbot. Passengers from Paignton, Torquay and Torre should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.
- B Saturday The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
