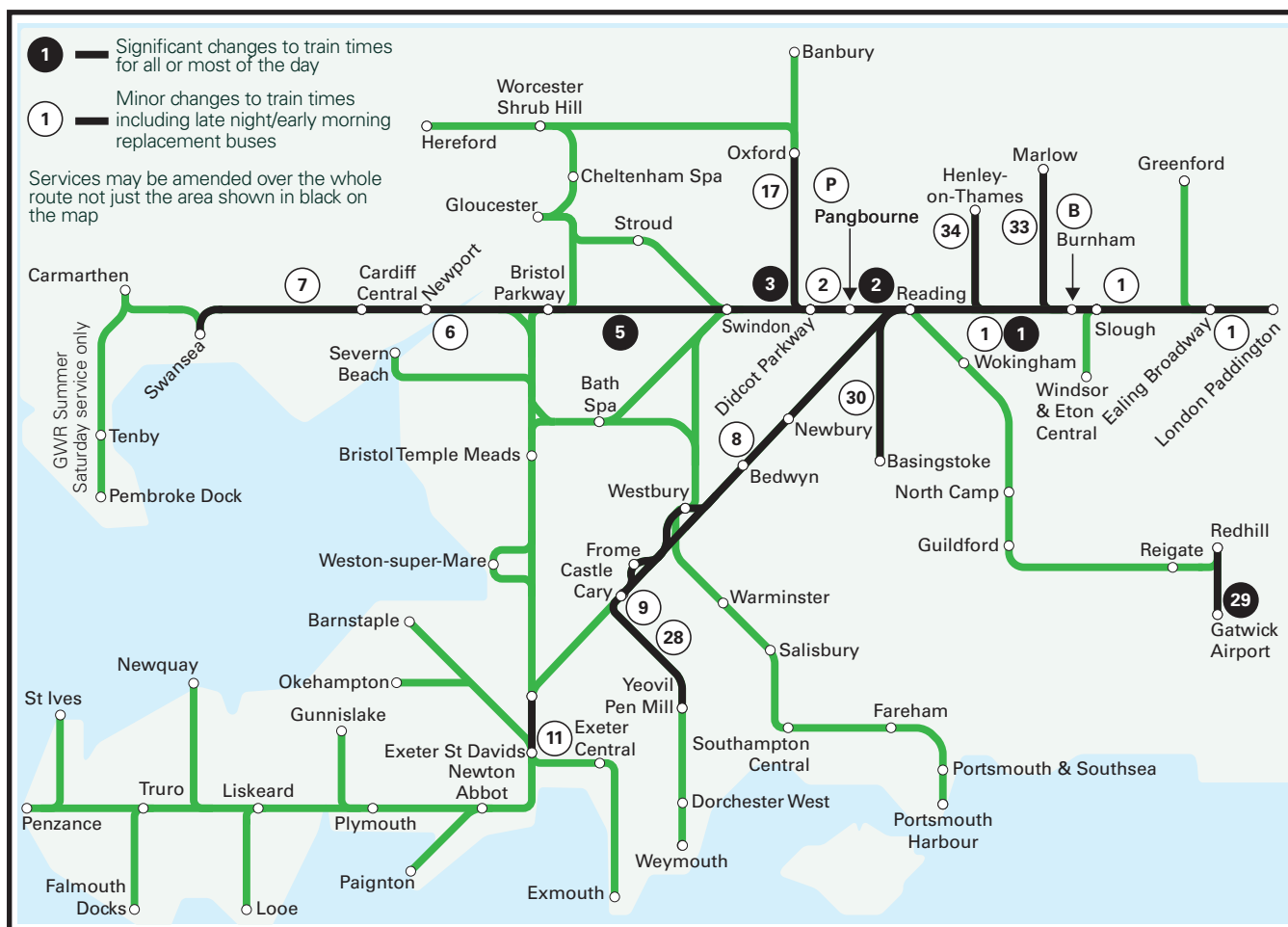


Summary of timetable changes

1 2 3 5 6	<p>Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted via an alternative route between Swindon and Bristol Parkway, extending journey times. Most trains running towards South Wales will depart from London Paddington, Reading, (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon EARLIER than usual. Trains running towards London Paddington will arrive later at Swindon and stations beyond. Most trains running between London Paddington and Swindon or Bristol Parkway only will be retimed, in most cases EARLIER than usual. A few other trains will not run at all.</p> <p>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</p>
1 2	<p>Sunday until approximately 0900 - Trains from London Paddington will be retimed, in some cases EARLIER than usual.</p>
7	<p>Sunday until approximately 1115 - Trains from Swansea to London Paddington will depart from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend a few minutes EARLIER than usual.</p> <p>Monday to Thursday - The 2148 & 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will both finish their journeys at Port Talbot Parkway. Replacement buses will run from Port Talbot Parkway to Neath and Swansea.</p> <p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0338 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Passengers travelling from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend should travel on the next available service.</p>
8	<p>Sunday - The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Newbury. The 0804 (departing at 0747) London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. The 0844 (departing at 0833 London Paddington to Penzance will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey.</p>
9 28	<p>Monday and Tuesday - The 2130 Cardiff Central to Frome and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. Replacement buses will run from Westbury to Frome.</p> <p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. A connecting rail service will run from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual. The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary. Passengers travelling from Yeovil Pen Mill should use the next available service, changing at Westbury for stations towards Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood.</p>
11	<p>Monday to Thursday - The 2348 (Monday & Tuesday) Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will arrive at Exeter St Davids later than usual. The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive at Taunton and Exeter St Davids later than usual.</p>
17	<p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart from Oxford slightly EARLIER than usual. Normal timings from Didcot Parkway onwards.</p>
29	<p>Saturday - The 2335 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p> <p>Sunday - All day, trains between Reading and Gatwick Airport will only run between Reading and Redhill. Replacement buses, operated on behalf of Thameslink, will run between Redhill and Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p> <p>Please note that, due to late notification of this work, this information is not shown on the Summary of planned service changes posters which are on display at stations.</p>
30	<p>Sunday - The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and the 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, departing at 0737 from Reading and at 0745 from Basingstoke. Buses will not call at Reading West, and passengers travelling to / from Reading West should use alternative services running between Reading and Newbury.</p>
33	<p>Sunday - The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.</p>
34	<p>Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.</p>

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading

Tuesday to Thursday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington

Friday - 0045 London Paddington to Reading

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

On Sunday, the following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing 0625) Reading to London Paddington and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:

Sunday - 0738, 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 0818 & 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington

Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
