


Summary of timetable changes

- Tuesday The 1003 London Paddington to Penzance will be diverted after Par to run to Newguay. Passengers travelling to St Austell and beyond will need to travel on an alternative service. The 1615 Penzance to London Paddington will start from Par. Passengers travelling from stations west of Par will need to use an alternative service and change at Par. **12 13** Wednesday to Friday - In connection with the Boardmasters Festival in Newquay, some trains from London Paddington to Penzance will be diverted after Par to run to Newquay. Passengers will not be able to join these trains at stations other than London Paddington, Reading, Plymouth and stations west of Plymouth. Passengers travelling to St Austell and beyond will need to travel on alternative services. Some afternoon trains from Penzance to London Paddington 16 will start their journeys from Par. Passengers travelling from stations west of Par will need to travel on alternative services. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Monday to Thursday - The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Passengers should **(2)(3)** travel EARLIER on the 2314 to Oxford, which will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. A replacement bus will connect out of this train at Didcot Parkway, running to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling from Didcot Parkway. Swindon to Chippenham to Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads will need to travel on an earlier service. **(5)(6)** Monday to Thursday - The 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon to call additionally at Chippenham and Bath Spa, then will run up **(7**) to approximately 30 minutes later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea. Saturday - The 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Newport. An alternative rail connection, operated by Transport for Wales, will **(6)** be available from Newport to Cardiff Central, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot **(7**) Parkway and Bridgend to Cardiff Central to connect into the train. Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be subject to minor retimings between Cardiff Central and Swansea. Monday to Thursday - The 2305 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will finish its journey at Taunton. The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will be replaced by a bus. The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Taunton and will arrive Exeter St Davids earlier than usual. The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER from Plymouth, Totnes and Newton Abbot, depart later from Exeter St Davids, will not call at Taunton and will arrive later at Reading.
 - Saturday from approximately 2015 until end of service A reduced service will run between Bristol Temple Meads, Avonmouth and Severn Beach. Some trains will not run at all and a limited replacement bus service will run instead.
- Sunday until approximately 1600 Buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads, Avonmouth and Severn Beach. 21 39 Sunday - The 1000 Cardiff Central to Taunton and the 1200 & 1400 Cardiff Central to Exeter St Davids will not call at Ashley Down. Passengers travelling to Ashley Down should travel to Bristol Temple Meads and change there for a service back to Ashley Down. Passengers travelling from Ashley Down should travel on an EARLIER service to Filton Abbey Wood and change there for a service to Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond).
- Saturday The 0002 Twyford to Henley-on-Thames will be replaced by a bus, departing EARLIER than usual. The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will be (34) replaced by a bus departing EARLIER than usual, as far as Twyford. A connecting rail service will be available from Twyford to Reading.
 - Tuesday The 1003 London Paddington to Penzance will be diverted after Par to run to Newguay. As a result, the 1416 Par to Newguay will not run. The 1521 Newquay to Par will depart at 1540 and run non-stop to Par. The 1616 Par to Newquay will depart at 1552 and run EARLIER throughout.
 - Wednesday to Friday In connection with the Boardmasters Festival in Newquay, some trains from London Paddington to Penzance will be diverted after Par to run to Newguay. Most local trains between Par and Newguay will be retimed and will run non-stop between Par and Newguay. Replacement buses will run to serve intermediate stations. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
- (**B**) Saturday - The 0045 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
