


Summary of timetable changes

12	 Saturday - The 2208 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2250 London Paddington to Oxford will depart slightly EARLIER from London Paddington. The 2200 Oxford to London Paddington will not call at Twyford or Maidenhead. The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Slough. A replacement bus will run from Slough to London Paddington. Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Slough at 0700. A replacement bus will run non-stop from London Paddington at 0556 to Slough. Passengers travelling to/from other stations should use the next available rail service. Sunday - All day, services to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for all or part of their journey. Some trains may depart EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, but will be part replaced by additional trains running between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Most trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway only.
923	Monday to Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with a later rail connection from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.
(1) (12) (13)	 Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive Exeter St Davids later than usual. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart Exeter St Davids slightly EARLIER than usual. Monday - The 2104 London Paddington to Plymouth and the 2200, 2305 & 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will run later from Tiverton Parkway onwards. The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will run later from Taunton to Exeter St Davids. Monday and Tuesday - The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will run later from Taunton to Reading. Tuesday - The 2305 & 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids to Exeter St Davids. The 2345 London Paddington will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. The 2345 Meads to Exeter St Davids will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. Monday to Friday - All week, buses will replace trains between Evesham and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street.
	A revised service will run between Oxford and Evesham and between Worcester Foregate Street, Great Malvern and Hereford. The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will be replaced by a bus from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway.
(21)	Monday to Friday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will arrive later at Bristol Temple Meads.
29	Sunday - All day, trains will be reduced to hourly, and will run between Guildford and Redhill only. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Guildford. Passengers should use other operators' services to travel to / from Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
34)	Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
37 37	Monday to Friday - All week, trains between Bristol Temple Meads (or beyond) and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street (or beyond) will not run north of Gloucester. Alternative rail services will be available between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa. Buses will replace trains between Cheltenham Spa and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street.

 The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow: Saturday - 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 2345 Didcot Parkway to Slough; Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading; Tuesday to Thursday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington;
 Friday - 0045 London Paddington to Reading. In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow. The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
 Friday - The 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
