


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 2 to Friday 8 March 2024

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to/from central London.

- Sunday All day, services to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for all or part of their journey. Some trains may depart EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, but will be part replaced by additional trains running between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Most trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway only.

- 1 2 3 5 6 Sunday - The 1016 London Paddington to Bristol Parkway and 1413 London Paddington to Cardiff Central will not run. The 0955 & 1220 Bristol Parkway to London Paddington and 1650 Cardiff Central to London Paddington will start from Swindon.
 - Sunday All day, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will not run between Cardiff Central and Swansea. Non-stop buses will run between Cardiff Central and Swansea. Passengers travelling to/from Bridgend, Port Talbot Parkway and Neath should use TfW rail/replacement bus services instead, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
- Monday to Thursday The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will terminate at Neath. Replacement buses will run from Neath to Swansea.
 - **Tuesday to Friday** The 0341 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Neath and will run later as far as Cardiff Central. A replacement bus will run from Swansea to Neath.
- Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening Buses will replace trains between Reading, (8) Newbury and Bedwyn.
 - Saturday and Sunday Buses will replace trains between St Austell and St Erth / Penzance. A revised and reduced rail service will run between Plymouth and St Austell.
- **14 15** Monday to Friday - Buses will replace trains between Plymouth / Liskeard and St Erth / Penzance. A reduced rail service will run between Plymouth and Liskeard.
 - All week, in most cases, passengers travelling to/from stations east of Plymouth will need to change trains at Plymouth. A rail shuttle service will run between St Erth and Penzance. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
- Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service Late evening trains between London Paddington / Oxford and (17) (18) Worcester / Hereford will be revised, with buses replacing trains for some journeys.
 - Monday to Thursday The 2121 Bristol Parkway to Portsmouth & Southsea will be diverted after Southampton Central to call additionally at Southampton Airport Parkway and Eastleigh, and will run slightly later from Fareham to Portsmouth & Southsea.

Saturday 24 February to Friday 1 March 2024

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Reading and North Camp. A reduced, hourly service will run between Blackwater and Redhill / Gatwick Airport.

Monday to Thursday - The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport and 0500 Reading to Redhill will start from Guildford. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Guildford, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0531 Reading to Gatwick Airport will depart slightly EARLIER and call additionally at Crowthorne, Sandhurst, Farnborough North and Ash.

- **Sunday** The 1918 Windsor & Eton Central to Slough will depart EARLIER at 1914. The 1928 Slough to Windsor & Eton Central will depart at 1932.
- Monday to Friday between approximately 0745 and 1700 Trains between Liskeard and Looe will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual, to maintain connections with retimed mainline rail and replacement bus services at Liskeard.
- Monday to Friday All week, buses will replace trains between St Austell and Newquay. Passengers travelling to / from Par will need to change buses at St Austell.
- Saturday to Friday All week, buses will replace trains between Truro and Falmouth Docks.
- **Saturday** The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
