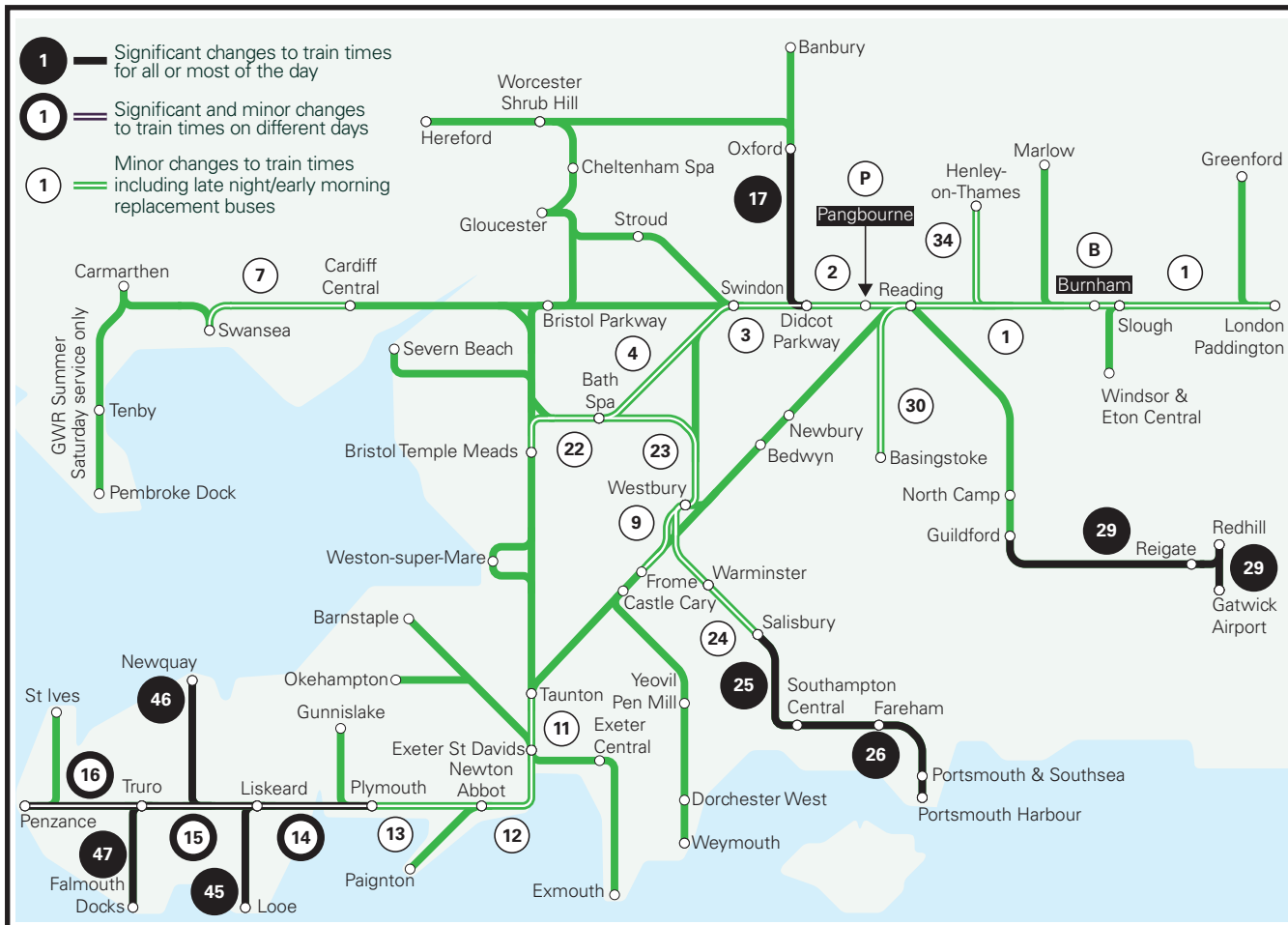


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. **Sunday** - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to/from central London.

⑬ **Sunday** - All day, services to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for all or part of their journey. Some trains may depart EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, but will be part replaced by additional trains running between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Most trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway only.

⑫ ⑬ **Friday** - The **Night Riviera Sleeper** service (2345 London Paddington to Penzance and 2145 Penzance to London Paddington) will NOT run, and no alternative transport will be provided. Passengers will need to use alternative daytime services.

⑯ **Sunday** - The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Passengers for Didcot Parkway should use an alternative local service from Reading. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon (set down only) and Chippenham.

⑦ **Sunday** - The 2145 (departing 2205) London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.
Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.

⑨ ⑳ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2315 until end of service** - Buses will replace trains between Bath Spa and Westbury / Frome.

⑪ ⑫ **Friday** - The 1736 London Paddington to Plymouth will terminate at Newton Abbot and the 1836 London Paddington to Plymouth will terminate at Taunton. Passengers should change trains where necessary to complete their journey.

⑭ ⑮ **Saturday and Sunday** - Buses will replace trains between Plymouth and St Erth / Penzance. A rail shuttle service will run between St Erth and Penzance. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

⑯ **Monday until approximately 0700** - A few trains from Penzance to Plymouth will not run, or will only run for part of their journey. Other trains will make additional stops.

⑳ **Sunday** - The 1740 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will run in two parts: Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads and 1841 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury.
The 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will terminate at Westbury. Passengers travelling beyond Westbury should use alternative earlier or later services.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, and will not call at Southampton Central. Most trains will call additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. On **Saturday**, passengers should use SWR services to travel between Romsey and Southampton Central. On **Sunday**, replacement buses will run between Southampton Central and Eastleigh, to connect into/out of diverted trains.

Saturday - The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Redhill. A replacement bus (operated by Southern) will run from Redhill to Gatwick Airport.

Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Passengers travelling between Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use other operators' rail services, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

Sunday from approximately 1000 - Trains between Reading and Basingstoke will be subject to minor retimings.

Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

Saturday - All day, buses will replace trains between Liskeard and Looe. Some bus stops will not be at the railway stations themselves. Please check local publicity for full details.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between St Austell and Newquay. Passengers travelling to / from Par will need to change buses at St Austell.

47

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Truro and Falmouth Docks.

B

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow: Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; **Sunday** - 0034 London Paddington to Reading; **Tuesday to Friday** - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington. In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow. **Sunday - The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:** 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing later) & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

P

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne: Monday, Tuesday and Thursday: 2236 & 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2324 Didcot Parkway to Reading; **Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday** - 0355 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided); **Friday** - 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway. Unless otherwise shown, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
