


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 28 June to Friday 4 July 2025

 Sunday until approximately 1545 - The Severn Rail Tunnel will be closed. Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted to run via Gloucester and will not call at Bristol Parkway. Trains running towards South Wales will depart EARLIER from London Paddington, Reading, (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon, and journey times will be extended. A few trains will continue to run between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway, otherwise passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services and travel via Bristol Temple Meads Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. A few other trains will not run, or will only run for part of their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
Monday to Thursday - The 2228 & 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Swindon to run non-stop to Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will serve Chippenham and Bath Spa.
 Sunday until approximately 1545 - The Severn Rail Tunnel will be closed. Trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted to start from / finish at Bristol Parkway, and most will call additionally at Ashley Down. Trains between Cardiff Central and Taunton / Exeter St Davids will generally only run south of Bristol Temple Meads. A few other trains will also not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Replacement buses will run between Newport and Bristol Parkway. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Friday - 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers travelling beyond Bristol Temple Meads will need to travel on a later service to complete their journey. An additional train will also run at 2156 from Bristol Temple Meads to Cardiff Central.
 Sunday - The 2045 & 2145 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run approximately 25 minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea. Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run up to approximately 25 minutes later from Bridgend to Swansea.
 Saturday until approximately 0700 - Trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn will be revised. Some trains will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey, departing EARLIER than usual. Sunday - The 2333 Newbury to Reading will be replaced by a bus. Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
Monday to Thursday - The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. Replacement buses will run from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads.
Monday and Tuesday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run slightly later from Patchway to Bristol Temple Meads.
Saturday - The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Westbury will be diverted after Fareham and will not call at Eastleigh or Southampton Airport Parkway. Normal timings from Southampton Central onwards. Sunday - The 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted after Southampton Central and will not call at Southampton Airport Parkway, Eastleigh, Hedge End or Botley. Normal timings from Fareham onwards.
Tuesday to Friday - In connection with Henley Regatta, a revised service will run between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames. Some trains will depart EARLIER than usual. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
Monday to Wednesday - The 2054 Exmouth (2129 Exeter St Davids) to Barnstaple will finish its journey at Crediton. A replacement bus will run from Crediton to Barnstaple and a taxi from Crediton to Yeoford. The 2241 Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids will not run. A replacement bus will run from Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids. Yeoford will be served by a separate taxi service to / from Crediton.

B	Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;
	Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;
	Tuesday to Friday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;
	In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
	The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:
	Sunday - 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing 0622) & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 departing 2333) London Paddington to
	Didcot Parkway and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
P	Monday to Wednesday - The 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Pangbourne.
	Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
	Tuesday to Thursday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. No replacement transport will be provided - passengers should travel on the next
	available service.
	Friday - The 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
