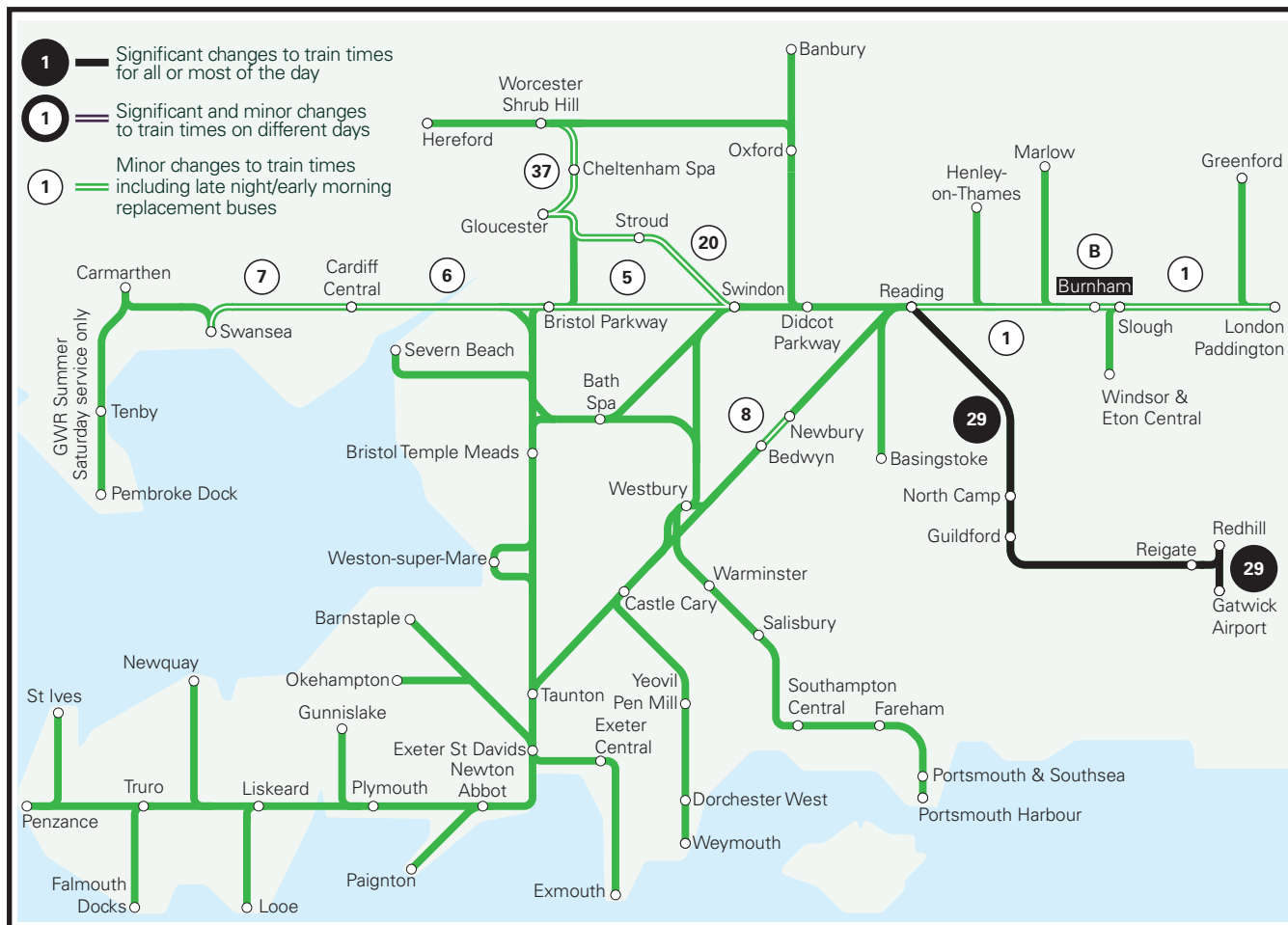


Summary of timetable changes

Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Maidenhead. A replacement bus will run from London Paddington to Maidenhead, departing EARLIER than usual.

- ① **Sunday** - All day, services to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for all or part of their journey. Some trains may depart EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not call at Slough. Most trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway only.

⑦ **Monday, Wednesday and Thursday** - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.

- ⑦ **Sunday** - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run from Swansea to Cardiff Central, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0832 Swansea to London Paddington will run a few minutes later than usual.

- ⑧ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening** - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn.

- ⑳ ㉓ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER than usual and will be diverted to run non-stop from Swindon to Gloucester where it will terminate. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, calling at stations via Stroud.

- ㉑ **Saturday and Sunday** - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Reading and Guildford. A reduced, hourly train service will run between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. On Sunday, a few trains will only run between Guildford and Redhill. Passengers should use other operators' services to travel to / from Gatwick Airport.

Monday until approximately 0830 - A few early morning trains will not run or will only run for part of their journey. Some other trains will make additional stops instead.

- ㉓ **Sunday until approximately 1600** - Buses will replace trains between Gloucester, Cheltenham Spa and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street.

- ㉔ **Saturday** - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0018 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
