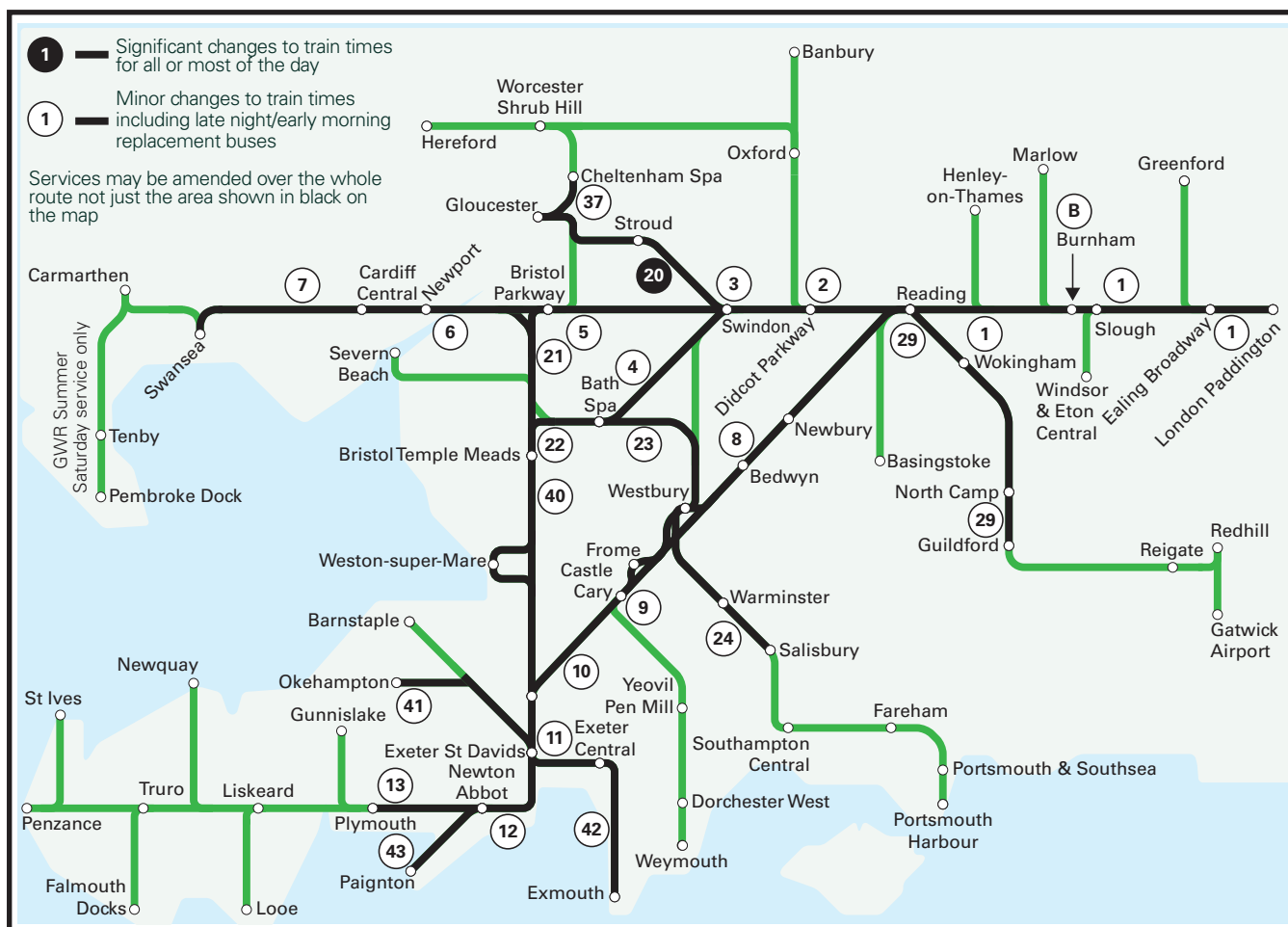

①	Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
① ② ③ ⑤	Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Trains between London Paddington and Swindon will be revised. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be retimed, with some trains departing EARLIER than usual.
① ② ③ ④ ②② ④①	Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run.
	Sunday - All day, most trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will not run between Cardiff Central and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should travel on alternative scheduled rail services instead.
⑥ ②①	Monday and Tuesday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run a few minutes later from Patchway onwards. Monday to Thursday - The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will not call at Stapleton Road or Lawrence Hill. A replacement bus will run from Filton Abbey Wood to Bristol Temple Meads, calling at Stapleton Road and Lawrence Hill.
⑦	Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend to Cardiff Central to connect into the train. Monday to Thursday - The 2148 & 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will both finish their journeys at Neath. Replacement buses will run from Neath to Swansea. Tuesday to Friday - 0338 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Neath. A replacement bus will run from Swansea to Neath to connect into the train.
⑧	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2130 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn. A few other trains will either not run, or will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual. Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
⑧ ⑨ ⑩ ⑪ ⑫ ⑬ ④③	Sunday - Most trains from London Paddington to the West of England will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. The 1032 Paignton to London Paddington will not run and the 0918 Penzance to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary. The 1436 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will not run and the 1503 (departing 1459) London Paddington to Plymouth will call additionally at Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary, then will run later from Taunton to Plymouth.
⑨	Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will start from Westbury. A connecting rail service will run from Frome to Westbury, departing slightly EARLIER than usual.
②① ③⑦	Saturday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Cheltenham Spa will only run between London Paddington and Swindon. A very limited direct service will run between London Paddington / Swindon and Gloucester / Cheltenham Spa via Bristol Parkway, otherwise, passengers will need to use alternative scheduled rail services and change trains at Bristol Parkway. Replacement buses will run between Swindon and Gloucester, serving Kemble, Stroud and Stonehouse Town Hall. Passengers travelling to / from Cheltenham Spa should use alternative scheduled rail services. A few other trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
②② ②③ ②④	Sunday - All day, most trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will only run between Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour. Some trains running between Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury / Salisbury will not run, and other trains will make additional stops as a result. The 0801 Weymouth to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Bristol Temple Meads. The 1744 Swindon to Salisbury will finish its journey at Westbury. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

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- ②⑨ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will finish its journey at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.
Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport and the 0500 Reading to Redhill will both start from Guildford. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Reading to Guildford to connect into the trains. The 0531 Reading to Gatwick Airport will depart slightly EARLIER and call additionally at Crowthorne, Sandhurst, Farnborough North and Ash.
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- ④① **Monday to Wednesday** - The 2117 Exeter St Davids to Okehampton and the 2219 Okehampton to Exeter St Davids will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, extending journey times.
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- ④② **Monday to Thursday** - The 2340 (**Monday to Wednesday**) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (**Tuesday to Thursday**) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, extending journey times.
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- Ⓑ **Saturday** - The 0045 London Paddington to Reading will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
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
