


Summary of timetable changes



Saturday - The 1818 &1918 London Paddington to Swansea will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service. Sunday until approximately 1530 - Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted to run via Gloucester and will not call at Bristol Parkway. Most trains running towards South Wales will depart from London Paddington, Reading, (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon EARLIER than usual, and journey times will be extended. In most cases, passengers travelling between London Paddington and Bristol Parkway should use alternative scheduled rail services and travel via Bristol Temple Meads. Limited replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway, Newport and Cardiff. A few other trains will not run, or will only run for part of their journey. Saturday - In connection with the Kendrick Lamar concert at Cardiff Principality Stadium, additional late evening trains will run from Cardiff Central to Swansea. Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be subject to a slight increase in journey time between Newport and Cardiff Central. Most trains from South Wales to London Paddington will depart from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway, Bridgend and Cardiff Central a few minutes EARLIER than usual. Saturday - In connection with the Kendrick Lamar concert at Cardiff Principality Stadium, additional late evening trains will run from Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads. Sunday until approximately 12noon - Trains between Cardiff Central and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be diverted to start from / finish at Bristol Parkway. A few trains will also not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Replacement buses will run between Cardiff Central / Newport and Bristol Parkway. Monday and Tuesday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run a few minutes later from Patchway onwards. Monday to Thursday from approximately 2130 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn. A few other trains will either not run, or will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual. Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service. Monday to Thursday - Due to engineering work taking place elsewhere on the network, the 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury will run up to 4 minutes 9 22 later throughout. Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. A connecting rail service will run from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual. Sunday - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive at Exeter St Davids later than usual. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart **(11)** Exeter St Davids slightly EARLIER than usual. Monday to Thursday from approximately 2200 until end of service each evening - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton / Exeter St Davids will either be diverted to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, or will not run between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton. Replacement buses will run instead. The 2244 Taunton to Bristol Temple Meads will depart EARLIER and will call at Weston-super-Mare only. Sunday - The 2059 Exmouth to Paignton will finish its journey at Newton Abbot. A replacement bus will run from Newton Abbot to Paignton. The 2240 Paignton to Exeter St Davids will start from Newton Abbot. A replacement bus will run from Paignton to Exeter St Davids, departing later than usual. Monday to Wednesday - The 2225 Exmouth to Paignton will finish its journey at Newton Abbot. A replacement bus will run from Newton Abbot to Paignton. Tuesday to Thursday - The 0002 Paignton to Exeter St Davids will start from Newton Abbot. A replacement bus will run from Paignton to Exeter St Davids, departing later than usual. Saturday - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - The 0612 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. An alternative EARLIER rail connection, operated by Thameslink, will be available from Gatwick Airport to Redhill, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

Sunday - The 0935 (departing 0846) London Paddington to Carmarthen will finish its journey at Swansea. A connecting rail service will run from Swansea to Carmarthen. The 1125 Carmarthen to London Paddington will start from Swansea. A connecting rail service will run from Carmarthen to Swansea.

Saturday - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and the 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
