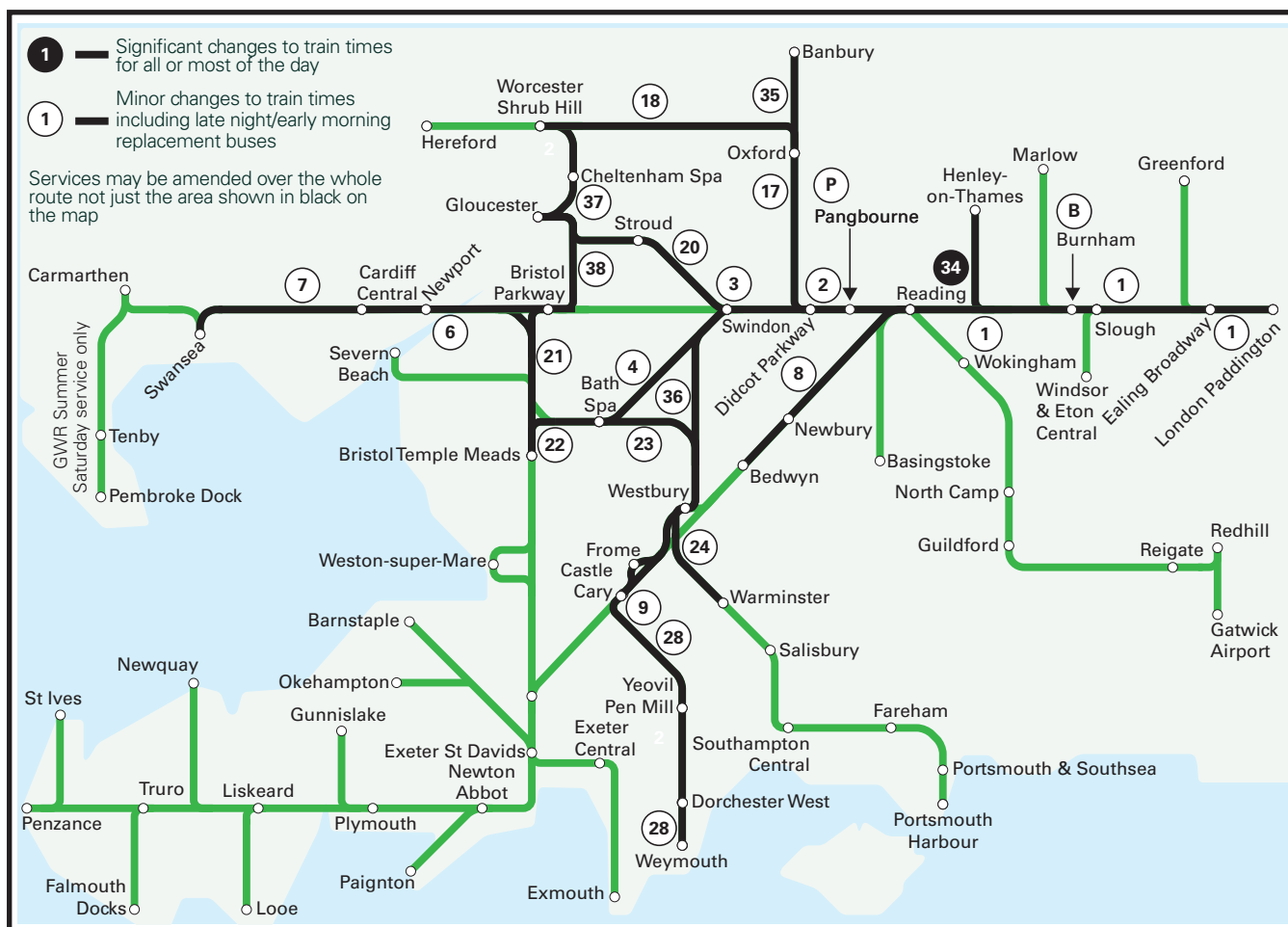


Summary of timetable changes

1 2 17	<p>Saturday from approximately 2230 until end of service - Trains between London Paddington / Didcot Parkway and Oxford will be replaced by buses between Oxford and Didcot Parkway.</p> <p>Sunday until approximately 0900 - Trains between London Paddington and Reading will be subject to slightly extended journey times. A few trains will depart from London Paddington EARLIER than usual. The 0836 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will depart at 0848 and run later throughout. The 0754 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers travelling from Oxford should use the next available service.</p>
2 3 4 22	<p>Sunday - The 1053 Swindon to Bristol Temple Meads will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.</p> <p>Sunday - The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling to Didcot Parkway should change at Reading for an alternative local service.</p>
6 7 21	<p>Friday - In connection with the Catfish & The Bottlemen concert at Cardiff Principality Stadium, the 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers travelling beyond Bristol Temple Meads will need to travel on a later service to complete their journey. An additional train will also run at 2156 from Bristol Temple Meads to Cardiff Central. Additional late evening trains will run from Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads and from Cardiff Central to Swansea.</p>
7	<p>Sunday - The 2045 & 2145 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run up to approximately 25 minutes later from Brigend to Swansea.</p> <p>Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run up to approximately 25 minutes later from Brigend to Swansea.</p>
8	<p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.</p>
9 22 23 24 28 36	<p>Saturday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.</p> <p>Sunday - The 0806 Warminster to Swindon and the 0908 Swindon to Westbury will be replaced by buses between Warminster / Westbury and Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon. The 0839 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads will depart at 0924 and will run later throughout, not calling at Avoncliff or Freshford. The 0900 Westbury to Weymouth will depart at 0940 and run later throughout and the 0908 Bristol Temple Meads to Weymouth will run later from Yeovil Pen Mill onwards. The 1038 Weymouth to Swindon will depart at 1127 and run later to Chippenham where it will finish its journey. The 1332 Swindon to Weymouth will start from Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon.</p> <p>Monday to Thursday - The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.</p>
17 18	<p>Monday to Thursday - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, then run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will finish its journey at Oxford. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill and re-start from Oxford, with no connection between the two parts. Replacement buses will run between Oxford and Worcester Shrub Hill.</p>
20 37 38	<p>Sunday until approximately 1900 - Trains between London Paddington / Swindon and Cheltenham Spa and trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street will not call at Gloucester. The 0955 Worcester Shrub Hill to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Cheltenham Spa, with a replacement bus from Worcester Shrub Hill to Cheltenham Spa, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0905 Gloucester to Swindon and trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Gloucester will not run at all. Replacement buses will run between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa.</p> <p>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</p>
34	<p>Monday to Friday - All week, buses will replace trains between Twyford and Henley-on-Thames. In some cases, buses will depart EARLIER than trains and journey times will be extended. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</p>
35	<p>Monday to Thursday - The 2231 (departing 2239) Didcot Parkway to Banbury will finish its journey at Oxford. The 2334 Banbury to Oxford will not run. Replacement buses will run between Oxford and Banbury.</p>

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Tuesday to Friday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington.

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

On Sunday, the following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing 0623) & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

Monday to Thursday - The 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and the 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. No replacement transport will be provided - passengers should travel on the next available service.

Friday - The 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
