


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. **Sunday** - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to/from central London.

- Sunday All day, services to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for all or part of their journey. Some trains may depart EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, but will be part replaced by additional trains running between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. The 1700 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington will terminate at Swindon and the 1733 London Paddington to Cheltenham Spa will start from Swindon. Most trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway only.
- Sunday The **Night Riviera Sleeper** service (2350 London Paddington to Penzance and 2115 Penzance to London Paddington) will NOT run, and no alternative transport will be provided. Passengers will need to use alternative daytime services.
- Monday to Thursday The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.
 - **Sunday** All day, long-distance trains between London Paddington / Reading and the West of England will be diverted between Reading and Taunton, and will not call at Newbury, Hungerford, Pewsey, Westbury or Castle Cary. Most trains from London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual. Passengers travelling to / from Newbury, Hungerford or Westbury should use alternative rail services, changing where necessary to complete their journey. Replacement buses will run between Pewsey and Swindon, connecting at Swindon with diverted trains calling additionally. Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weymouth will only run between Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury and between Castle Cary and Weymouth (and in some cases, will be retimed). Replacement buses will run between Westbury, Frome and Castle Cary, and between Castle Cary and Taunton.
- **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening** Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn.

Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

- (9) Saturday The 2312 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.
- **Monday to Thursday** The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart earlier and run non-stop to and terminate at Gloucester. A replacement bus will serve stations via Stroud.
- Sunday The 1740 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour and the 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will terminate at Westbury. Passengers travelling beyond Westbury should use alternative earlier or later services.

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, and will not call at Southampton Central. Most trains will call additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh.

On Saturday, passengers should use SWR rail services between Southampton Central and Eastleigh, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

On Sunday, replacement buses will run between Southampton Central and Eastleigh, to connect into/out of diverted trains.

Saturday - The 2059 Gatwick Airport to Reading will terminate at Redhill. The 2130 Gatwick Airport to Reading will call additionally at Farnborough North, Sandhurst and Crowthorne.

Sunday - All day, trains will be reduced to hourly, and will be replaced by buses between North Camp / Ash, Guildford and Shalford. Most trains will also not run between Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Passengers should use other operators' services to travel to / from Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

Monday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Redhill. Passengers from stations west of Redhill should travel on the next available service.

Friday - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Gatwick Airport. Sunday - The 1918 Windsor & Eton Central to Slough will depart EARLIER at 1914. The 1928 Slough to Windsor & Eton Central will depart at 1932.

Sunday - Most trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and 40 Bristol Temple Meads.

Monday - The 1631 Barnstaple to Axminster will terminate at Exeter Central. Replacement buses (operated by SWR) will run from 42 Exeter Central for stations to Axminster.

Sunday - Direct trains between London Paddington and Paignton will not run. Passengers should use alternative services, changing en-route where necessary, to complete their journey.

Saturday - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
