


Summary of timetable changes

12 34 517	Sunday until approximately 1000 - Trains between London Paddington / Reading and Didcot Parkway / Swindon / Oxford are subject to retimings, in some cases EARLIER than usual. Buses will replace trains for some journeys. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be subject to retimings. In most cases, trains FROM London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, and additional trains will run between Didcot Parkway, Radley and Oxford instead. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Swindon (or beyond) will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
1	Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Some trains will be subject to slightly extended journey times between London Paddington and Reading.
23 422	Sunday - The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling to Didcot Parkway should change at Reading for an alternative local service.
67	Sunday - The 0833 (departing 0828) London Paddington to Swansea will run approximately 10 minutes later from Reading onwards.
8	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2130 until end of service - Trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn will be revised. A few trains will run EARLIER than usual or will not run at all. Replacement buses will run between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn. Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.
11 40	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2215 until end of service - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton / Exeter St Davids will be revised. Some trains will run EARLIER than usual, or will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey.
17	Saturday from approximately 2230 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford.
21	Monday and Tuesday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run slightly later from Patchway to Bristol Temple Meads.
22 23	Monday to Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury will depart at 2308 and run slightly later throughout.
24 25 25 26	Sunday until approximately 2100 - Trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted, not calling at Southampton Central. Most will call additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Passengers travelling to / from Southampton Central should change at Eastleigh for alternative SWR rail services to / from Southampton Central, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. In addition, the 1740 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will finish its journey at Westbury. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
26	Monday to Thursday - The 2123 Bristol Parkway to Portsmouth & Southsea will be diverted to call additionally at Southampton Airport Parkway and Eastleigh, then run slightly later from Fareham to Portsmouth & Southsea.
29 29	Saturday - The 2335 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - All day, a revised rail service will run between Reading and Ash. Replacement buses will run between North Camp, Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Passengers should interchange between trains and buses at North Camp.
42	Monday to Friday - The 2340 (Monday to Thursday) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (Tuesday to Friday) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will be replaced by buses, with extended journey times.

Saturday - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading, 0019 Reading to London Paddington and 2345 Didcot Parkway to Ealing Broadway will not call at Burnham or Taplow.

Sunday - The 0034 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow.

In all cases above, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0625 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Burnham. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
