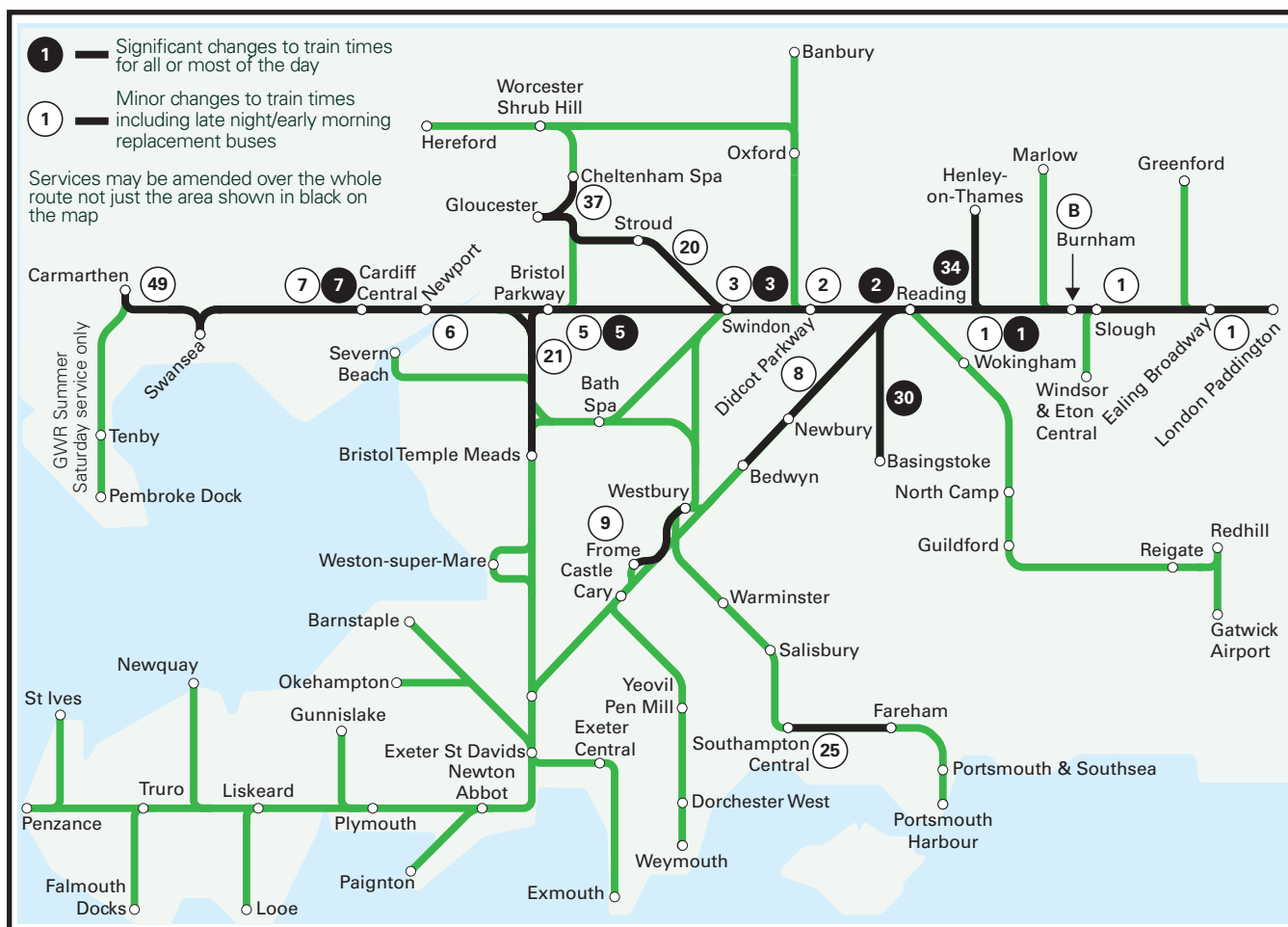

① ② ③ ⑤ ⑥ ⑦ ④⑨	<p><b>Saturday</b> - The 1818 &amp; 1918 London Paddington to Swansea will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.</p> <p><b>Sunday</b> - All day, trains between London Paddington and Swansea / Carmarthen will be diverted via an alternative route between Cardiff Central and Bridgend, extending journey times by up to 35 minutes. Most trains from South Wales to London will depart from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend EARLIER than usual. Trains to / from Carmarthen will mostly run between Swansea and Carmarthen only, in normal timings. The 0835 Swansea to London Paddington will not run. The 0955 Bristol Parkway to London Paddington will depart at 0934 and run EARLIER throughout.</p> <p><b>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</b></p>
① ② ③ ⑤ ⑥ ⑦	<p><b>Monday to Friday</b> - All week, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be reduced in frequency and will be diverted via an alternative route between Swindon and Bristol Parkway, extending journey times. Most trains running towards South Wales will depart from London Paddington, Reading, (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon EARLIER than usual. Trains running towards London Paddington will arrive later at Swindon and stations beyond. A few other trains will not run (including the 1612 &amp; 1912 London Paddington to Bristol Parkway). The 0453 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington will start EARLIER from Bristol Parkway, then will run non-stop from Bristol Temple Meads to Swindon.</p> <p><b>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</b></p>
① ② ③ ⑤ ⑥ ⑦ ②①	<p><b>Saturday</b> - In connection with the Oasis concert at Cardiff Principality Stadium, there will be some late evening changes to services running between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central. The 2202 London Paddington to Bristol Parkway and the 2022 Swansea to Bristol Parkway will not run. The 2000 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington will finish its journey at Swindon, with an alternative connecting rail service running from Swindon to London Paddington. Additional late evening trains will run from Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads, Swansea and Swindon.</p> <p><b>Friday</b> - In connection with the Stereophonics concert at Cardiff Principality Stadium, the 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers travelling beyond Bristol Temple Meads will need to travel on a later service to complete their journey. An additional train will also run at 2156 from Bristol Temple Meads to Cardiff Central. Additional late evening trains will run from Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads.</p>
⑧	<p><b>Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening</b> - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn.</p> <p><b>Thursday and Friday</b> - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.</p>
⑨	<p><b>Tuesday to Friday</b> - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. A connecting rail service will run from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual.</p>
②① ③⑦	<p><b>Monday to Thursday</b> - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will be diverted to run non-stop from Swindon to Gloucester, where it will finish its journey. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, serving stations via Stroud.</p>
②⑤	<p><b>Saturday</b> - The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Westbury will be diverted after Fareham and will not call at Eastleigh or Southampton Airport Parkway. Normal timings from Southampton Central onwards.</p> <p><b>Sunday</b> - The 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted after Southampton Central and will not call at Southampton Airport Parkway, Eastleigh, Hedge End or Botley. Normal timings from Fareham onwards.</p>
③①	<p><b>Saturday</b> - All day, local stopping services between Reading and Basingstoke will be reduced in frequency. <b>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</b></p>
③④	<p><b>Saturday</b> - In connection with Henley Regatta, all day, trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames will be revised. Trains will not call at Wargrave, which will be served by replacement buses running between Wargrave and Twyford only.</p> <p><b>Sunday</b> - In connection with Henley Regatta, all day, trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames will be revised.</p>
⑧	<p><b>Saturday</b> - The 0045 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
