


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday and Monday to Friday - The Severn Rail Tunnel will be closed. Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be reduced to an hourly frequency, diverted to run via Gloucester and will not call at Bristol Parkway. Most trains running towards South Wales will depart EARLIER from London Paddington, Reading, (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon, and journey times will be extended. At certain times, direct trains between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway will continue to run, otherwise passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services and travel via Bristol Temple Meads. Some trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads will be slightly retimed and some will not call at Didcot Parkway (with other trains calling there instead). A few other trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey.

Sunday - The Severn Rail Tunnel will be closed. Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway, and between Newport and Swansea / Carmarthen. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport / Cardiff Central. Some other trains will not run, or will only run for part of their journey.

Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Some trains will be subject to slightly extended journey times between London Paddington and Reading.

Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads / Weston-super-Mare (and beyond) will be reduced in frequency. Some trains will only run for part of their journey. Some trains will call additionally at Didcot Parkway in place of other trains which will not run. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

Saturday and Monday to Friday - The Severn Rail Tunnel will be closed. Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted to start from / finish at Bristol Parkway, and will call additionally at Ashley Down, Stapleton Road and Lawrence Hill. Local stopping services between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will generally not run. Trains between Cardiff Central and Taunton / Exeter St Davids will generally only run south of Bristol Temple Meads. A few other trains will also not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Passengers travelling between Bristol Temple Meads (or stations further south or east) and south Wales should travel on scheduled rail services, changing trains at Gloucester. Passengers travelling to / from Patchway should use local bus services to / from Bristol Parkway, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. A very limited service of replacement buses will run, at peak times only, between Bristol Parkway, Patchway and Severn Tunnel Junction, otherwise passengers should travel via Gloucester. On Saturday only, a limited taxi service will run between Pilning and Bristol Parkway.

Sunday - The Severn Rail Tunnel will be closed. Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted to start from / finish at Bristol Parkway, and most will call additionally at Ashley Down. Trains between Cardiff Central and Taunton / Exeter St Davids will generally only run south of Bristol Temple Meads. A few other trains will also not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Replacement buses will run between Cardiff Central / Newport and Bristol Parkway. Passengers travelling to / from Patchway can also use local bus services to / from Bristol Parkway, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Sunday - The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Newbury. The 0804 (departing at 0800) London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. The 0844 (departing at 0835) London Paddington to Penzance will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey.

Monday to Friday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, some trains from London Paddington to Newbury will run slightly later than usual.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.

Saturday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome. 9 22 Sunday - The 0806 Warminster to Swindon and 0908 Swindon to Westbury will be replaced by buses between Warminster / Westbury and Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon. The 0839 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads, 0900 Westbury to Weymouth and 23 24 1038 Weymouth to Swindon will all run later than usual. Monday, Wednesday and Thursday - The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome. Monday to Thursday - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, then run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. Passengers should change at Didcot Parkway for an alternative rail connection to Oxford, then a replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will finish its journey at Oxford. A replacement bus service will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill and re-start from Oxford, with no connection between the two parts. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford, but there will be no onward connection to London Paddington. Monday to Wednesday - The 2238 Worcester Shrub Hill to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Bristol Parkway. An alternative rail connection will be **(21)** available from Bristol Parkway to Bristol Temple Meads. The 2308 Severn Beach to Bristol Temple Meads will arrive at Bristol Temple Meads a few minutes later than usual. Monday to Friday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 0748 (departing at 0705) London Paddington to Swansea will depart Swindon at 0805 and will call additionally at Stroud for passengers to leave the train only. The 0735 Salisbury to Worcester Foregate Street will depart Swindon at 0812 and run approximately 15-17 minutes later as far as Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2006 Westbury to Cheltenham Spa will not call at Gloucester. Sunday - The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, departing at 0737 from Reading and at 0745 from Basingstoke. (30) Monday to Friday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, 0738 Reading to Basingstoke will depart slightly EARLIER from Reading and Reading West. (33) Sunday - The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead. Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford 34 to Reading. Monday to Thursday - The 2231 (departing at 2239) Didcot Parkway to Banbury will finish its journey at Oxford. The 2334 Banbury to Oxford will not run at all. **35** Replacement buses will run between Oxford and Banbury. The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow: Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading; Tuesday to Thursday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington; Friday - 0045 London Paddington to (**B**) Reading. In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow. The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday - 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing 0624) Reading to London Paddington and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham. Sunday - The 0738, 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 0818 & 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Pangbourne. (**P**) Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
