


Summary of timetable changes

ALL ROUTES	Monday - In addition to planned engineering work, a revised, and in a few cases, reduced Bank Holiday service will run on some routes. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
1	Saturday - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will finish its journey at Ealing Broadway. Passengers should use London Underground services to travel into central London, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will not run. Passengers should travel on a later service. The 0620 Reading to London Paddington will depart at 0636 and run later throughout.
1 2 3 4 5 22 40	Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be subject to retimings. In most cases, trains FROM London Paddington will depart EARLIER than usual. Some trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will not run, and most trains between London Paddington and Weston-super-Mare (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Swindon (or beyond) will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Most local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
1	Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Some trains will be subject to slightly extended journey times between London Paddington and Reading.
5 6 7	Monday to Thursday -The 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run approximately 15-20 minutes later from Bristol Parkway onwards.
8	From approximately 2145 until end of service Monday to Thursday - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn. Thursday - The 0600 Bedwyn to London Paddington will run slightly later from Newbury onwards and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
8 9 10 11 12 13 43	Sunday - Due to engineering work taking place in the London Paddington area, some High Speed services between London Paddington and the West of England will either not run or will be retimed. A few trains will make additional stops in place of cancelled trains. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
9 22 23 24 28 36	Saturday - The 2215 & 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. The 2316 Frome to Westbury will not run. Replacement buses will run between Westbury and Frome. Sunday - The 806 Warminster to Swindon and the 0908 Swindon to Westbury will not run. Replacement buses will run between Warminster or Westbury and Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon. The 0839 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads will depart at 0924 and run later throughout, not calling at Avoncliff or Freshford. The 0900 Westbury to Weymouth will depart at 0940 and run later throughout. The 1038 Weymouth to Swindon will depart at 1127, will run later throughout and will finish its journey at Chippenham. The 1332 Swindon to Weymouth will start from Chippenham at 1347. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon. Monday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington and the 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will both start from Westbury. Passengers from stations before Westbury should travel on an alternative later service. Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. A connecting service will run from Frome, departing slightly EARLIER at 0607.
11)	Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive at Exeter St Davids approximately 50 minutes later than usual. Monday to Thursday - The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will arrive at Exeter St Davids 20 minutes later than usual.

Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER at 2321 and will be diverted to run non-stop from Swindon to Gloucester, where it will finish its journey. A replacement bus will serve stations via Stroud.



Monday - All day, a revised hourly service will run between Maidenhead, Bourne End and Marlow.



The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow: Saturday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading, 0019 Reading to London Paddington and 2345 Didcot Parkway to Ealing Broadway; **Sunday** - 0034 London Paddington to Reading; In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0636 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
