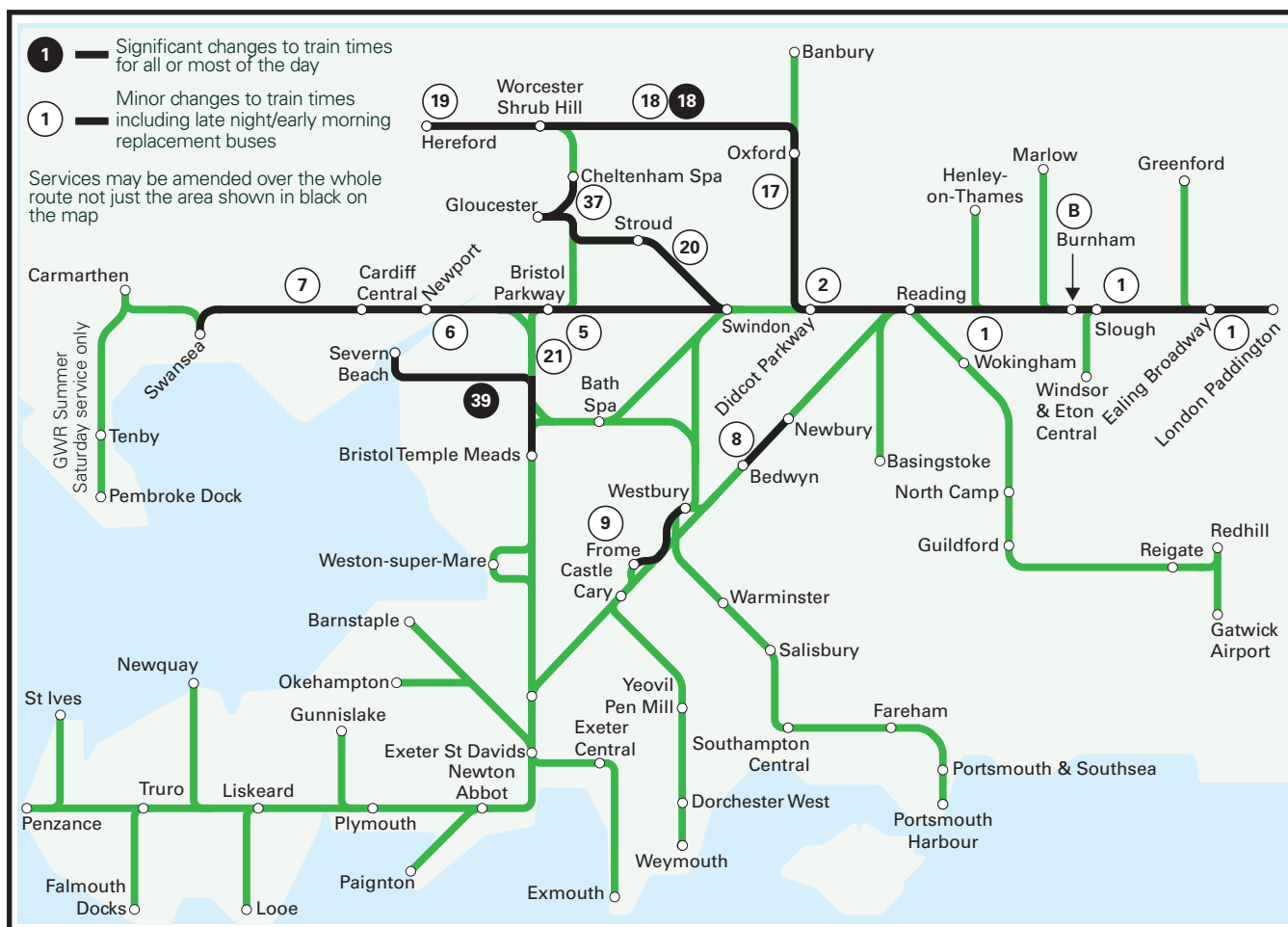


Summary of timetable changes

① ② ①⑦ ①⑧	Saturday from approximately 2230 until end of service - Trains between London Paddington / Didcot Parkway and Oxford will be replaced by buses between Oxford and Didcot Parkway. Sunday until approximately 0900 - Trains between London Paddington and Reading will be subject to slightly extended journey times. A few trains will depart from London Paddington EARLIER than usual. The 0836 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will depart at 0848 and run later throughout. The 0847 London Paddington to Great Malvern will depart at 0844 and will also run slightly later from Reading onwards. The 0754 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers travelling from Oxford should use the next available service.
⑤ ⑥ ⑦	Monday to Thursday - The 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.
⑥	Saturday - The 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Newport. An alternative rail connection, operated by Transport for Wales, will be available from Newport to Cardiff Central, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
⑦	Sunday until approximately 1900 - Some trains between London Paddington and Swansea / Carmarthen will be subject to minor retimings between Cardiff Central and Swansea. A few trains will depart slightly EARLIER than usual.
⑧	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn.
⑨	Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. A connecting rail service will run from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual.
⑬ ⑰	Monday to Friday - All week, buses will replace trains between Moreton-in-Marsh and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street. A revised service will run between London Paddington / Oxford and Moreton-in-Marsh, and between Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street, Great Malvern and Hereford. A very limited direct service will continue to run between London Paddington, Worcester, Great Malvern and Hereford, diverted via an alternative route. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
⑳ ㉔	Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER and will be diverted to run non-stop to Gloucester, where it will finish its journey. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, serving stations via Stroud.
㉑ ㉓	Monday to Friday - Off-peak service frequency will be reduced to hourly. Some other trains will be retimed. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
B	Saturday - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and the 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
