


Summary of timetable changes

Saturday 27 September to Friday 3 October 2025

(1) Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings. **(1)(2)** Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Most trains between London Paddington and Oxford will only run between London Paddington and Didcot Parkway (trains to and from North Cotswolds stations will continue to provide an hourly fast service between London Paddington and Oxford). Local stopping trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be retimed. Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart 1 2 3 4 22 40 slightly EARLIER than usual. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond). Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run. Saturday - The 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Newport. An alternative rail connection, operated by Transport for Wales, will **(6)** be available from Newport to Cardiff Central, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Sunday - The 0755 Swansea to London Paddington will start from Cardiff Central, Replacement buses will run from Swansea and intermediate stations to **(7**) Cardiff Central, departing EARLIER than usual. Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service each evening - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn. (8) Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service. Sunday - Most trains from London Paddington to the West of England will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. The 1032 Paignton to (8)(9) London Paddington will not run and the 0918 Penzance to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary. The 1436 London Paddington to (10) (11) Exeter St Davids will not run and the 1503 (departing 1459) London Paddington to Plymouth will call additionally at Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary, then **(12) (13)** will run later from Taunton to Plymouth. The 0759 (departing 0747) London Paddington to Exeter St Davids and the 1630 (departing 1623) London Paddington to Plymouth will both finish their journeys at Bristol Temple Meads. The 1800 London Paddington to Plymouth (via Bristol Temple Meads) will not run. The 1322 & 43 1732 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington and the 1502 Plymouth to London Paddington will all start from Bristol Temple Meads. (9) Tuesday - The 0612 Frome to London Paddington will depart slightly later from Frome. Normal timings from Westbury onwards. Saturday - All day, buses will replace trains between Kemble, Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa. Trains between Swindon and Kemble will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual. A few other trains will not run at all. Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Swindon, Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa. Monday to Friday - All week, trains between London Paddington / Swindon and Cheltenham Spa will not call at Gloucester. Most trains from London Paddington to Cheltenham Spa will arrive earlier at Cheltenham Spa and most trains from Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington will depart later from Cheltenham Spa. The 0511 (Monday only) Gloucester to Southampton Central and the 1750 Gloucester to Salisbury will both start from Swindon. Replacement buses will run between Cheltenham Spa and Gloucester. Passengers travelling to or from Gloucester are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling. Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester and between Gloucester, Cheltenham Spa and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street. A few early morning / late evening buses between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester will be extended from / to Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood. Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway will run to a revised timetable. Passengers travelling between Worcester Shrub Hill and Worcester Foregate Street should use alternative scheduled rail services. Monday to Friday - All week, trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Gloucester / Cheltenham Spa / Worcester will either not run, or will run but will not call

at Gloucester. Some other trains will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual. Replacement buses will run between Cam & Dursley and Gloucester and between Cheltenham Spa and Gloucester. **Passengers travelling to or from Gloucester are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.**

Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, not calling at Southampton Central, but mostly calling additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh. Replacement buses will run between Southampton Central and Eastleigh. A few other trains will either not run at all, or will only run for part of their journey.



Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Monday - The 0703 Salisbury to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Westbury. Passengers travelling from Salisbury, Warminster and Dilton Marsh should use an alternative earlier or later service.

Saturday - All day, trains will run between Reading and Guildford only. Replacement buses will run between Guildford and Gatwick Airport and between Guildford and Redhill. These buses will not call at Chilworth after approximately 2200, with no other replacement transport provided. Passengers travelling between Reigate, Redhill and Gatwick Airport should use alternative rail services provided by other operators. A few other trains will not run.



Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.

Sunday - The 0612 Gatwick Airport to Reading will start from Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Thameslink, will run EARLIER from Gatwick Airport to Redhill, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.

Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement non-stop bus will run from Reading to Guildford, departing EARLIER than usual. Passengers travelling to / from other intermediate stations should use the next available service.
