


Summary of timetable changes

18 910	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, long-distance services between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will be diverted and will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. Some trains will also not call at Westbury or Castle Cary. Most trains from London Paddington and Reading will depart EARLIER than usual. Trains between London Paddington, Reading and Newbury / Bedwyn will be replaced by buses between Reading and Newbury. Trains between Newbury and Bedwyn will be retimed. Pewsey will be served by replacement buses to / from Swindon. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling .
7	 Monday to Thursday - The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will terminate at Port Talbot Parkway. Replacement buses will run from Port Talbot Parkway to Neath and Swansea. Tuesday to Friday - The 0341 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Passengers travelling from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend should use the next available service.
9	Wednesday and Thursday - The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.
12 43	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, direct trains between London Paddington and Paignton will not run.
(13)(14) (15)(16)	 Sunday - The 0947 Penzance to Plymouth and the 1340 Plymouth to Penzance will not run. Other trains will make additional stops. The 1800 (departing 1806) London Paddington to Plymouth will terminate at Newton Abbot and the 1502 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Newton Abbot. A few other trains will be subject to minor retimings. Monday - The 1359 Cardiff Central to Penzance and the 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will terminate at Plymouth. Passengers should travel forward on alternative services. The 1703 London Paddington to Penzance will terminate at Plymouth with a rail connection from Plymouth to Penzance.
14 15 16	Tuesday to Friday - Buses will replace trains between St Austell and St Erth / Penzance. A revised and reduced rail service will run between Plymouth and St Austell. In most cases, passengers travelling to/from stations east of Plymouth will need to change trains at Plymouth. A rail shuttle service will run between St Erth and Penzance. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling .
(17)	 Saturday from approximately 2245 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Sunday - The 0754 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers travelling from Oxford should use the next available service. Monday to Thursday - The 2314 London Paddington to Oxford will arrive slightly later at Oxford. Tuesday to Friday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart slightly EARLIER from Oxford.
28	Tuesday to Friday - The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary. Passengers travelling from Yeovil Pen Mill should use the next available service, changing en-route where necessary to complete their journey.
