


Summary of timetable changes

ALL	May Day Bank Holiday Monday - In addition to planned engineering work, a revised, and in a few cases, reduced Bank Holiday service will run on some routes.
ROUTES	Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
1	Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start
	from Ealing Broadway. In both cases, passengers should use London Underground services to / from central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
	Sunday - The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will depart at 0636 and run later throughout.
12	Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be subject to retimings. In most cases, trains FROM London Paddington will depart
$\overline{3}$	EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, and additional trains will run between Didcot Parkway, Radley and
34	Oxford instead. Some trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will not run, and most trains between London Paddington and
51	Weston-super-Mare (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Swindon
22 40	(or beyond) will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will
	only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling .
7	Sunday - The 2045 & 2145 (both departing 2 minutes earlier) London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run approximately 25 minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.
	Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run up to 25 minutes later from
	Bridgend to Swansea.
	Tuesday to Friday - The 0346 Swansea to London Paddington will depart at 0338 and run slightly EARLIER as far as Cardiff Central.
	From approximately 2300 Saturday until 1000 Sunday - Buses will replace trains between Reading and Newbury. The 0751 & 0850 (departing 0831)
8	London Paddington to Penzance will be diverted via an alternative route between Reading and Westbury.
	Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.
9 22 23 24 28 36	Saturday - The 2215 & 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. The 2316 Frome to Westbury will not run. Replacement
	buses will run between Westbury to Frome.
	Sunday - The 0806 Warminster to Swindon will not run. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Warminster to Chippenham. The 0908 Swindon to Westbury
	will start from Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon. The 0839 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads will
	depart at 0855 and run later throughout.
	Monday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington and the 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will both start from Westbury. Passengers from stations
	before Westbury should travel on an alternative later service. The 0635 Salisbury to Worcester Foregate Street will finish its journey at Westbury. Passengers
	travelling beyond Westbury should use the next available service.
	Monday to Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Bath Spa.
	Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury.
	A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with an alternative rail connection from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.
11	Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive at Exeter St Davids approximately 50 minutes later than usual.
17 18	Monday to Thursday - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway and then run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill.
	An alternative rail connection will run from Didcot Parkway to Oxford, with a replacement bus from Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2251 London Paddington
	to Worcestershire Parkway will finish its journey at Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to
	London Paddington will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford, but stops at Kingham,
	Charlbury and Hanborough will be to drop off passengers only. An alternative train will run from Oxford (departing later than usual) to Didcot Parkway, Reading,
	Slough and London Paddington.

20 37	 Saturday and Monday - All day on both days, trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will only run between London Paddington and Stroud. Most trains will be retimed. Replacement buses will run between Stroud, Stonehouse Town Hall and Gloucester, with alternative rail connections running between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa. A few trains will not run at all, and a few late evening buses will be extended to run from/to Swindon and to/from Cheltenham Spa. Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington / Swindon and Cheltenham Spa will not run. Replacement buses will run between Swindon and Gloucester, with some buses extended to run to/from Cheltenham Spa. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Tuesday - The 0511 Gloucester to Southampton Central will start from Swindon. Passengers travelling from stations before Swindon should travel on the next available service.
21 38	Saturday and Monday - All day on both days, buses will replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester. Some trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Filton Abbey Wood and Bristol Parkway will be retimed. Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads / Bristol Parkway and Gloucester. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
29	Sunday from approximately 0745 to 2100 - Some trains from Reading to Gatwick Airport will run slightly later from Wokingham to Redhill.
30	Saturday - The 2235 & 2305 Reading to Basingstoke and the 2320 & 2340 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. Replacement buses will run instead. Sunday and Monday - All day on both days, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Buses will not call at Reading West. Passengers for Reading West should use services between Reading and Newbury / Bedwyn instead.
33	Monday - All day, a revised hourly service will run between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow.
34	Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
35	Monday to Wednesday - The 2231(departing 2239) Didcot Parkway to Banbury will finish its journey at Oxford and the 2334 Banbury to Oxford will not run at all. Replacement buses will run instead.
B	Tuesday to Friday - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and the 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
(P)	 Monday to Wednesday - The 2236 & 2334 (departing 2336) London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and the 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst. Tuesday to Thursday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Passengers should travel on the next available service. Friday - The 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between and Tilehurst.
