


Summary of timetable changes

- Saturday The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. Sunday The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to/from central London.
- Sunday All day, services to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for all or part of their journey. Some trains may depart EARLIER than usual. Most trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway only.

- Monday to Thursday The Night Riviera Sleeper service (2345 London Paddington to Penzance and 2145 Penzance to
- London Paddington) will NOT run. No alternative transport will be provided. Passengers will need to use alternative daytime services.
- **Sunday** The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea to Cardiff Central, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0832 Swansea to London Paddington will be retimed throughout.
- Monday to Thursday The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway onwards.
- (8) Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn.
- **Sunday until approximately 1430** A reduced service will run between Taunton and Exeter St Davids. Some trains will be subject to minor retimings. The 1050 Penzance to Cardiff Central will not call at Weston-super-Mare.
 - **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2100 until end of service** Some late evening trains will only run for part of their journey. Replacement buses will run instead.
- Tuesday to Friday The 0454 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Newton Abbot at 0530. Passengers travelling from Plymouth should use an alternative later service. The 0533 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Totnes at 0601 and the 0555 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Exeter St Davids at 0652. Replacement buses will run from Plymouth to connect into these trains, departing EARLIER than usual.
 - Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway then run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. An alternative rail connection will run from Didcot Parkway to Oxford. The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will call additionally at Shipton and will terminate at Moreton-in-Marsh.
- (17) (18) A replacement bus will run from Moreton-in-Marsh to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will terminate at Worcester Shrub Hill. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill non-stop to Oxford, connecting into a train to Didcot Parkway, Reading, Slough and London Paddington. A separate replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford calling at intermediate stations. There will be no onward connection to London Paddington out of this bus.
- Monday to Thursday The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart earlier and run non-stop to and terminate at Gloucester. A replacement bus will serve intermediate stations via Kemble and Stroud.

Saturday - Most local trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Some other trains will call additionally at Lawrence Hill and Stapleton Road.

Monday to Thursday - The 2236 Worcester Shrub Hill to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Gloucester and will run approximately 40 minutes later from Bristol Parkway onwards.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Bath Spa and Westbury. A revised rail service will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Bath Spa.

Saturday - The 0539 Portsmouth & Southsea to Bristol Temple Meads will not run and the 0608 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central

will start from Southampton Central and terminate at Westbury.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, a revised and slightly reduced service will run between Westbury, Warminster and Salisbury.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Reading, Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport. Journey

times will be extended.

Monday - The 0445 Redhill to Gatwick Airport will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative service*. The 0511

Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. An alternative EARLIER rail connection* will be available from Gatwick Airport to Redhill (* - provided by another operator: valid GWR tickets will be accepted).

Tuesday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement bus will run non-stop from Reading to Guildford, departing EARLIER than the train.

Friday - The 2020 Reading to Shalford and 2130 Shalford to Reading will not run. Passengers should use alternative earlier or later services. The 2054 Reading to Gatwick Airport will call additionally at Crowthorne, Sandhurst, Farnborough North, Ash and Shalford.

- **Sunday** The 0737 Reading to Basingstoke will not run. Passengers should travel on a later service.
- **Sunday** The 1918 Windsor & Eton Central to Slough will depart EARLIER at 1914. The 1928 Slough to Windsor & Eton Central will depart at 1932.
- Saturday and Sunday All weekend, buses will replace trains between Westbury and Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon.
- Sunday All day, trains between Exeter St Davids and Okehampton will be retimed. Some trains (until approximately 1430) will be extended to run to/from Newton Abbot and Paignton.
- **Sunday until approximately 1430** Buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids and Exeter Central.
- The 1036 London Paddington to Paignton will terminate at Taunton and the 1036 Paignton to London Paddington will start from Taunton. Passengers should use other services, changing en-route where necessary, to complete their journey.
- **Saturday** The 0045 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
