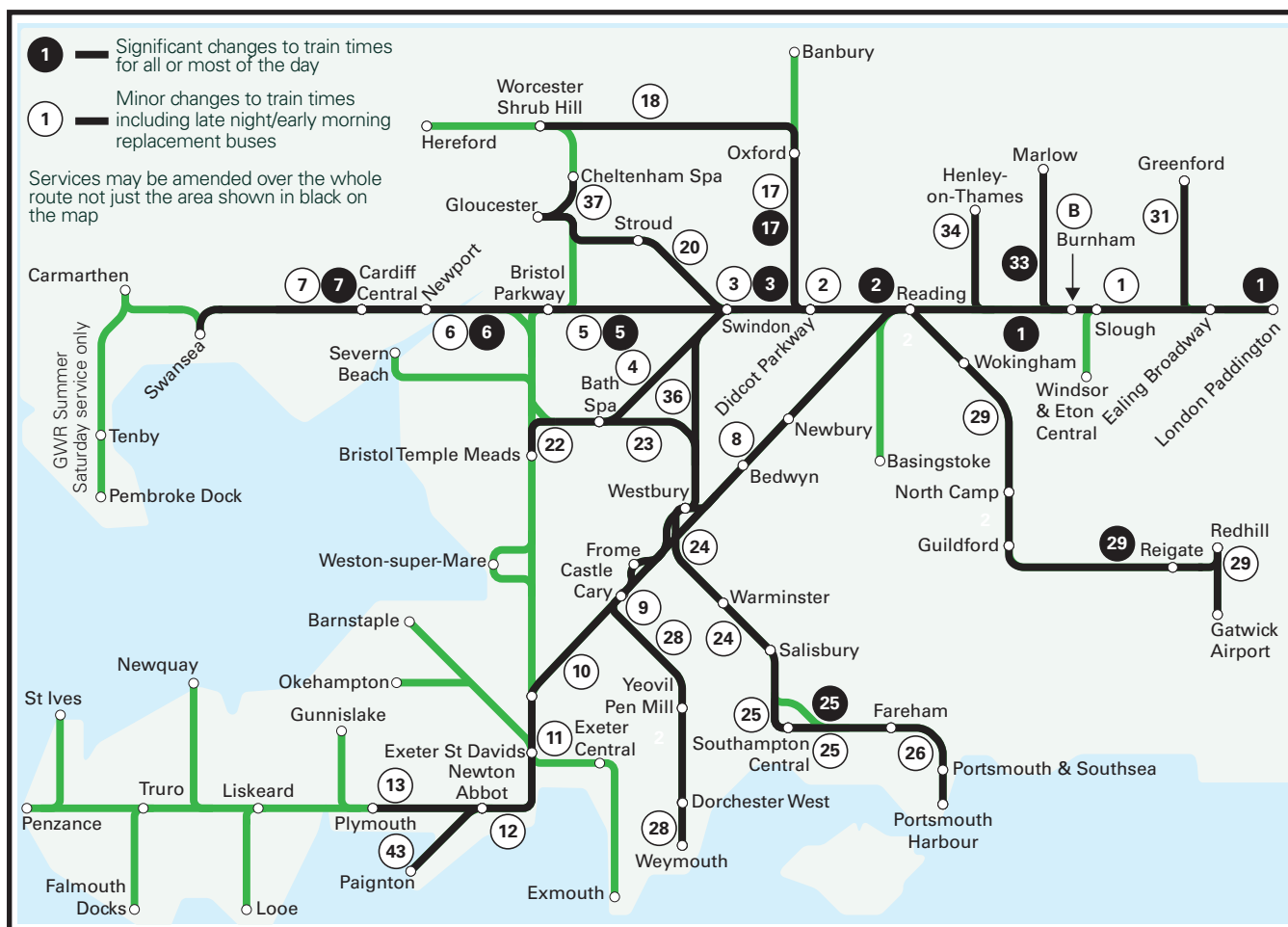


Summary of timetable changes

ALL ROUTES	Friday - In addition to planned engineering work shown below, a revised, and in a few cases, reduced Bank Holiday service will run on some routes. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
1 2 3 5 6 7	Friday - All day, a revised High Speed service will run to and from London Paddington, with some trains departing EARLIER than usual. A reduced, hourly service will run between London Paddington and South Wales, and additional trains will run between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will only run between Reading and Oxford. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Newbury will only run between Reading and Newbury. Most trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will only run between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa. Some other High Speed services will not run at all or will only run for part of their journey. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
1 2 3 4 5 17	Sunday until approximately 1000 - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and Didcot Parkway / Swindon / Oxford are subject to retimings, in some cases EARLIER than usual. Buses will replace trains for some journeys. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be subject to retimings. In most cases, trains FROM London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, and additional trains will run between Didcot Parkway, Radley and Oxford instead. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Swindon (or beyond) will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
5 6 7	Monday to Thursday - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.
6 7	Saturday - The 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Newport. An alternative rail connection will be available from Newport to Cardiff Central. Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central and run later to Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will run from Swansea and intermediate stations to Cardiff Central.
8 9 10 11 12 13 43	Sunday - All day, due to SWR diverting their London Waterloo to Exeter St Davids services via Westbury and Castle Cary, all GWR services running through Wesbury or Castle Cary are subject to minor retimings. Friday - The 0600 London Paddington to Penzance will start from Bristol Temple Meads. The 0937 London Paddington to Paignton, 1736 London Paddington to Plymouth, 1808 London Paddington to Frome, 0510 Bristol Temple Meads (via Westbury) to London Paddington, 0531 & 2042 Bedwyn to London Paddington, 0555 Plymouth to London Paddington and 1355 Paignton to London Paddington will all not run. The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury and the 1907 London Paddington to Bedwyn will only run between Reading and Newbury.
8	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn. Tuesday - 0600 Bedwyn to London Paddington will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
9	Friday - The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.
11	Monday and Wednesday - The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids and 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will both arrive up to 30 minutes later at Exeter St Davids.
17	Saturday from approximately 2230 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford.
18	Friday - The 1523 London Paddington to Worcester Foregate Street and 1726 Worcester Foregate Street to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on alternative earlier or later services.
20 37	Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER and be diverted to run non-stop from Swindon to Gloucester, where it will finish its journey. A replacement bus will serve intermediate stations via Stroud.

22 23 28 36	Sunday - The 1038 Weymouth to Swindon and 1342 Swindon to Weymouth will run later throughout. The 1405 Weymouth to Bristol Temple Meads will run later from Yeovil Pen Mill onwards.
24 25 25 26	Saturday to Friday - All week, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted, not calling at Southampton Central. Most will call additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Passengers travelling to / from Southampton Central should (on Saturday) change at Salisbury or Romsey for alternative SWR rail services to / from Southampton Central; (on Sunday) change at Eastleigh for replacement buses to / from Southampton Central; or (on Monday to Friday) change at Eastleigh for alternative SWR rail services to / from Southampton Central. On all days, some other trains will also be retimed, or will only run for part of their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
29 29	Saturday - The 2335 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. In addition, the 0821 Reading to Gatwick Airport and 1955 Gatwick Airport to Reading will not run at all.
31	Friday - The 0543 London Paddington to Greenford will start from West Ealing. The 2204 Greenford to London Paddington will finish its journey at West Ealing. Passengers should use TfL Elizabeth line services to complete their journey.
33	Saturday to Friday - All week, buses will replace trains between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow. In addition, on Friday , first replacement buses will be later than usual train times.
34	Friday - All day, trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames will be retimed to maintain connections with retimed mainline services running between London Paddington, Twyford and Reading.
B	Saturday - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
