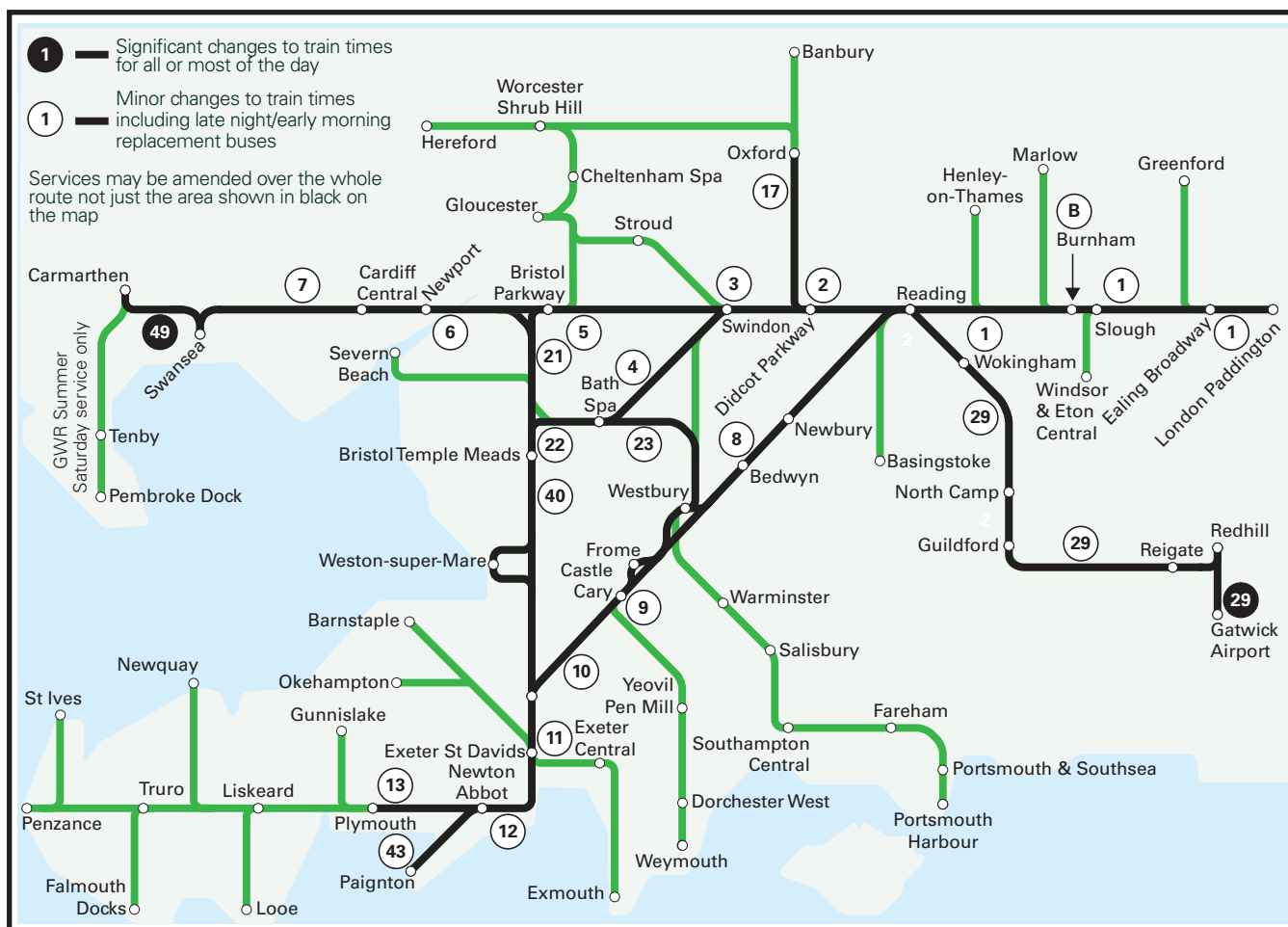


Summary of timetable changes

①	Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2300 until end of service - Trains to and from London Paddington will be subject to minor retimings.
① ② ①⑦	Saturday from approximately 2230 until end of service - Trains between London Paddington / Didcot Parkway and Oxford will be replaced by buses between Oxford and Didcot Parkway.
① ② ③ ⑤	Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. The 1700 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington will finish its journey at Swindon. Passengers should travel forward on the next available service. Most local stopping trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford will be served by additional calls in fast trains running between London Paddington and Swindon (occasionally beyond).
① ② ③ ④ ②② ④①	Sunday - All day, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual. Some trains will not run at all, and some trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Passengers should use alternative scheduled rail services between Bristol Temple Meads, Weston-super-Mare and Taunton. Some trains from London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run.
⑤ ⑥ ⑦	Sunday until approximately 1530 - Trains between London Paddington and South Wales will be diverted via an alternative route between Swindon and Newport and will not call at Bristol Parkway. Trains towards South Wales will generally depart from London Paddington, Reading, (Didcot Parkway) and Swindon EARLIER than usual. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Parkway and Newport. 0858 Bristol Parkway to Swansea will start from Newport. Sunday - All day, in addition to the diversions until around 1530, trains will be subject to minor retimings between Cardiff Central and Swansea. Some trains towards London Paddington will depart from Swansea, Neath, Port Talbot Parkway and Bridgend slightly EARLIER than usual. The 1413 (departing 1400) London Paddington to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Newport. The 1650 Cardiff Central to London Paddington will start from Newport at 1651 and run EARLIER throughout. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
⑥	Saturday - 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will finish its journey at Newport. An alternative rail connection, operated by Transport for Wales, will be available from Newport to Cardiff Central, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
⑥ ②①	Sunday until approximately 1530 - Trains between Cardiff Central and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will either not run or will be diverted to start from / finish at Bristol Parkway, not serving Patchway or stations in South Wales. Trains calling at Ashley Down will be different from usual. Replacement buses will run between Newport, Severn Tunnel Junction, Patchway and Bristol Parkway. Trains will continue to run between Cardiff Central and Newport. Sunday - All day, in addition to the diversions until around 1530, some trains between Cardiff Central and Portsmouth Harbour will not run between Cardiff Central and Newport. Alternative rail services will be available. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
⑧	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2130 until end of service - Buses will replace trains between Reading, Newbury and Bedwyn. A few other trains will either not run, or will be retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual. Tuesday to Friday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will be slightly retimed and will finish its journey at Reading. An alternative rail connection will be available from Reading to London Paddington.
⑧ ⑨ ⑩ ⑪ ⑫ ⑬ ④③	Sunday - All day, most trains from London Paddington to the West of England will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. The 1032 Paignton to London Paddington will not run and the 0918 Penzance to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary. The 1436 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will not run and the 1503 (departing 1458) London Paddington to Plymouth will call additionally at Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary, then will run later from Taunton to Plymouth. The 0759 (departing 0753) London Paddington to Exeter St Davids and the 1630 (departing 1628) London Paddington to Plymouth will both finish their journeys at Bristol Temple Meads. The 1800 London Paddington to Plymouth (via Bristol Temple Meads) will not run. The 1322 & 1732 Exeter St Davids to London Paddington and the 1502 Plymouth to London Paddington will all start from Bristol Temple Meads.

9	Tuesday to Friday - The 0612 Frome to Paddington will start from Westbury. An EARLIER rail connection will be available from Frome to Westbury.
11 40	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2200 until end of service each evening - Trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton / Exeter St Davids will either be diverted to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton, or will not run between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton. Replacement buses will run instead. The 2200 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will run slightly earlier from Weston-super-Mare to Taunton and will not call at Highbridge & Burnham or Bridgwater. The 2244 Taunton to Bristol Temple Meads will depart EARLIER and will call at Weston-super-Mare only.
22 23	Monday to Thursday - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury will run a few minutes later throughout.
	Saturday - The 2335 Reading to Gatwick Airport will finish its journey at Redhill. An alternative rail connection, operated by Southern, will be available from Redhill to Gatwick Airport, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
29 29	Sunday - All day, one train each hour between Reading and Gatwick Airport will not run between Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Passengers should use alternative rail services, provided by Southern and Thameslink, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted.
	Monday to Thursday - The 2322 Gatwick Airport to Reading will finish its journey at Guildford. A replacement bus will run from Guildford to Reading.
	Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport and the 0500 Reading to Redhill will both start from Guildford. Replacement buses will run EARLIER from Reading to Guildford to connect into the trains. The 0531 Reading to Gatwick Airport will depart slightly EARLIER and call additionally at Crowthorne, Sandhurst, Farnborough North and Ash.
49	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.
	The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:
	Saturday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading, 0019 Reading to London Paddington and 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;
	Sunday - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;
B	Tuesday to Friday - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;
	In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
	On Sunday, the following GWR trains will not call at Burnham:
	0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.
