


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 7 to Friday 13 June 2025



Sunday until approximately 0900 - Most High Speed services from London Paddington will depart a few minutes EARLIER than usual, and will be further retimed for some or all of their journey. The 0836 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will depart at 0846 and run later throughout.



Monday to Friday - The Severn Rail Tunnel will be closed. Trains between London Paddington and south Wales will be reduced to an hourly frequency, diverted to run via Gloucester and will not call at Bristol Parkway. Most trains running towards South Wales will depart EARLIER from London Paddington, Reading, (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon, and journey times will be extended. At peak times, direct trains between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway will continue to run, otherwise passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services and travel via Bristol Temple Meads. Some trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will be slightly retimed and some will not call at Didcot Parkway (with other trains calling there instead). A few other trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey.



Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Monday to Friday - The Severn Rail Tunnel will be closed. Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted to start from / finish at Bristol Parkway, and will call additionally at Ashley Down, Stapleton Road and Lawrence Hill. Local stopping services between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will generally not run. Trains between Cardiff Central and Taunton / Exeter St Davids will generally only run south of Bristol Temple Meads. A few other trains will also not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Passengers travelling between Bristol Temple Meads (or stations further south or east) and south Wales should travel on scheduled rail services, changing trains at Gloucester. Passengers travelling to / from Patchway should use local bus services to / from Bristol Parkway, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. A very limited service of replacement buses will run, at peak times only, between Bristol Parkway, Patchway and Severn Tunnel Junction, otherwise passengers should travel via Gloucester.



Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses, departing EARLIER than usual, will run from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend to Cardiff Central.

Sunday - The 2323 Newbury to Reading will not run and will be replaced by a bus.

Monday to Thursday from approximately 2130 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn. A few other trains will either not run, or will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual.

Monday to Friday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains from London Paddington to Newbury will run slightly later than usual.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. An alternative rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual.



Monday to Friday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 0748 (departing 0705) London Paddington to Swansea will depart Swindon at 0805 and will call additionally at Stroud for passengers to leave the train only. The 0735 Salisbury to Worcester Foregate Street will depart Swindon at 0812 and run approximately 15-17 minutes later as far as Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2006 Westbury to Cheltenham Spa will not call at Gloucester.


Saturday - The 2030 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will finish its journey at Southampton Central. Passengers travelling beyond Southampton Central should travel on the next available service.



Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Southampton Central and Portsmouth Harbour. Passengers making local journeys between Fratton, Portsmouth & Southsea and Portsmouth Harbour should use alternative scheduled rail services operated by Southern or SWR, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. In addition, the 1750 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will not run. Passengers should use alternative earlier or later services. **Monday** - The 0450 Fratton to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Southampton Central. Passengers travelling from stations east of Southampton Central should travel on a later service.

Sunday - The 0737 Reading to Basingstoke will not run. Passengers should travel on the next available service. The 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will depart at 0830 and run later throughout.

Monday to Friday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 0738 Reading to Basingstoke will depart slightly EARLIER from Reading and Reading West.

Saturday - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and the 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
