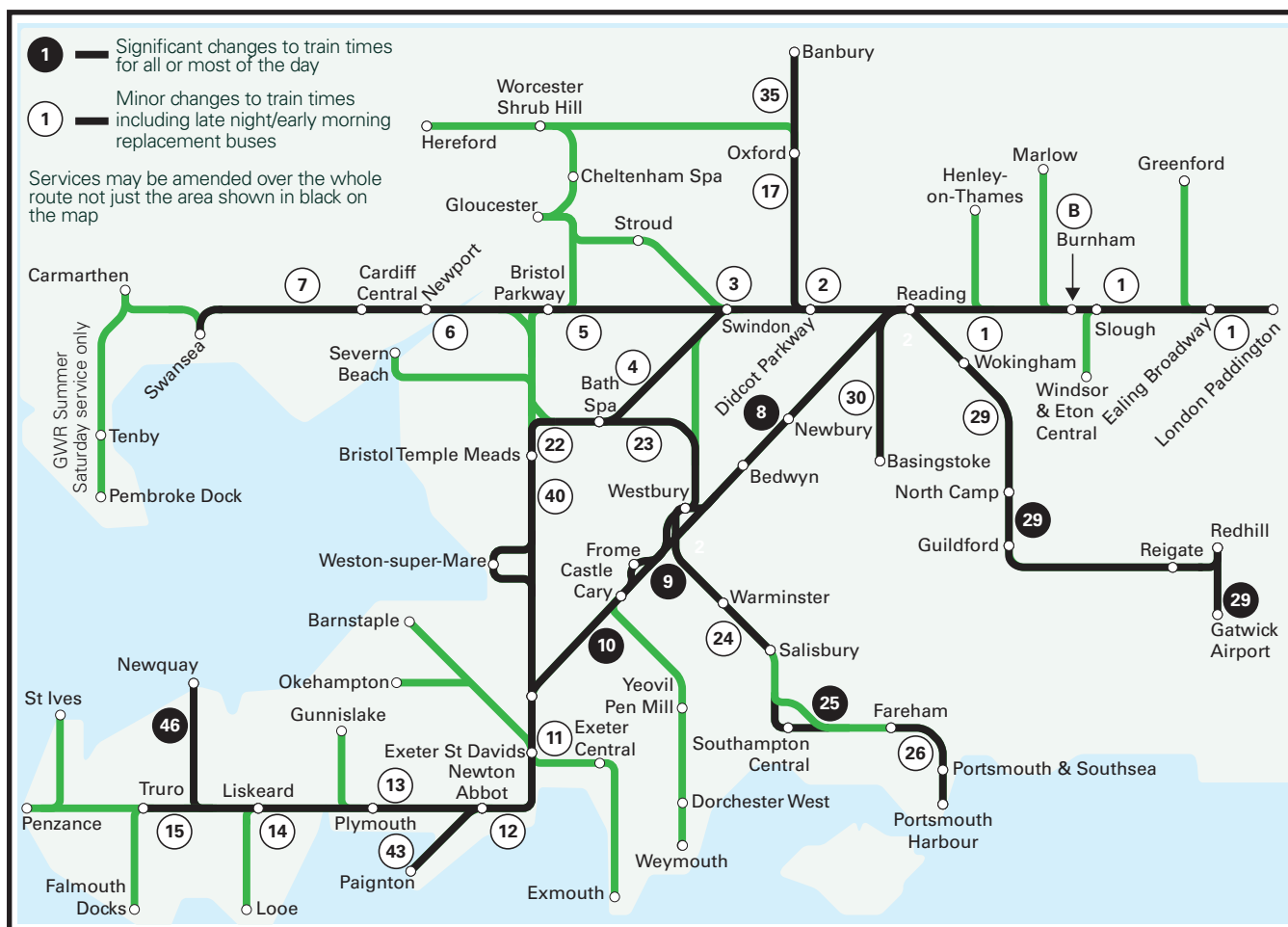

①	Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
① ② ③ ⑤	Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Trains between London Paddington and Swindon will be revised, and will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford, in place of local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway, which will mostly only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway.
① ② ③ ④ ②② ④①	Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run. Monday to Thursday - The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Passengers should travel EARLIER on the 2314 to Oxford, which will call additionally at Didcot Parkway. A replacement bus will connect out of this train at Didcot Parkway, running to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling from Didcot Parkway, Swindon to Chippenham to Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads will need to travel on an earlier service.
⑤ ⑥ ⑦	Monday to Thursday - The 2048 & 2148 London Paddington to Swansea will be subject to slightly extended journey times between Cardiff Central and Swansea. Monday to Thursday - The 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon to call additionally at Chippenham and Bath Spa, and will run later from Bristol Parkway onwards.
⑧ ⑨ ⑩ ⑪ ⑫ ⑬ ④③	Sunday - Trains between London Paddington and the West of England will be revised. Trains will be diverted, not calling at Newbury, Hungerford, Pewsey, Westbury or Castle Cary, but will call additionally at Bristol Temple Meads and some will also call additionally at Swindon. Most trains will depart EARLIER from London Paddington and Reading. Some trains will not run, including all direct trains between London Paddington and Paignton. Passengers travelling to / from intermediate stations between Reading and Taunton should use alternative rail connections, changing where necessary to complete their journey. Pewsey will be served by replacement buses running to / from Swindon only. Replacement buses will also run between Westbury, Castle Cary and Taunton. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
⑨ ②② ②③ ②④	Saturday - The 2215 & 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. The 2316 Frome to Westbury will not run. Replacement buses will run between Westbury and Frome. Sunday - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Frome / Castle Cary / Weymouth will be replaced by buses between Westbury, Frome and Castle Cary. A few other trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury / Salisbury will not run, and certain trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will make additional stops. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
⑭ ⑮	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, due to closure of the railway between Par and Newquay, some other trains that would normally run between London Paddington / Exeter St Davids / Plymouth and Newquay will either not run at all, will not run between Plymouth and Newquay, or will be diverted to run to / from St Austell.
⑰	Sunday - The 1456, 1656 & 1756 Oxford to London Paddington will all run slightly later throughout.
②④ ②⑤ ②⑥	Sunday - All day, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, not calling at Southampton Central, but calling additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Replacement buses will run between Eastleigh and Southampton Central. The 1750 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will finish its journey at Westbury and the 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will not run. A few other trains will make additional stops. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Monday - The 0703 Salisbury to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Westbury. Passengers should use alternative services to complete their journey.

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Saturday - The 2335 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Gatwick Airport.

Sunday - All day, trains will run between Reading and Ash only. Replacement buses will run between North Camp, Guildford and Gatwick Airport, between North Camp, Guildford, Gomshall and stations to Redhill, and between Guildford, Shalford, Chilworth and Gomshall. Passengers should interchange between trains and buses at North Camp, rather than at Ash. Passengers travelling between Reigate, Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use alternative rail services provided by other operators. A few other trains will not run. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

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Monday to Friday - All week, trains will run between Reading and Guildford only. Replacement buses will run between Guildford and Gatwick Airport and between Guildford and Redhill. These buses will not call at Chilworth after approximately 2200 each evening, **with no other replacement transport provided.** Passengers travelling between Reigate, Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use alternative rail services provided by other operators. A few other trains will not run. **Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

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Sunday - The 0737 Reading to Basingstoke will not run. Passengers should travel on the next available service.

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Sunday - The 0944 Oxford to Banbury will run slightly later throughout.

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Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Par and Newquay will not run. Replacement buses will run between St Austell and Newquay. Passengers travelling to / from Par should use scheduled rail services between Par and St Austell.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading, 0019 Reading to London Paddington and 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

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In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

On Sunday, the following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing 0623) & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
