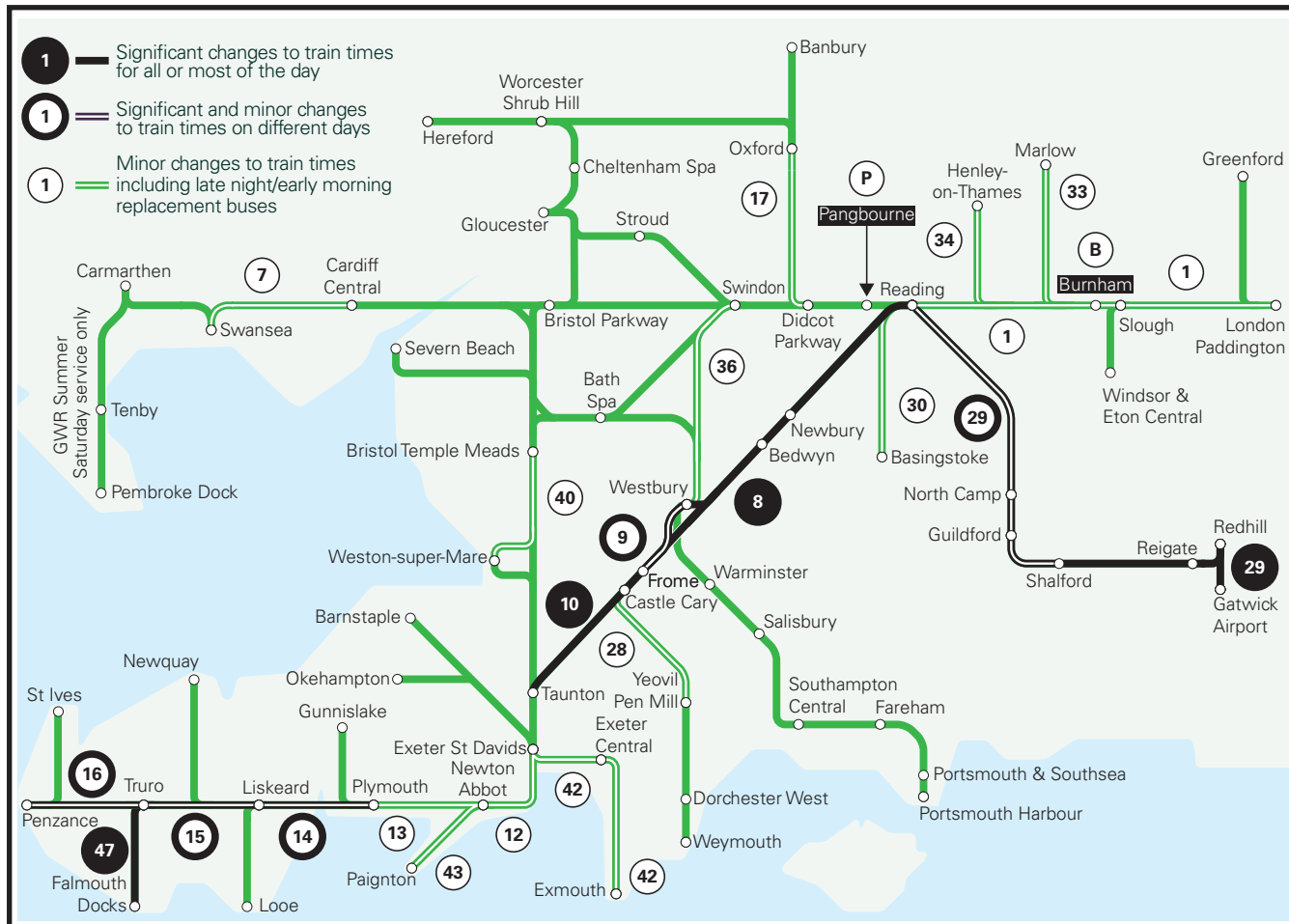


Summary of timetable changes

9 10 **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, long-distance services between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will be diverted and will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. Some trains will also not call at Westbury or Castle Cary. Most trains from London Paddington and Reading will depart EARLIER than usual. Trains between London Paddington, Reading and Newbury / Bedwyn will be replaced by buses between Reading and Newbury. Trains between Newbury and Bedwyn will be retimed. Pewsey will be served by replacement buses to / from Swindon. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

- 7** **Monday to Thursday** - The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will terminate at Port Talbot Parkway. Replacement buses will run from Port Talbot Parkway to Neath and Swansea.
- Tuesday to Friday** - The 0341 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Passengers travelling from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend should use the next available service.

- 9** **Wednesday and Thursday** - The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.

- 12 43** **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, direct trains between London Paddington and Paignton will not run.

15 16 **Sunday** - The 0947 Penzance to Plymouth and the 1340 Plymouth to Penzance will not run. Other trains will make additional stops. The 1800 (departing 1806) London Paddington to Plymouth will terminate at Newton Abbot and the 1502 Plymouth to London Paddington will start from Newton Abbot. A few other trains will be subject to minor retimings.
- Monday** - The 1359 Cardiff Central to Penzance and the 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will terminate at Plymouth. Passengers should travel forward on alternative services. The 1703 London Paddington to Penzance will terminate at Plymouth with a rail connection from Plymouth to Penzance.

16 **Tuesday to Friday** - Buses will replace trains between St Austell and St Erth / Penzance. A revised and reduced rail service will run between Plymouth and St Austell. In most cases, passengers travelling to/from stations east of Plymouth will need to change trains at Plymouth. A rail shuttle service will run between St Erth and Penzance. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

- 17** **Saturday from approximately 2245 until end of service** - Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford.
- Sunday** - The 0754 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers travelling from Oxford should use the next available service.
- Monday to Thursday** - The 2314 London Paddington to Oxford will arrive slightly later at Oxford.
- Tuesday to Friday** - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart slightly EARLIER from Oxford.

- 28** **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary. Passengers travelling from Yeovil Pen Mill should use the next available service, changing en-route where necessary to complete their journey.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains will be reduced to hourly and will run between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport only. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Guildford. A few trains will only run between Guildford and Redhill, with alternative rail connections to / from Gatwick Airport (provided by other operators, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted).

Monday - The 0627 Reading to Gatwick Airport will call additionally at Crowthorne, Sandhurst, Farnborough North, Ash, Shalford, Chilworth, Gomshall, Dorking West and Betchworth and will terminate at Redhill. An alternative rail connection* will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport. The 0651 Reading to Redhill will not run. The 0720 Reading to Gatwick Airport will call additionally at Chilworth and Dorking West. The 0759 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. An alternative EARLIER rail connection* will be available from Gatwick Airport to Redhill (* - provided by another operator: valid GWR tickets will be accepted).

Monday to Thursday - The 2234 Reading to Shalford will not run. The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will call additionally at Shalford. The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Guildford, departing EARLIER than usual.

②⑨ ③① **Sunday** - The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and the 0747 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, calling at all stations except Reading West.

③③ **Sunday** - The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will terminate at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.

③④ **Tuesday to Thursday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

③⑥ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, some trains between Westbury and Swindon via Melksham will be retimed, in some cases up to 15 minutes EARLIER than usual.

④① **Saturday and Sunday** - A few trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare will be slightly retimed, or will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads.

④② **Monday to Thursday** - The 2340 (**Monday to Wednesday**) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (**Tuesday to Thursday**) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will be replaced by buses.

④⑦ **Tuesday to Friday** - Buses will replace trains between Truro and Falmouth Docks.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow: Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading; **Tuesday to Thursday** - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington; **Friday** - 0045 London Paddington to Reading. In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Sunday - The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 Reading to London Paddington and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne: Sunday - 0738, 2233 & 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway, 0818 & 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; **Friday** - 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway. In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
