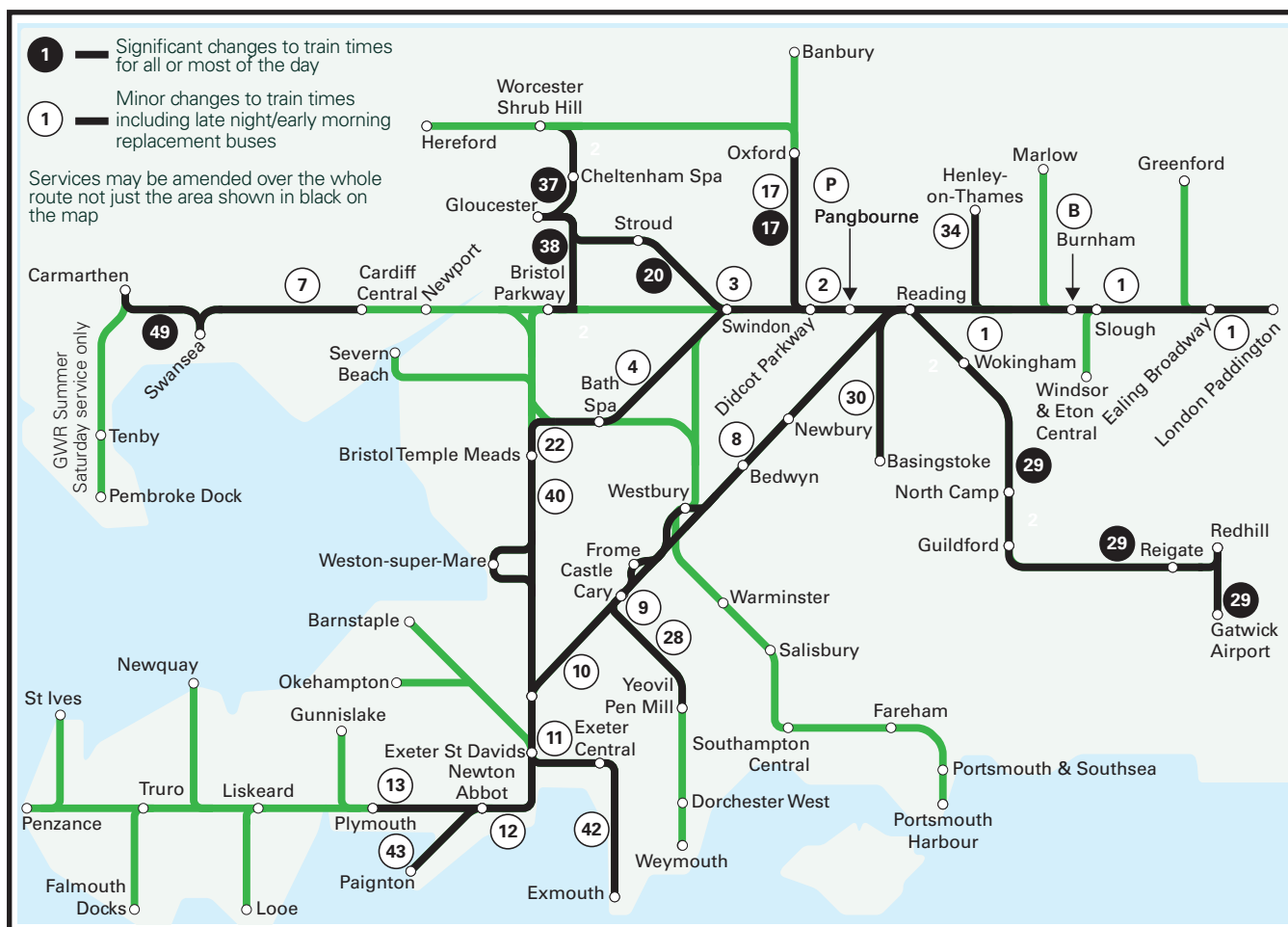

Saturday 4 to Friday 10 October 2025

①	Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
① ② ③ ⑤ 17	Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. Most trains between London Paddington and Oxford will only run between London Paddington and Didcot Parkway (trains to and from North Cotswolds stations will continue to provide an hourly fast service between London Paddington and Oxford). Local stopping trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will be retimed.
① ② ③ ④ 22 40	Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond). Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run.
7	Monday to Thursday - The 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will arrive earlier at Port Talbot Parkway.
8 9 10 11 12 13 43	Sunday - Most trains from London Paddington to the West of England will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. The 1032 Paignton to London Paddington will not run and the 0918 Penzance to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary. The 1436 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will not run and the 1503 (departing 1459) London Paddington to Plymouth will call additionally at Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary, then will run later from Taunton to Plymouth. The 0759 (departing 0747) London Paddington to Exeter St Davids and the 1630 (departing 1623) London Paddington to Plymouth will both finish their journeys at Bristol Temple Meads. The 1800 London Paddington to Plymouth (via Bristol Temple Meads) will not run. The 1322 & 1732 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington and the 1502 Plymouth to London Paddington will all start from Bristol Temple Meads.
9 28	Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to Paddington will start from Westbury. An EARLIER rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury. The 0618 Yeovil Pen Mill to Filton Abbey Wood will start from Castle Cary. Passengers travelling from Yeovil Pen Mill should travel on the next available service.
17	Tuesday to Friday - The 0355 Oxford to Reading will depart from Oxford slightly EARLIER than usual. Normal timings from Didcot Parkway onwards.
20 37	Saturday - All day, buses will replace trains between Kemble, Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa. Trains between Swindon and Kemble will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual. A few other trains will not run at all. Sunday - All day, buses will replace trains between Swindon, Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa.
21 37 38	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester and between Gloucester, Cheltenham Spa and Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street. A few early morning / late evening buses between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester will be extended from / to Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood. Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Bristol Parkway will run to a revised timetable. Passengers travelling between Worcester Shrub Hill and Worcester Foregate Street should use alternative scheduled rail services.
29	Saturday - All day, trains will be reduced to an hourly frequency and will run between Blackwater and Gatwick Airport only. Replacement buses will run between Reading and North Camp. Passengers should interchange between trains and buses at North Camp. Sunday - All day, trains will be reduced to an hourly frequency and will run between Guildford and Gatwick Airport only. Replacement buses will run between Reading and Guildford.
30	Sunday - The 0737 Reading to Basingstoke will not run. Passengers should travel on the next available service.
34	Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
42	Monday to Friday - The 2340 (Monday to Thursday) Exeter St Davids to Exmouth and the 0019 (Tuesday to Friday) Exmouth to Exeter St Davids will not run. Replacement buses will run instead, extending journey times.

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Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.

The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:

B

Tuesday to Thursday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;

Friday - 0045 London Paddington to Reading;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

P

Friday - The 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
