


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 20 to Friday 26 September 2025

- Saturday from approximately 2230 until end of service Trains between London Paddington / Didcot Parkway and Oxford will be replaced by buses between Oxford and Didcot Parkway.
- Sunday The 0754 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers travelling from Oxford should use the next available service. The 1456, 1656 & 1756 Oxford to London Paddington will all run slightly later throughout.
- Sunday All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Trains between London Paddington and Swindon will be revised, and will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford, in place of local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway, which will mostly only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway.
- Sunday All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run.
- Monday to Thursday The 2228 & 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Swindon to run non-stop to Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run from Swindon to Bristol Temple Meads, serving Chippenham and Bath Spa.
- Sunday The 0755, 0835, 0923 (departing 0922), 1022 & 1133 Swansea to London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings running through Cardiff Central. Wednesday and Thursday The 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be retimed approximately 11 minutes later from Newport onwards.

 Saturday until approximately 0700 Trains between Reading. Newbury and Bedwyn will be revised. Some trains will be replaced by buses for all or part of
 - **Saturday until approximately 0700** Irains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn will be revised. Some trains will be replaced by buses for all or part of their journey, departing EARLIER than usual.
 - **Sunday** -The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury. A replacement bus will run from Reading to Newbury. The 2333 Newbury to Reading will be replaced by a bus.
 - Tuesday to Friday The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.
- Sunday Trains between London Paddington and the West of England will be revised. Trains will be diverted, not calling at Newbury, Hungerford, Pewsey, Westbury or Castle Cary, but will call additionally at Bristol Temple Meads and some will also call additionally at Swindon. Most trains will depart EARLIER from London Paddington and Reading. Some trains will not run, including all direct trains between London Paddington and Paignton. Passengers travelling to / from intermediate stations between Reading and Taunton should use alternative rail connections, changing where necessary to complete their journey. Pewsey will be served by replacement buses running to / from Swindon only. Replacement buses will also run between Westbury, Castle Cary and Taunton.

 Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
 - **Saturday** 2215 & 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. 2316 Frome to Westbury will not run. Replacement buses will run between Westbury and Frome.
- Sunday Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Frome / Castle Cary / Weymouth will be replaced by buses between Westbury, Frome and Castle Cary. A few other trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Westbury / Salisbury will not run, and certain trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will make additional stops. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
 - **Monday to Thursday** The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will not run. Replacement buses will run from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bristol Temple Meads.
- Monday to Thursday The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will be diverted to run non-stop from Swindon to Gloucester, where it will finish its journey. A replacement bus will run from Swindon to Cheltenham Spa, serving stations via Stroud.
- Monday and Tuesday The 2330 Cardiff Central to Bristol Temple Meads will run slightly later from Patchway onwards.

- Sunday The 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted to run non-stop from Southampton Central to Fareham, not calling at Southampton Airport Parkway, Eastleigh, Hedge End or Botley. Passengers travelling to / from these stations should use alternative services provided by other operators.
- Saturday to Friday All week, trains will run between Reading and Guildford only. Replacement buses will run between Guildford and Gatwick Airport and between Guildford and Redhill. These buses will not call at Chilworth after approximately 2200 each evening, with no other replacement transport provided. Passengers travelling between Reigate, Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use alternative rail services provided by other operators. A few other trains will not run. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
- **Sunday** All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke. Buses will not call at Reading West. Passengers travelling to / from Reading West should use alternative rail services running between Reading and Newbury.
- (33) Sunday The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.
- Tuesday to Friday The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
- Monday to Thursday The 2054 Exmouth (2129 Exeter St Davids) to Barnstaple will finish its journey at Crediton. A replacement bus will run from Crediton to Barnstaple and a taxi from Crediton to Yeoford. The 2241 Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids will not run. A replacement bus will run from Barnstaple to Exeter St Davids. Yeoford will be served by a separate taxi service to / from Crediton.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

Saturday - 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

(B) Tuesday to Friday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington. In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

On Sunday, the following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing 0625) Reading to London Paddington and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following GWR trains will not call at Pangbourne:

Sunday - 0738, 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 0818 & 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Monday to Thursday - 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Tuesday to Friday - 0355 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided - passengers should travel on the next available service);

Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

Unless otherwise shown, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
