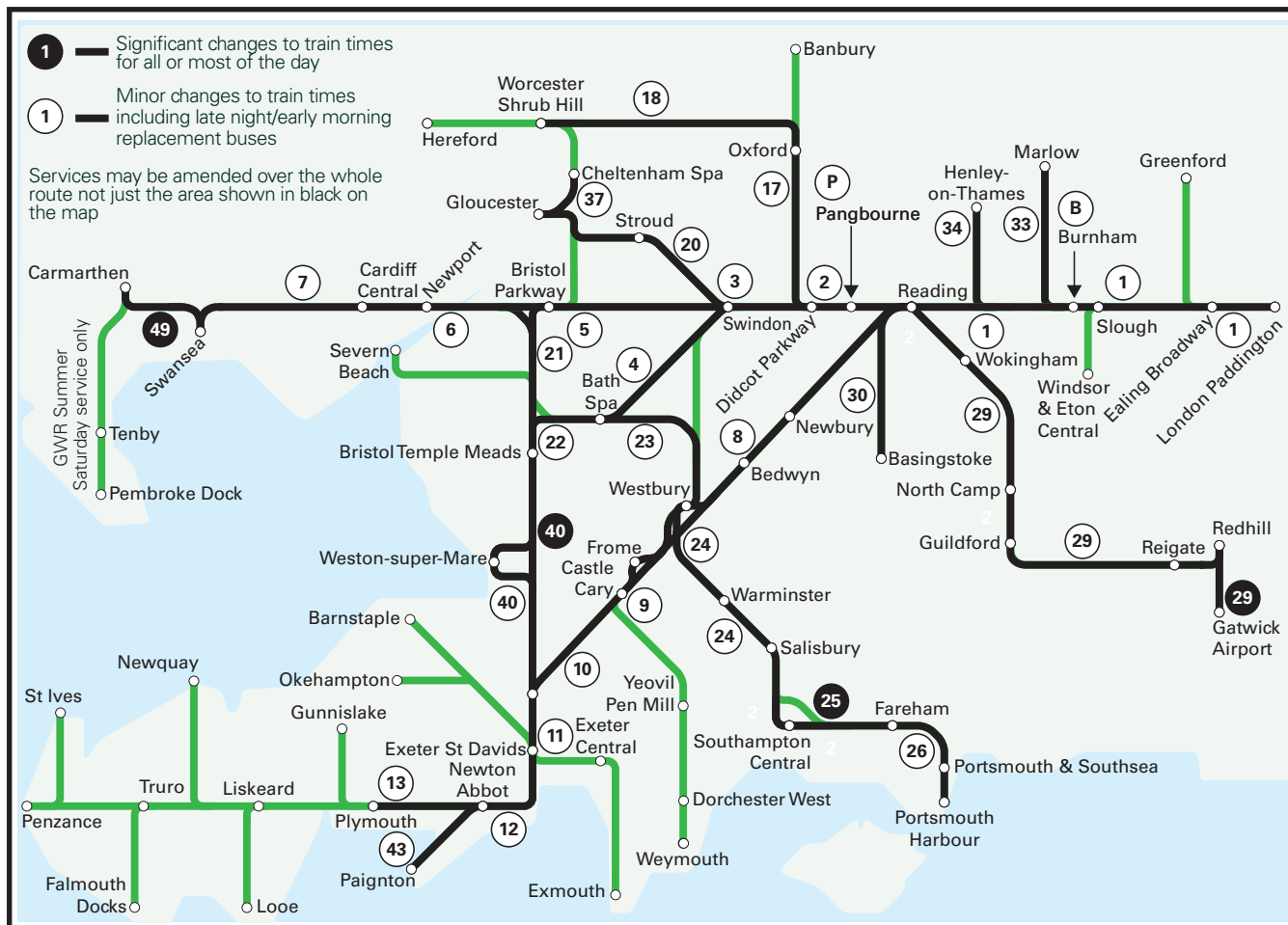


Summary of timetable changes

<div> <div>1</div> <div>2</div> </div> <div> <div>3</div> <div>5</div> </div>	<p>Sunday - All day, High Speed services to and from London Paddington will be revised. Most trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and most trains TO London Paddington will arrive a few minutes later than usual. The 1700 Cheltenham Spa to London Paddington will finish its journey at Swindon. Passengers travel forward on the next available service. Most local stopping trains between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will only run between Reading and Didcot Parkway. Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford will be served by additional calls in fast trains running between London Paddington and Swindon (occasionally beyond).</p>
<div> <div>1</div> <div>2</div> </div> <div> <div>3</div> <div>4</div> </div> <div> <div>22</div> <div>40</div> </div>	<p>Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, trains between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads (and beyond) will be revised. Some trains will not run at all. Trains that would normally run beyond Bristol Temple Meads to / from Weston-super-Mare and Taunton (or beyond) will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads. Replacement buses will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare. In addition, on Sunday, some trains from London Paddington will depart slightly EARLIER than usual and some will call additionally at Didcot Parkway, in place of trains that will no longer run.</p>
<div> <div>2</div> <div>3</div> </div> <div> <div>4</div> <div>22</div> </div>	<p>Sunday - The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling to Didcot Parkway should travel on an alternative local service from Reading.</p> <p>Wednesday and Thursday - The 2332 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa. Passengers should travel EARLIER on the 2314 London Paddington to Oxford, changing at Didcot Parkway for a replacement bus to Swindon and Chippenham. Passengers travelling from Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham to Bath Spa or Bristol Temple Meads should travel on an alternative EARLIER service.</p>
<div> <div>3</div> <div>4</div> </div> <div> <div>17</div> <div>20</div> </div> <div> <div>22</div> <div>37</div> </div>	<p>Saturday - The following trains will not run: 0846 Cheltenham Spa to Bristol Temple Meads (via Swindon), 1018 & 1518 Bristol Temple Meads to Oxford and 1202 & 1712 Oxford to Bristol Temple Meads. In all cases, passengers should use alternative scheduled services, changing en-route where necessary to complete their journey.</p>
<div> <div>5</div> <div>6</div> </div> <div> <div>7</div> </div>	<p>Sunday - The 2045 (departing 2037) & 2145 (departing 2143) London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.</p> <p>Monday, Wednesday and Thursday - The 2246 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Swindon and will run up to 45 minutes later from Bristol Parkway onwards. On Wednesday and Thursday, it will also call at Chippenham and Bath Spa.</p> <p>Monday to Thursday - 2048 & 2148 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.</p>
<div> <div>6</div> <div>21</div> </div>	<p>Saturday - Local stopping trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Filton Abbey Wood will not run. Some trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Cardiff Central will call additionally at Lawrence Hill, Stapleton Road and Ashley Down. The 1901 Severn Beach to Frome will finish its journey at Bristol Temple Meads.</p>
<div> <div>8</div> </div>	<p>Sunday - The 0804 (departing 0753) London Paddington to Penzance will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. The 0844 (departing 0828) London Paddington to Penzance will call additionally at Newbury and Pewsey. The 0806 Reading to Newbury will not run and the 0833 Reading to Bedwyn will start from Newbury and run slightly later throughout. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading to Newbury.</p> <p>Tuesday and Wednesday - The 0531 Bedwyn to London Paddington will not run. Passengers should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.</p>
<div> <div>8</div> <div>9</div> </div> <div> <div>10</div> <div>11</div> </div> <div> <div>12</div> <div>13</div> </div> <div> <div>43</div> </div>	<p>Sunday - All day, most trains from London Paddington to the West of England will depart from London Paddington slightly EARLIER than usual. The 1032 Paignton to London Paddington will not run and the 0918 Penzance to London Paddington will call additionally at Castle Cary. The 1436 London Paddington to Exeter St Davids will not run and the 1503 (departing 1458) London Paddington to Plymouth will call additionally at Pewsey, Westbury and Castle Cary, then will run later from Taunton to Plymouth. All trains that would normally run via Bristol Temple Meads will either not run at all, or will only run between London Paddington and Bristol Temple Meads.</p>
<div> <div>9</div> </div>	<p>Saturday - The 2215 & 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will both finish their journeys at Westbury. The 2316 Frome to Westbury will not run. Replacement buses will run between Westbury and Frome.</p> <p>Monday to Thursday - The 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will finish its journey at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Frome.</p>

11	Monday and Tuesday - The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will arrive later at Exeter St Davids. Monday to Wednesday - The 2345 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive later at Exeter St Davids.
12 43	Saturday - The 1033 London Paddington to Paignton will finish its journey at Exeter St Davids. The 1455 Paignton to London Paddington will start from Exeter St Davids. Passengers travelling to stations west of Exeter St Davids should travel on alternative services.
17 18	Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service - The 2153 London Paddington to Worcester Shrub Hill will call additionally at Didcot Parkway then be diverted to run non-stop to Worcester Shrub Hill. An alternative rail connection will be available from Didcot Parkway to Oxford with a replacement bus from Oxford to Worcester Shrub Hill. The 2200 Hereford to London Paddington will finish its journey at Worcester Shrub Hill and restart from Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Worcester Shrub Hill to Oxford, but will not connect into the train at Oxford. Passengers travelling from stations between Worcestershire Parkway and Hanborough wishing to travel beyond Oxford should travel on an EARLIER service. Monday to Friday - The 2251 London Paddington to Worcestershire Parkway will finish its journey at Oxford. A replacement bus will run from Oxford to Worcestershire Parkway.
22 23	Saturday - The 0945, 1645 & 1845 Bristol Temple Meads to Salisbury will run slightly EARLIER from Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury. The 1901 Severn Beach to Frome will start from Bristol Temple Meads.
24 25	Sunday - The 0806 Warminster to Swindon will start from Westbury. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Warminster and Dilton Marsh to Westbury.
26	Sunday - All day, trains between Cardiff Central / Bristol Temple Meads and Portsmouth Harbour will be diverted between Romsey and Fareham, calling additionally at Chandlers Ford and Eastleigh, but not calling at Southampton Central. Replacement buses will run between Southampton Central and Eastleigh. The 1750 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will finish its journey at Westbury, The 1825 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will call additionally at Keynsham, Oldfield Park, Freshford and Avoncliff and the 1934 Bristol Temple Meads to Portsmouth Harbour will not run. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
	Monday - The 0703 Salisbury to Bristol Temple Meads will start from Westbury. Passengers travelling from stations before Westbury should travel on an alternative earlier or later service.
29 29	Sunday - All day, one train each hour between Reading and Gatwick Airport will not run between Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Passengers should use alternative rail services, provided by Southern and Thameslink, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Some trains will be retimed between Guildford / Reigate and Gatwick Airport. Tuesday to Friday - The 0432 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading non-stop to Guildford to connect into the train.
30	Sunday - The 0737 & 0837 Reading to Basingstoke and the 0806 Basingstoke to Reading will not run. Replacement buses will run at 0737 from Reading to Basingstoke and at 0745 from Basingstoke to Reading.
33	Sunday - The 0007 Marlow to Maidenhead will finish its journey at Bourne End. A replacement bus will run from Bourne End to Maidenhead.
34	Tuesday to Thursday - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will finish its journey at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.
40	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare. Bedminster and Parson Street will not be served, and passengers should use alternative local bus services, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted. Passengers are strongly advised to check their journeys before travelling.
49	Saturday and Sunday - All weekend, buses will replace trains between Swansea, Llanelli and Carmarthen.

Ⓑ **Tuesday to Friday** - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

On Sunday, the following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: 0638 London Paddington to Reading, 0620 (departing 0625) Reading to London Paddington and 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington. Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

The following trains will not call at Pangbourne:

Sunday - 0738, 2233 & 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 0818 & 2350 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Ⓟ **Monday to Wednesday** - 2236 & 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2326 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington;

Tuesday to Thursday - 0355 Oxford to Reading (no replacement bus provided - passengers should use the next available service);

Friday - 2337 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway;

Unless otherwise stated, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
