


Summary of timetable changes

- 1 11 12 13 Monday to Thursday - The Night Riviera Sleeper service (2345 London Paddington to Penzance
 - Monday to Thursday The Night Riviera Sleeper service (2345 London Paddington to Penzance and 2145 Penzance to
 London Paddington) will NOT run. No alternative transport will be provided. Passengers will need to use alternative daytime services.
 - Monday to Thursday The 2228 & 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Swindon to run non-stop to Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will serve Chippenham and Bath Spa.
 - 6 21 Monday and Tuesday The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run approximately 7 minutes later from Patchway onwards.
 - Monday to Thursday The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.
 - Monday to Wednesday The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Bath Spa. A replacement bus will run from Bath

 Spa to Frome.
 - **Thursday** The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. Replacement buses will run from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and Frome. The 2222 Southampton Central to Bristol Temple Meads will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads.
 - **Sunday until approximately 1000** Some trains will be subject to minor retimings. The 0825 & 0912 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Totnes at 0852 & 0939 respectively. A replacement bus will run from Plymouth at 0755 to connect into the 0853 from Totnes; otherwise passengers should travel on a later service.
 - Monday to Thursday from approximately 2100 until end of service Some late evening trains will only run for part of their journey.

 Replacement buses will run instead.
 - **Tuesday to Friday** The 0454 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Newton Abbot at 0530. Passengers travelling from Plymouth should use an alternative later service. The 0533 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Totnes at 0601 and the 0555 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Exeter St Davids at 0652. Replacement buses will run from Plymouth to connect into these trains, departing EARLIER than usual.
- Monday to Thursday The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will be diverted via Bristol Parkway. A replacement bus will serve intermediate stations via Kemble and Stroud.
 - Saturday and Monday to Friday Most local trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Some other trains will call additionally at Lawrence Hill and Stapleton Road, otherwise passengers should travel on alternative services.
- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, buses will replace trains between Bath Spa and Westbury. A revised rail service will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bath Spa.
- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, a revised and slightly reduced service will run between Westbury, Warminster and Salisbury.

 Monday to Friday All week, due to engineering work taking place between Southampton Central and Portsmouth Harbour, a few trains will not run between Westbury, Salisbury and Southampton Central.

Saturday 10 to Friday 16 February 2024

- Monday to Friday All week, buses will replace trains between Southampton Central, Fareham and Portsmouth Harbour. Journey times will be extended.
- Saturday to Friday All week, trains will be reduced in frequency and will run between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport only.

 Replacement buses will run between Reading and Guildford. On **Sunday**, most trains will only run between Guildford and Redhill.

 Alternative rail connections provided by other operators will be available between Redhill and Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
- Tuesday to Friday The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, buses will replace trains between Westbury and Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon.
- Sunday The 1036 Paignton to London Paddington will start from Newton Abbot. Passengers from Paignton, Torquay and Torre should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

B Tuesday to Friday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington. In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Sunday - *The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:* 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following GWR trains will not call at Pangbourne:

Monday to Thursday - 2236 & 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2324 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

(P) Tuesday to Friday - 0355 Oxford to Reading;

Friday - 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
