

| ALL ROUTES | Monday - In addition to planned engineering work, a revised, and in a few cases, reduced Bank Holiday service will run on some routes. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. |

| 12 34 56 77 | Saturday to Monday - On all three days, a revised High Speed service will run to and from London Paddington, with some trains departing EARLIER than usual. A reduced service will run between London Paddington and South Wales, and, on Monday only, additional trains will run between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will either (on Saturday and Monday) only run between Reading and Oxford or (on Sunday) will not run at all (with additional trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford). On Saturday and Monday, most fast trains between London Paddington and Newbury will only run between Reading and Newbury. On Saturday and Monday, most trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will only run between Swindon and Cheltenham Spa. On all three days, some other High Speed services will not run at all or will only run for part of their journey. On all three days, most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway, at a reduced hourly frequency. Sunday until approximately 1000 - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and Didcot Parkway / Swindon / Oxford are subject to retimings, in some cases EARLIER than usual. Buses will replace trains for some journeys. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. |
| 1 | Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Some trains will be subject to slightly extended journey times between London Paddington and Reading. |
| 6 | Saturday - The 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Newport. An alternative rail connection will be available from Newport to Cardiff Central. |
| 7 | Sunday - The 0755, 0923, 1023 & 1123 Swansea to London Paddington will depart up to 4 minutes earlier from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend. Monday to Wednesday - The 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will finish their journeys at Port Talbot Parkway. Replacement buses will run from Port Talbot Parkway to Neath and Swansea. Tuesday to Thursday - The 0346 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Passengers travelling from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend should use the next available service. |
| 8 9 10 11 12 13 43 | Sunday - The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run. The 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will call additionally at Reading West, Aldermaston and Midgham and run slightly later to Bedwyn. Monday - The 0600 London Paddington to Penzance will start from Bristol Temple Meads. The 0937 London Paddington to Paginton, 1736 London Paddington to Plymouth, 1808 London Paddington to Frome, 0510 Bristol Temple Meads (via Westbury) to London Paddington, 0531 & 2042 Bedwyn to London Paddington, 0555 Plymouth to London Paddington and 1355 Paignton to London Paddington will not run. The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury and the 1907 London Paddington to Bedwyn will only run between Reading and Newbury. |
| 9 | From approximately 2300 Saturday until end of service Monday - Trains will not call at Frome. Replacement buses will run between Westbury and Frome. |
| 17) | Tuesday to Friday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart slightly EARLIER from Oxford. Normal timings from Didcot Parkway onwards. |
| 18 | Saturday - The 0828 Worcester Foregate Street to London Paddington will not run. Monday - The 1523 London Paddington to Worcester Foregate Street and 1726 Worcester Foregate Street to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on alternative earlier or later services. |
| 24 25 25 26 | Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted, not calling at Southampton Central. Most will call additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Passengers travelling to / from Southampton Central should change at Eastleigh for either (on Saturday) alternative SWR rail services to / from Southampton Central or (on Sunday) replacement buses to / from Southampton Central. On both days, some other trains will also be retimed, or will only run for part of their journey. |

| 28 | Monday to Friday - The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Westbury (Monday) or Castle Cary (Tuesday to Friday). Passengers should travel on the next available service. |

| 30 | Sunday - The 0737 Reading to Basingstoke will not run. Passengers should travel on the next available service. |
| 31 | Saturday and Monday - The 0543 London Paddington to Greenford will start from West Ealing. The 2204 Greenford to London Paddington will finish its journey at West Ealing. Passengers should use TfL Elizabeth line services to complete their journey. |
| 33 | Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow. Monday - All day, a revised hourly service will run between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow. |
| 34) | Monday - All day, trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames will be retimed to maintain connections with retimed mainline services running between London Paddington, Twyford and Reading. Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading. |
| 40 | Sunday - Some trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare / Taunton (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative services to complete their journey. |
| В | Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to Ealing Broadway will not call at Taplow or Burnham. Sunday - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow. Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 Reading to London Paddington and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham. Tuesday to Thursday - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Friday - The 0045 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow. |
| P | Sunday - The 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Pangbourne. Friday - The 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst. |
