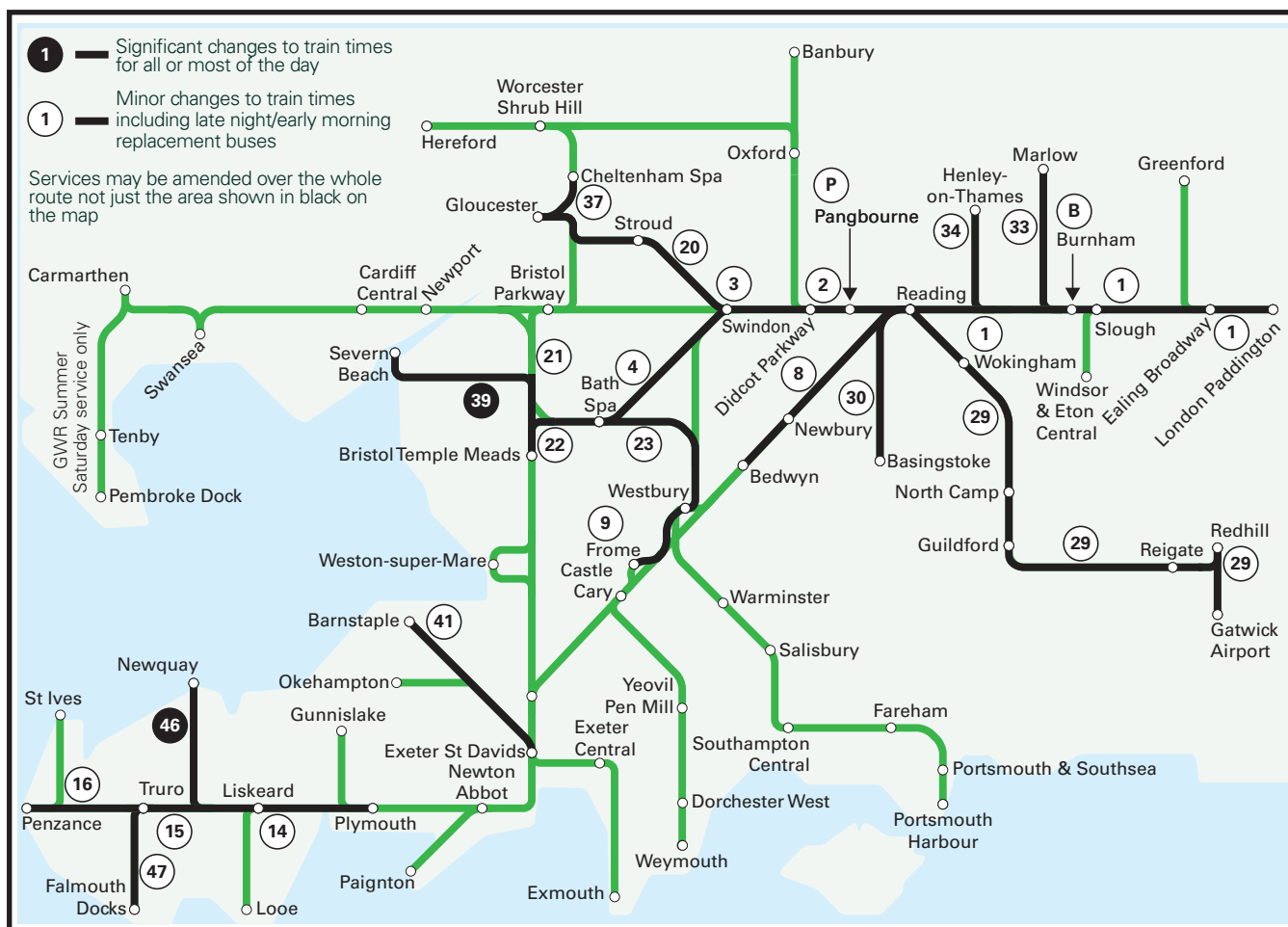


Summary of timetable changes

Sunday - The 0745 Bristol Temple Meads to London Paddington will depart at 0806 and run later throughout.

Monday - In connection with the Boardmasters Festival in Newquay, some trains from London Paddington to Penzance will only run as far as Par. Passengers travelling to St Austell and beyond will need to travel on alternative services. Some afternoon trains from Penzance to London Paddington will be diverted to start their journeys from Newquay. Passengers travelling from stations west of Par will need to travel on alternative services. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

Tuesday and Friday - The 0803 London Paddington to Penzance will finish its journey at Par. Passengers travelling to St Austell and beyond will need to travel on an alternative service. The 1415 Penzance to London Paddington will be diverted to start from Newquay. Passengers travelling from stations west of Par will need to use an alternative service and change at Par.

Monday to Thursday - The 2228 (**Monday to Wednesday**) & 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Swindon to run non-stop to Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will serve Chippenham and Bath Spa.

Saturday until approximately 0700 - Trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn will be revised. Some trains will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey, departing EARLIER than usual.

Sunday - The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Newbury. The 0804 (departing at 0747) London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. Passengers should travel on an alternative later service. The 2333 Newbury to Reading will be replaced by a bus.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.

Monday to Thursday - The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. Replacement buses will run from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads.

Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will be diverted to run non-stop from Swindon to Gloucester, where it will finish its journey. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, serving stations via Stroud.

Monday to Friday - Off-peak service frequency between Bristol Temple Meads, Avonmouth and Severn Beach will be reduced to hourly. Some other trains will be retimed. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

Monday to Thursday - The 2333 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Gatwick Airport. The 2332 Gatwick Airport to Reading will finish its journey at Redhill. A replacement bus will run from Redhill to Guildford, with a connecting rail service from Guildford to Reading.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will run later from Guildford and will finish its journey at Redhill. The 0559 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. Alternative rail connections, operated by Southern, will be available between Redhill and Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

Sunday - The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and the 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, departing at 0737 from Reading and at 0745 from Basingstoke. Buses will not call at Reading West, and passengers travelling to / from Reading West should use alternative services running between Reading and Newbury.

Sunday - The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.

Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

Monday to Wednesday - The 2054 Exmouth (2129 from Exeter St Davids) to Barnstaple will finish its journey at Crediton. A replacement bus will run from Crediton to Barnstaple and a taxi from Crediton to Yeoford. The 2241 Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids will not run. A replacement bus will run from Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids. Yeoford will be served by a separate taxi service to / from Crediton.

Sunday - The 1306 Plymouth to London Paddington will start back from Newquay. Some other trains between Par and Newquay will be retimed.

Monday - In connection with the Boardmasters Festival in Newquay, some trains from Penzance to London Paddington will be diverted to start from Newquay. Most local trains between Par and Newquay will not run and will be replaced by buses. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

Tuesday and Friday - The 1415 Penzance to London Paddington will be diverted to start from Newquay. As a result, the 1216 Par to Newquay and the 1320 Newquay to Par will not run. Some other trains will also be retimed.

Wednesday - All day, in connection with Falmouth Week, trains will NOT call at Falmouth Town. Passengers should use Falmouth Docks station instead. Some additional evening trains will run.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

Tuesday to Thursday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;

Friday - 0045 London Paddington to Reading;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

On Sunday, the following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing 0625) Reading to London Paddington and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

Sunday - The 0738, 0836 (departing 0838), 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and the 0818, 0918, 1012 (departing 1017) & 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.

Friday - The 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
