


## Summary of timetable changes

ALL	Monday - In addition to planned engineering work, a revised, and in a few cases, reduced Bank Holiday service will run on some routes.
ROUTES	Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
12 34 2240	Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run. Tuesday to Friday - All week, most trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will not run. As a result, most trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway.
6 21	<b>Sunday</b> - All day, most trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will not run between Cardiff Central and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should travel on alternative scheduled rail services instead.
	Sunday - The 2045 & 2145 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run up to approximately 25 minutes later from Brigend
7	to Swansea. Monday to Thursday - The 2048, 2148 & 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run up to approximately 25 minutes later from Brigend to Swansea.
9 28	Monday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington and the 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will both start from Westbury. Passengers travelling from stations before Westbury should use the next available service. The 0625 Westbury to Frome will run 5 minutes later than usual. <b>Tuesday to Friday</b> - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. A connecting rail service will run from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual. The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary. Passengers travelling from Yeovil Pen Mill should use the next available service.
11	Monday to Thursday - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive at Taunton and, on Monday and Tuesday nights, at Exeter St Davids later than usual. The 2348 (Monday) Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will arrive at Exeter St Davids later than usual.
17	From approximately 2300 Sunday until 0130 Monday - Scheduled replacement buses running between Didcot Parkway, Radley and Oxford will not run, and will be replaced by rail services, running at slightly later times. Tuesday to Friday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart EARLIER from Oxford. Normal timings from Didcot Parkway onwards.
18 (19	<ul> <li>Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Moreton-in-Marsh and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street. A revised service will run between London Paddington / Oxford and Moreton-in-Marsh, and between Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street, Great Malvern and Hereford. On Saturday only, a direct train will run from Great Malvern to London Paddington at 0743, diverted via an alternative route.</li> <li>Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</li> <li>Monday - The 0516 &amp; 0643 Worcester Shrub Hill to London Paddington will start from Oxford. Passengers travelling from stations west of Oxford should use an alternative earlier (where available) or later service.</li> </ul>
20 37	<b>Tuesday to Friday</b> - All week, trains will not run between Swindon and Gloucester via Stroud. Most trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will also not run. A <b>very</b> limited direct service will run between Swindon and Gloucester / Cheltenham Spa via Bristol Parkway, otherwise, passengers will need to use alternative scheduled rail services and change trains at Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will run between Swindon and Gloucester, serving Kemble, Stroud and Stonehouse Town Hall. Passengers travelling to / from Cheltenham Spa should use alternative scheduled rail services. A few other trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

(22) (23) (24)	Sunday - All day, most trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will only run between Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour. Some trains running between Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury / Salisbury will not run, and other trains will make additional stops as a result. The 0801 Weymouth to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Bristol Temple Meads. The 1744 Swindon to Salisbury will finish its journey at Westbury. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
34	Tuesday to Friday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
B	<ul> <li>The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:</li> <li>Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;</li> <li>Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;</li> <li>Tuesday to Friday - 0002 &amp; 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington.</li> <li>In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</li> <li>On Sunday, the following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing 0623) &amp; 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.</li> </ul>
P	<ul> <li>Monday to Wednesday - The 2236 &amp; 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and the 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.</li> <li>Tuesday to Thursday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. No replacement transport will be provided - passengers should travel on the next available service.</li> <li>Friday - The 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.</li> </ul>
