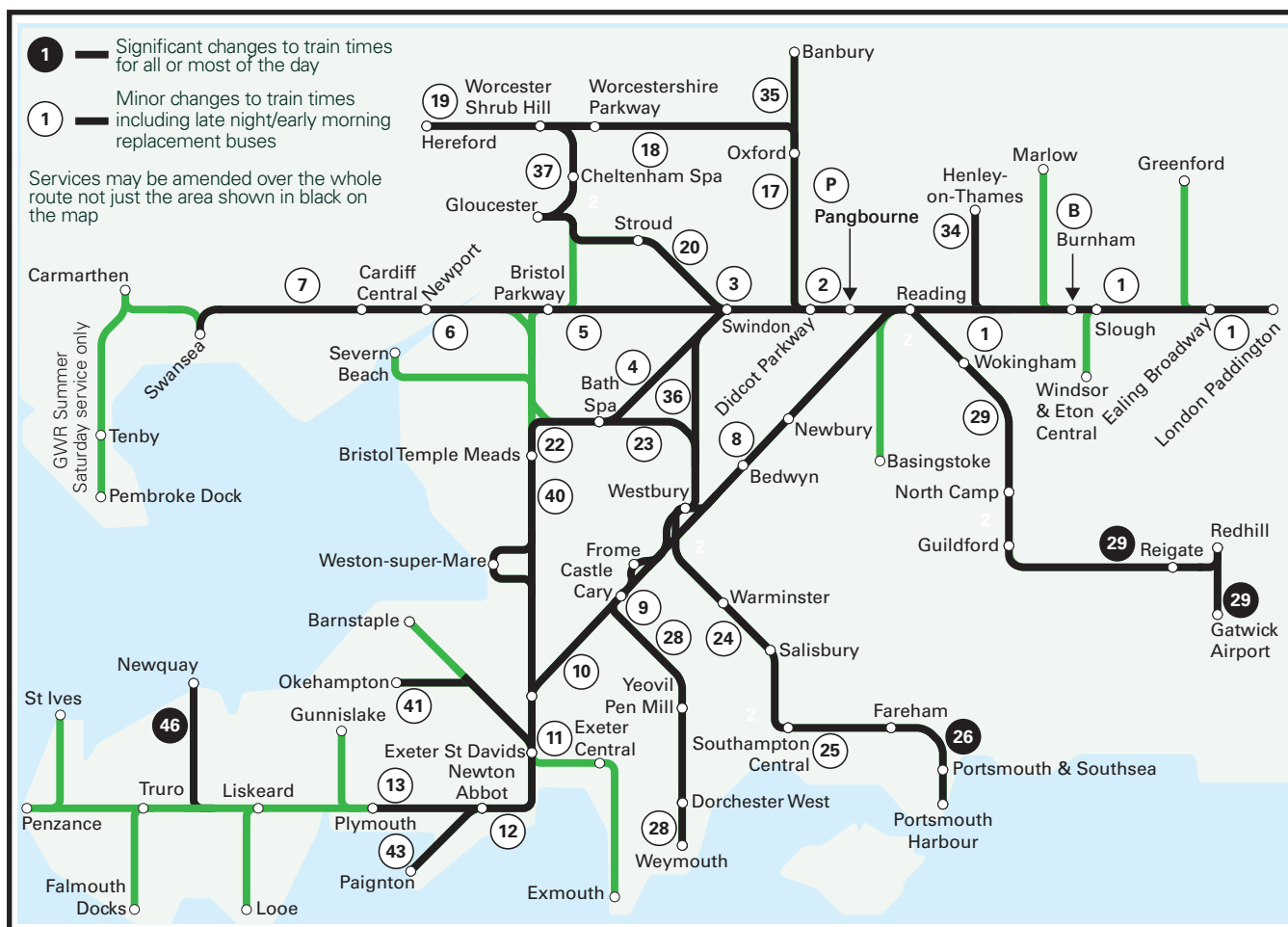


Summary of timetable changes

①	Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
① ② ③ ⑤	Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Trains between London Paddington and Swindon will be revised. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be retimed, with some trains departing EARLIER than usual.
① ② ③ ④ ②② ④①	Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run. The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa, not calling at Swindon or Chippenham. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers for Didcot Parkway should travel on the 2333 service and change at Reading for an alternative local service to Didcot Parkway.
⑤ ⑥ ⑦	Monday to Wednesday - The 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run later from Bristol Parkway onwards.
⑧	Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.
⑧ ⑨ ⑩ ⑪ ⑫ ⑬ ④③	Sunday - Most trains from London Paddington to the West of England will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. The 1032 Paignton to London Paddington will not run and the 0918 Penzance to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary. The 1436 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will not run and the 1503 (departing 1459) London Paddington to Plymouth will call additionally at Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary, then will run later from Taunton to Plymouth.
⑨ ②② ②③ ②④ ②⑧ ③⑥	Saturday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome. Sunday - The 0806 Warminster to Swindon and the 0908 Swindon to Westbury will be replaced by buses between Warminster / Westbury and Chippenham, in some cases, departing EARLIER than usual. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon. The 0839 Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads will depart at 0924 and will run later throughout, not calling at Avoncliff or Freshford. The 0900 Westbury to Weymouth will depart at 0940 and run later throughout and the 0908 Bristol Temple Meads to Weymouth will run later from Yeovil Pen Mill onwards. The 1038 Weymouth to Swindon will depart at 1127 and run later to Chippenham where it will finish its journey. The 1332 Swindon to Weymouth will start its journey from Chippenham. Alternative rail connections will be available between Chippenham and Swindon. Monday to Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and the 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with a connecting rail service from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.

	<p>Sunday until approximately 1645 - Buses will replace trains between Worcestershire Parkway and Worcester Shrub Hill, Worcester Foregate Street and Great Malvern. Rail services, operated by West Midlands Railway, will continue to run between Worcester Foregate Street, Great Malvern and Hereford. The 1658 Great Malvern to London Paddington will start from Worcester Shrub Hill and the 1730 Hereford to London Paddington will start from Great Malvern.</p>
17 18 19	<p>Monday to Thursday - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, then be diverted to run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. A connecting rail service will run from Didcot Parkway to Oxford, with a replacement bus from Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will finish its journey at Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill, and will re-start from Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford, and, at Kingham, Charlbury and Hanborough will only stop to drop passengers off. It will also not connect into the train to London Paddington at Oxford.</p>
20 37	<p>Sunday until approximately 1645 - Buses will replace trains between Gloucester and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street.</p> <p>Monday to Thursday - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER and be diverted to run non-stop to, and finish its journey at, Gloucester. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, serving stations via Stroud.</p>
22 23 24 25 26	<p>Saturday - The 2030 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will finish its journey at Fareham. An alternative rail connection, operated by SWR, will be available from Fareham to Portsmouth Harbour, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p> <p>Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Fareham and Portsmouth Harbour. The 1750 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will finish its journey at Westbury and the 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will not run at all. Passengers should use alternative services to complete their journey.</p> <p>Monday - The 0450 Fratton to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Fareham and the 0703 Salisbury to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Westbury. Passengers should use alternative services to complete their journey.</p>
29 29	<p>Saturday - The 2335 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.</p> <p>Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Passengers travelling between Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use alternative rail services provided by other operators. A few other trains will not run. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.</p>
34	<p>Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.</p>
35	<p>Monday to Thursday - The 2231 (departing 2239) Didcot Parkway to Banbury will finish its journey at Oxford. The 2334 Banbury to Oxford will not run at all. Replacement buses will run between Oxford and Banbury.</p>
41	<p>Monday to Wednesday - The 2117 Exeter St Davids to Okehampton and the 2219 Okehampton to Exeter St Davids will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, extending journey times.</p>
46	<p>Wednesday to Thursday - Trains between Par and Newquay will not run. Replacement buses will run between St Austell and Newquay. Passengers travelling to / from Par should use scheduled rail services between Par and St Austell.</p>
B	<p>Tuesday to Friday - The 0002 (Tuesday to Thursday) & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and the 0019 (Tuesday to Thursday) Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.</p>
P	<p>Friday - The 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.</p>
